MEMO: IMMEDIATE COMPLIANCE REQUIREMENTS: CALIFORNIA SB 258

Dear Private Label Partner,

Boat Bling, Inc. is committed to making world-class products on your behalf, ensuring an industry best in service and keeping you comprised of significant compliance regulations. A new regulation went into affect on January 1, 2021 specific to the sale of products in California called **California's Senate Bill 258 – Cleaning Product Right to Know Act of 2017**. If you do not sell products into California, you can ignore this memo but we highly encourage you to review and consider your distribution in the event your products are getting into California indirectly.

California's Senate Bill 258 – Cleaning Product Right to Know Act of 2017 official information can be found here and we highly encourage you to read through the entire law. There are many aspects of the law that is out of the scope of the manufacturer and the responsibility of the private label partner.

Here is the initial summary on the above web link:

Existing law regulates the existence of, and disclosure of, specified chemicals and components in consumer products, including phthalates and bisphenol A.

This bill would require a manufacturer of a designated product, as defined, that is sold in the state to disclose on the product label and on the product's Internet Web site information related to chemicals contained in the designated product, as specified. The bill would authorize a manufacturer to protect certain chemicals from disclosure by use of a generic name, as specified. The bill would prohibit the sale in the state of a designated product that does not satisfy these requirements

Ultimately, our interpretation of the law requires the following:

1. **Online Disclosure** effective immediately. Boat Bling, Inc. is working to provide you an Online Disclosure for your specific product(s). You will receive this within 30 days.
2. **Online Disclosure** MUST be on your website, with requirements on where its located, format and how it is accessed. The disclosed information should be within (5) clicks of the main webpage that is on the product label and within four (4) clicks of a product specific page. Any changes must be updated within six (6) months.

3. **SDS – Safety Data Sheet.** If this is NOT on your website yet, this is also a requirement. Boat Bling, Inc. has reviewed your currently SDS to ensure everything required under this new law is correctly included which it is. The current SDS you have is correct.
4. **On-Product Disclosure.** This is required on all product(s) ***produced*** after January 1, 2021. Products that are manufactured prior are considered compliant given there is a date/date code on the product which is the case for the products you purchase from us. Any updates to the disclosure should be implemented as a revision on the label within eighteen (18) months. Boat Bling, Inc. provided this information that is accurately on your current label(s).
5. **Rules on the website document location and file formats.**
 - Must be in an electronically readable format
 - Must not be restricted from search engines
 - Must not be restricted from use by means of CAPTCHA or other visual/auditory challenge questions
 - Must conform to WCAG (If using a pdf, make sure its ADA compliant)
 - No more than 5 clicks from the URL on product label
 - No more than 4 clicks from a product specific page
 - Electronic lists for the designated lists must be grouped together in a single location
 - Ingredients must be listed in a descending order (must list name, cas #, function)
 - Must have a link to the SDS
 - Must be easy to print for worker safety

We will provide you all necessary information to be compliant. Please ensure you publish the information to your website immediately when received. If we manage your label inventory, we will provide you with an approximate inventory number so you know how many remain prior to the new label design with the On-Product Disclosures included. If you manage your label inventory, please ensure the regulatory changes are made and any labels sent past December 1, 2020 for manufacturing are within compliance.
