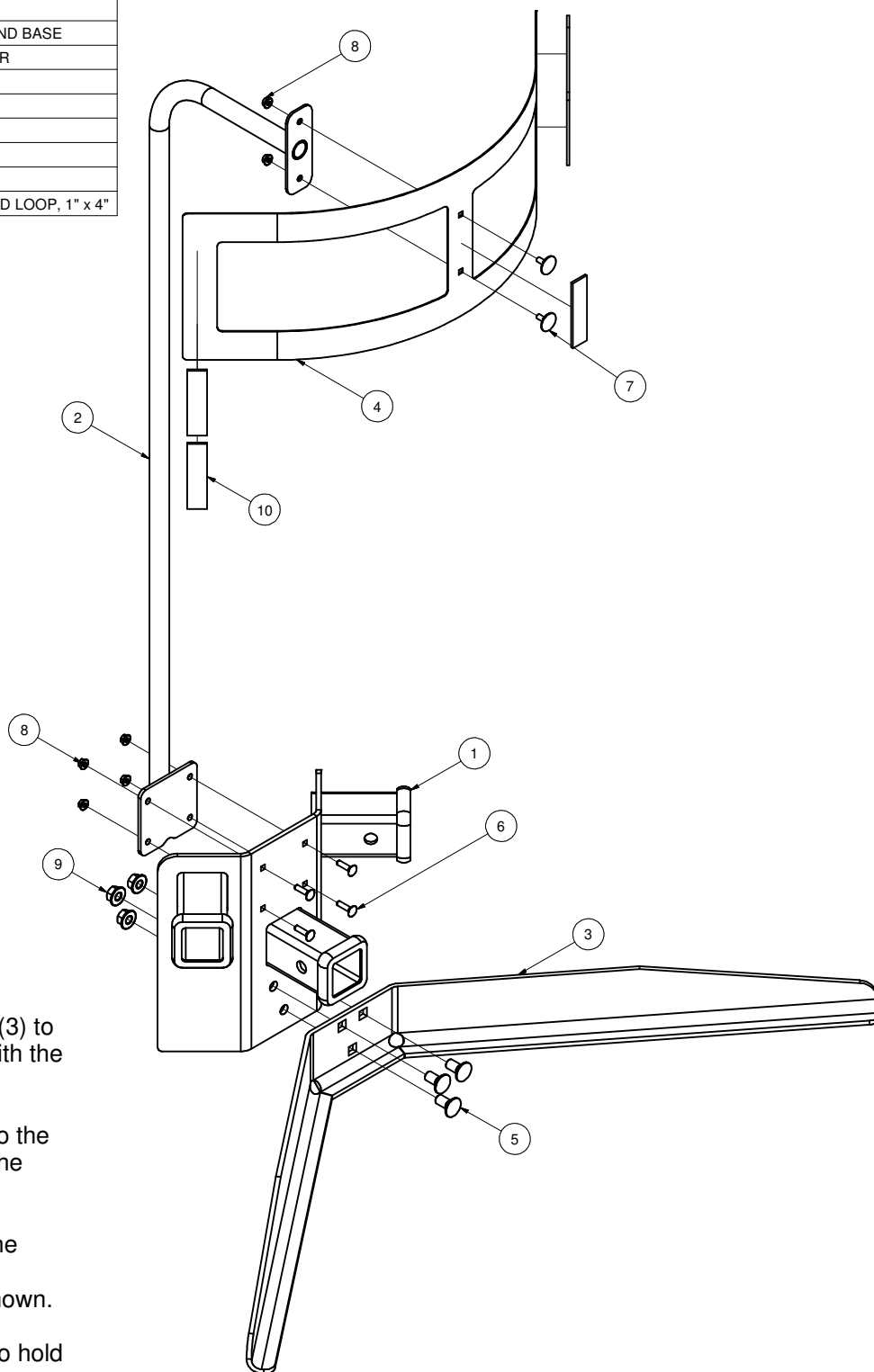

**ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Attach the display stand base (3) to the main body weldment (1) with the 1/2" hardware as shown.
2. Attach the post weldment (2) to the main body weldment (1) with the 1/4" hardware as shown.
3. Attach the sign backer (4) to the post weldment (2) with the remaining 1/4" hardware as shown.
4. Apply Velcro strips as shown to hold the printed sign.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS DISPLAY STAND TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.

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
