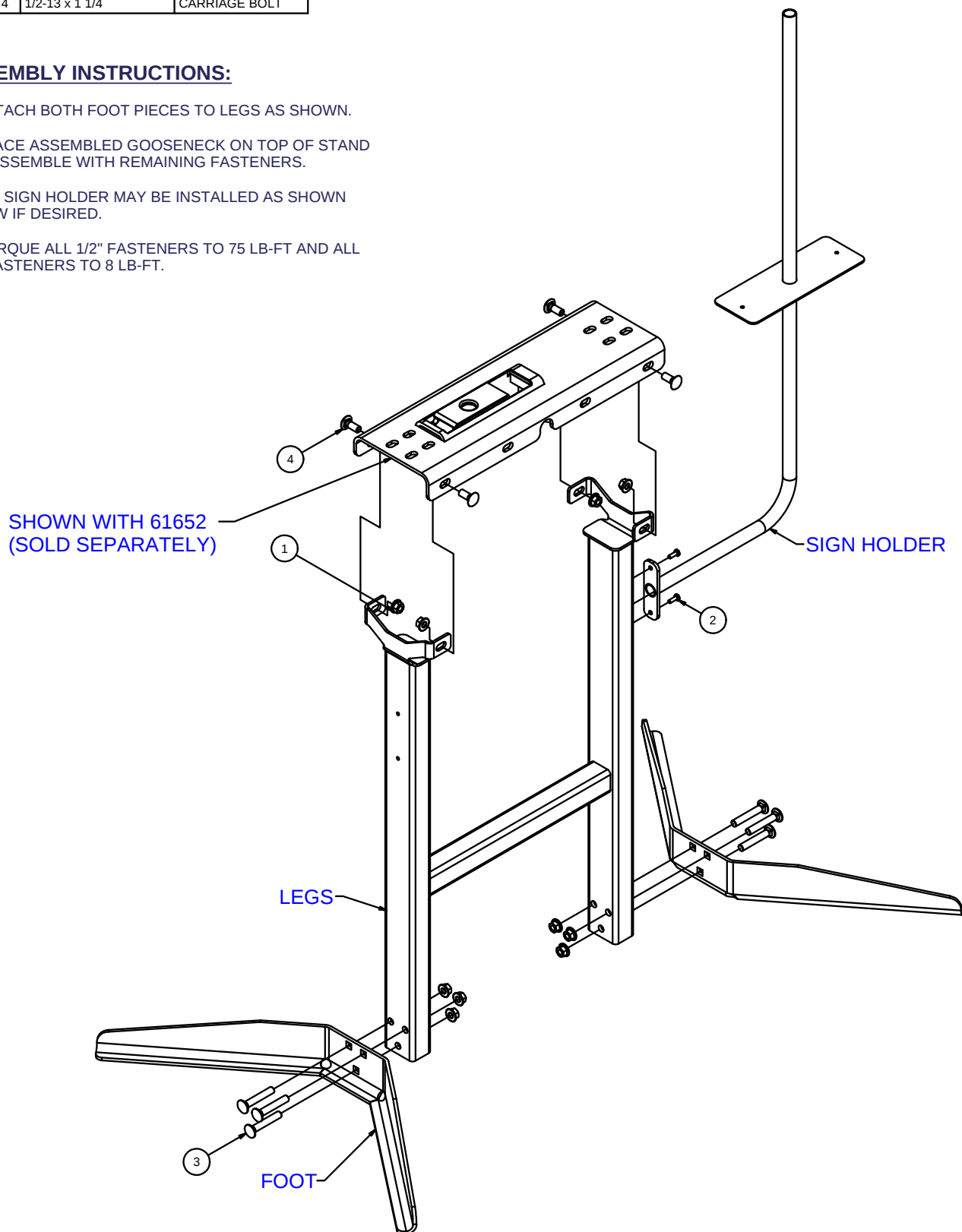
**ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS:**

2) PLACE ASSEMBLED GOOSENECK ON TOP OF STAND AND ASSEMBLE WITH REMAINING FASTENERS.

NOTE: SIGN HOLDER MAY BE INSTALLED AS SHOWN BELOW IF DESIRED.

3) TORQUE ALL 1/2" FASTENERS TO 75 LB-FT AND ALL 1/4" FASTENERS TO 8 LB-FT.



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
