- Co-cured in rust-resistant liquid Bonderite® and finished with a high-gloss black powder coat

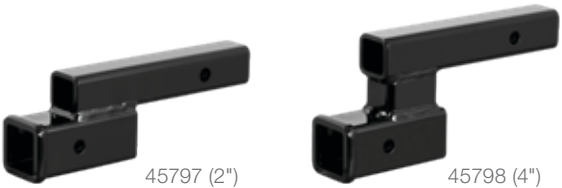

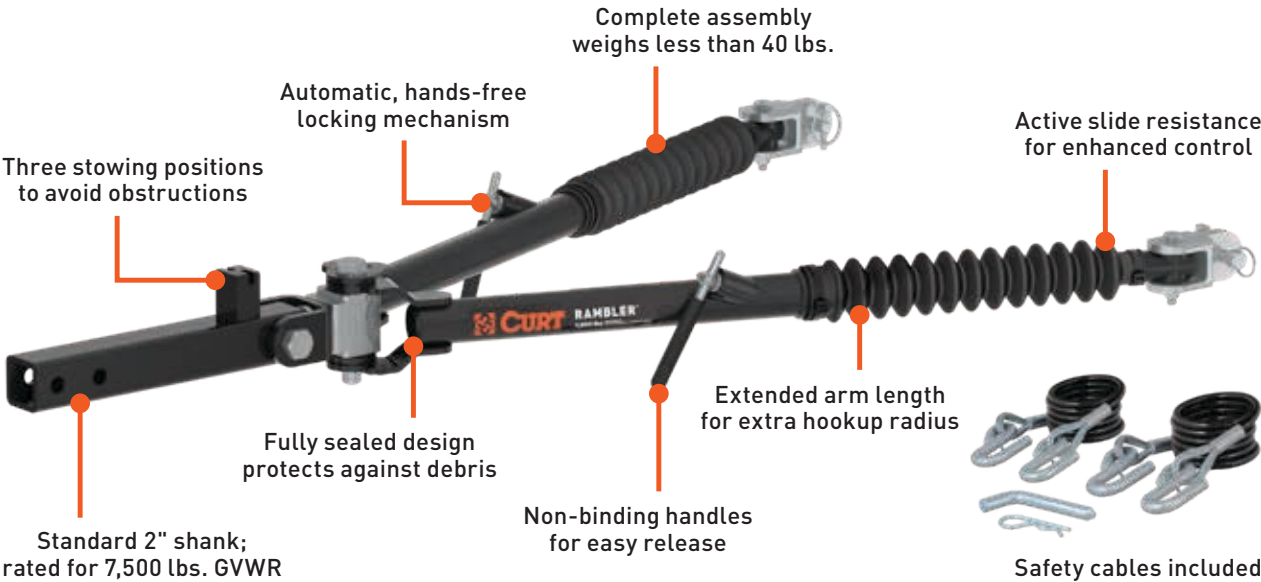
