

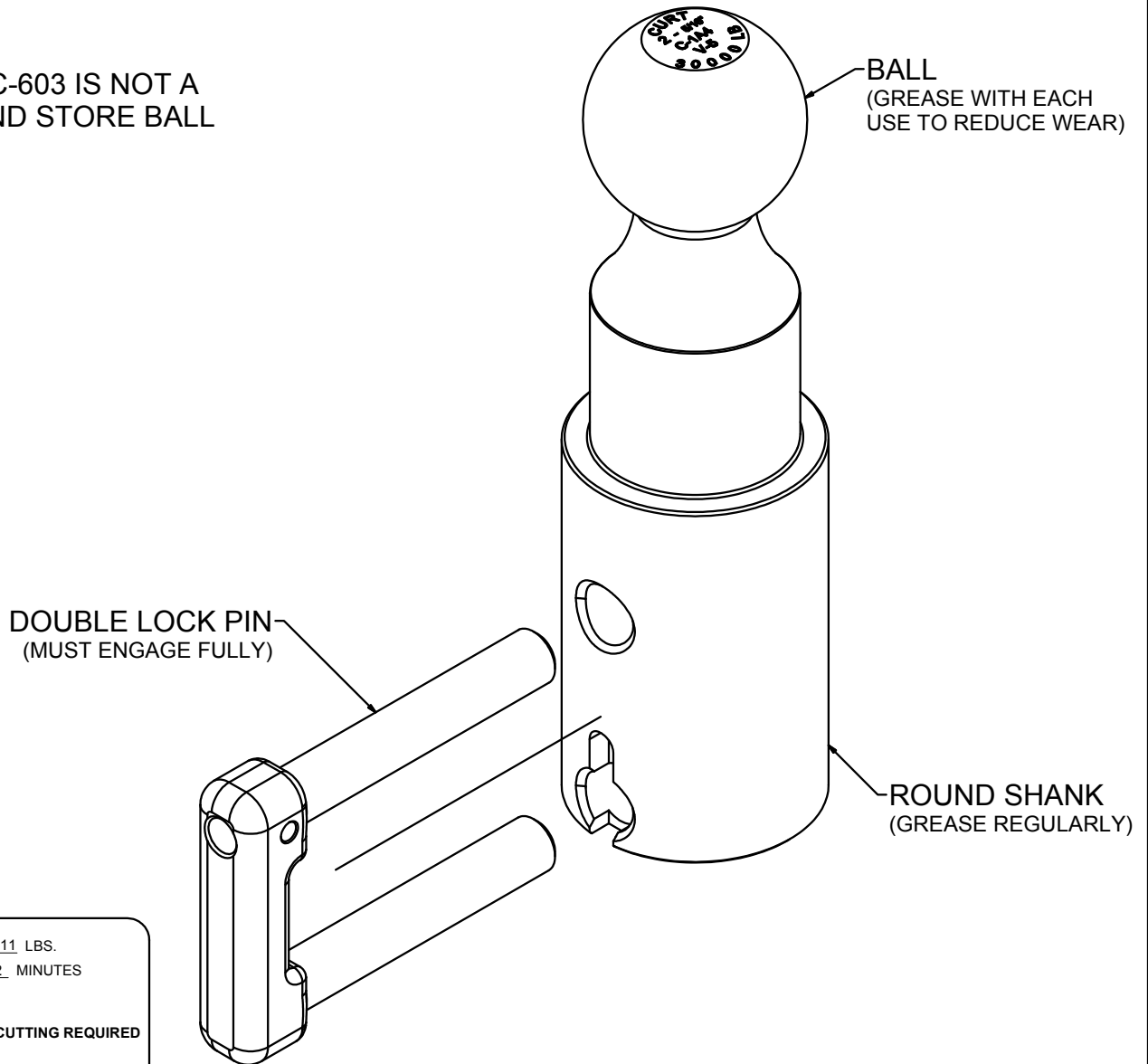

INSTALLATION STEPS

Application:

Make sure the High Rise Ball fully seats in the gooseneck, and can be fully locked by the pins of your gooseneck hitch. **Please review tow rating information, and turning clearance warning.**

Installation:

Disengage the double lock pins and remove ball or any other accessory. Place the round shank of the ball into the Double Lock cylinder and engage the Double Lock pins. Make sure that the pins fully engage the round shank of the extender and pass through the cylinder completely. For hitch accessories that remain in the Double lock Gooseneck for an extended period of time, Curt Mfg. recommends lightly lubricating the round shank with grease.

**PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS
ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.**

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
