

FTP VIDEO INSTRUCTIONS

Login credentials:

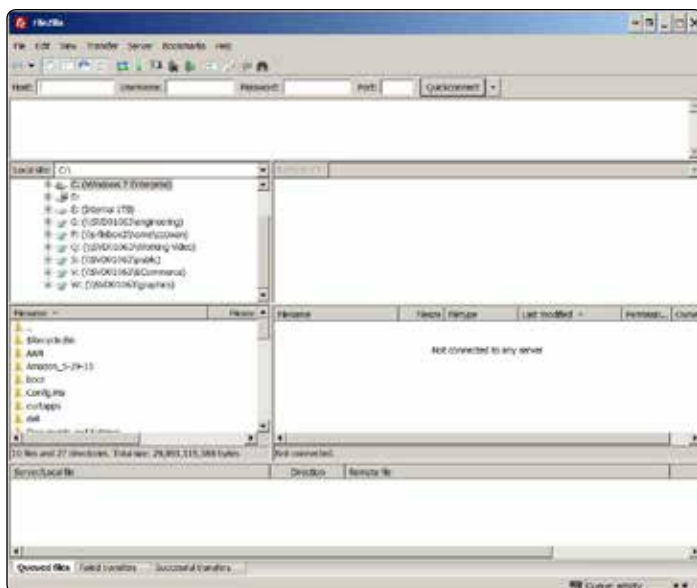
These instructions will help you access our video library, helping you provide the information your customers demand.

Getting online is simple! All that is needed is an FTP client and the login credentials, detailed above. We recommend using FileZilla as an FTP client. It is what we use, so our familiarity with the software better equips us to troubleshoot any issues. If you are currently using another client, and are familiar with it, that will work just as well.

Step 1:

Download the FileZilla client and install it on your computer. If you currently have an FTP client installed, you may skip this step.

Once installed, launch the program. Once loaded, you will be presented with a screen similar to what is shown below.

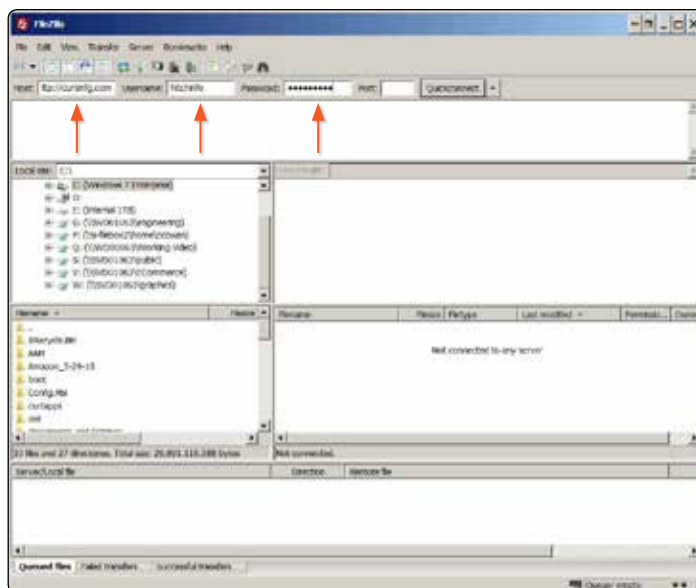

Videos are 1080p quality

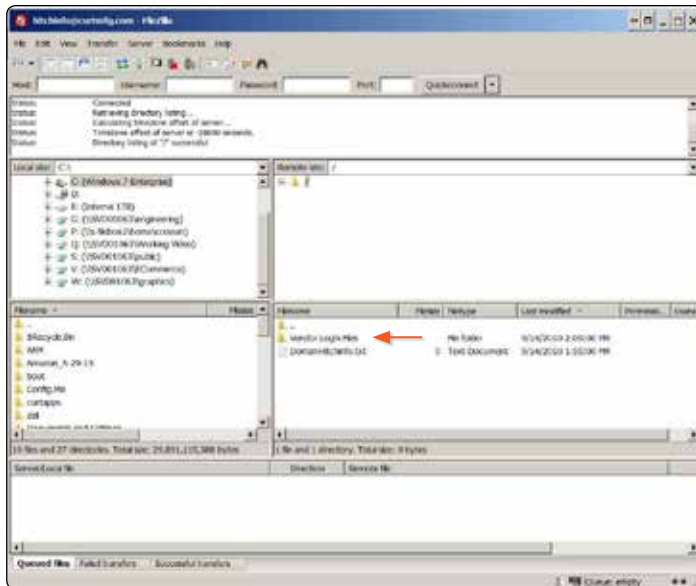
Step 2:

Located along the top of the program screen are the fields for entering the credentials, which are detailed above. Make sure to populate 'Host', 'User Name' and 'Password'. You may leave the 'Port' field empty.



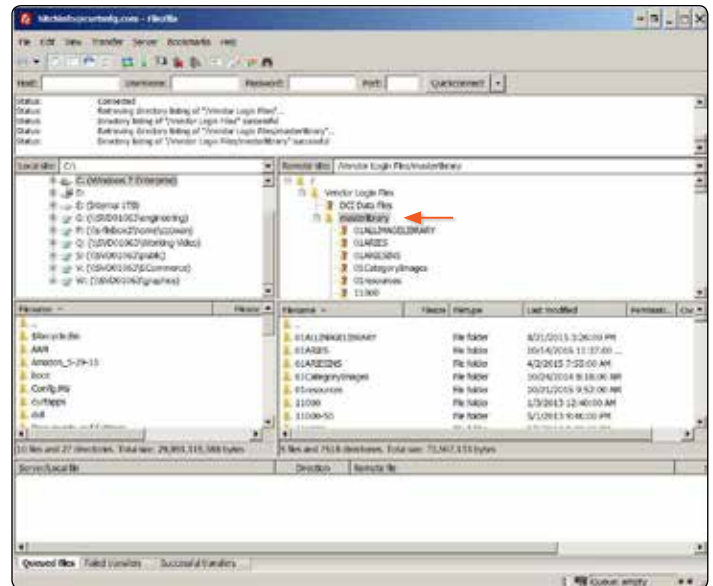
Step 3:

Once you are logged in, you should see the information shown below. Click into the 'Vendor Login Files' folder. This folder contains all of the helpful resources we are providing, which are intended to increase your sales.



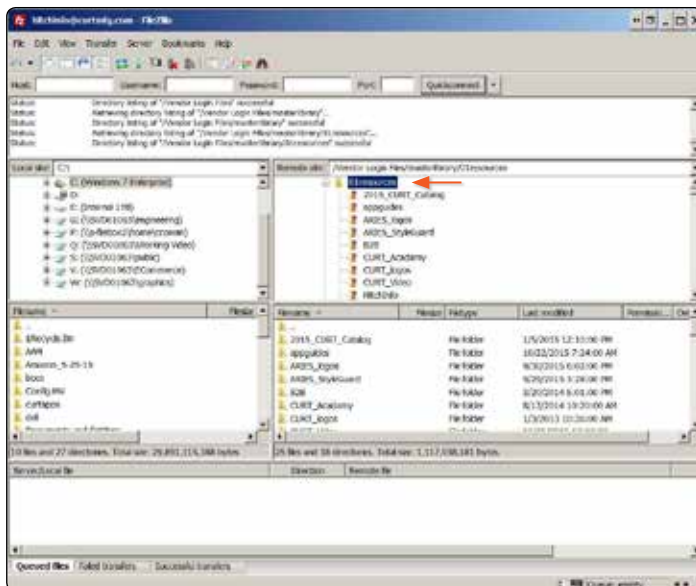
Step 4:

The 'Vendor Login Files' folder contains the 'DCI Data Files' and the 'masterlibrary' folders. Click into the 'masterlibrary' folder.



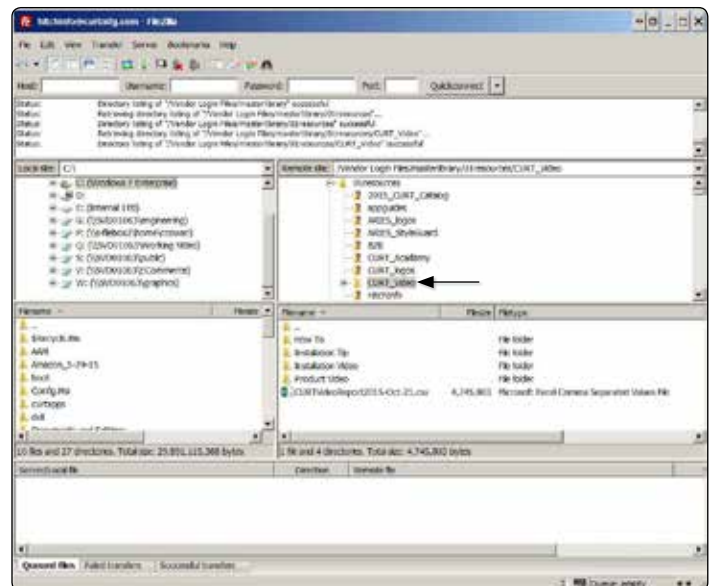
Step 5:

From the 'masterlibrary' folder, navigate to the '01resources' folder.



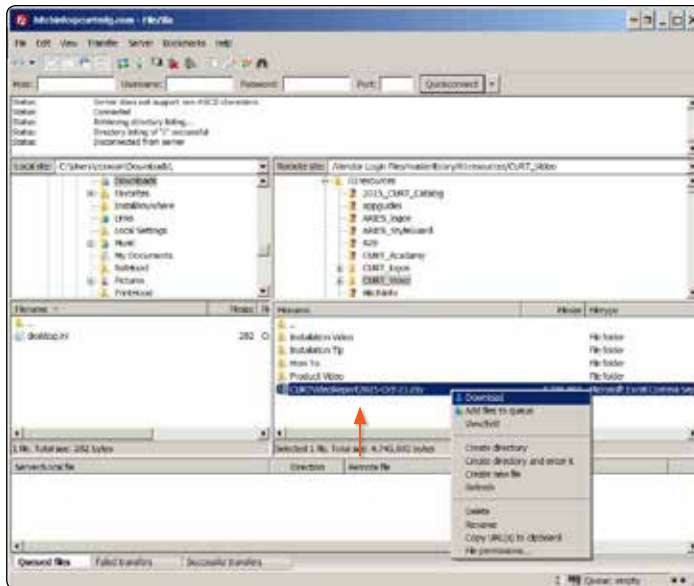
Step 6:

From the '01resources' folder, navigate to the 'CURT_Video' folder. We recommend downloading the entire contents of the folder to your computer. This is a large amount of data and depending on the connection speed, it may take up to 10 hours. For instructions on how to download individual videos, continue to step 7.



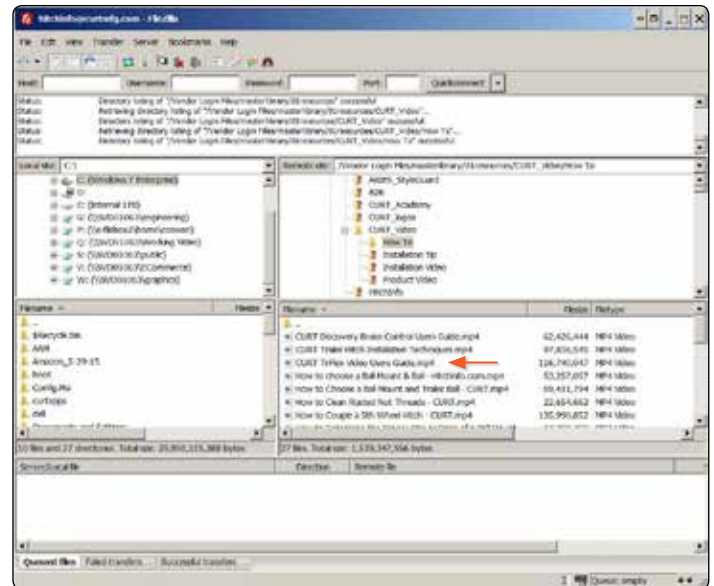
Step 7:

To download a specific video, first download the CURTVideoReport.CSV file for a complete list of our entire video offering. See note below.



Step 8:

Once you have identified the video you wish to download, navigate to the appropriate folder and simply drag and drop the file from the FTP client to your desktop.



NOTE: The CURTVideoReport.CSV is a key for matching up CURT parts with all of their associated videos. This makes it easy to load the information to your hosted environment.

Within the spreadsheet, replace <http://curtmfg.com/MasterLibrary/01RESOURCES/> with your hostname and keep the directory structure the same, and all links can be loaded to your database.



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
