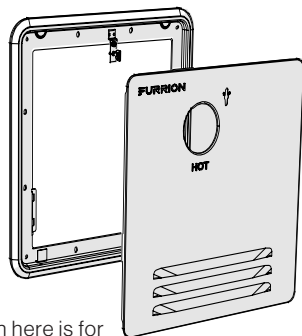

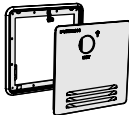

PREPARE CUTOUT OPENING

New Installation

1. Create a cutout with the following dimensions A and B of Fig. 1.

NOTE: The opening for the water heater should be right angle corners.

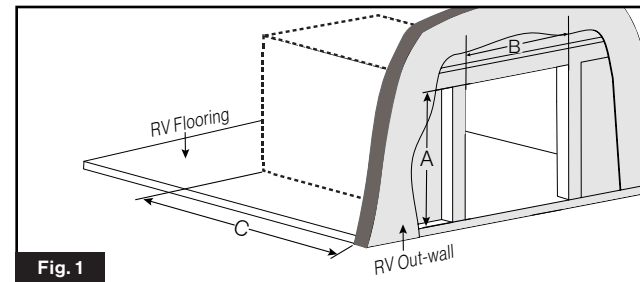

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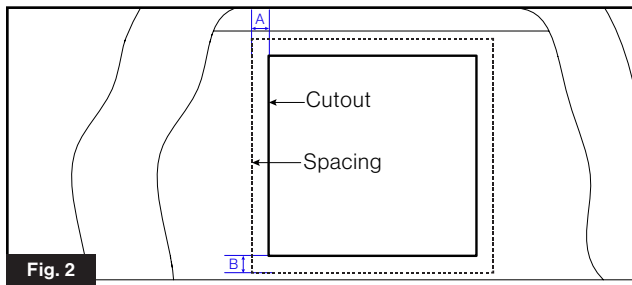

- Make sure that the front edge of the opening is surrounded by a solid frame to firmly anchor the water heater. If needed, construct the opening by using 1.5" x 1.5" min." wood or aluminum framing.

NOTE:

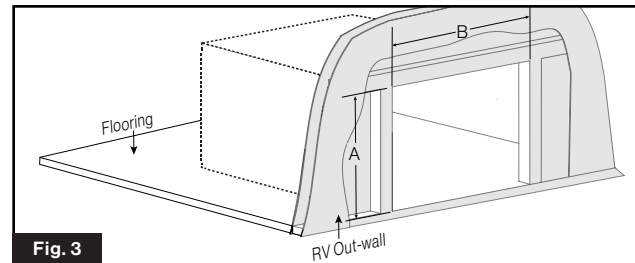
- Fiberglass, filon, and corrugated aluminum (Mesa 1") are all acceptable exterior wall siding solutions.
 - The exterior wall opening must be the same dimensions with no radius corners.
- Refer to depth "C" for minimum rear clearances, for such items as cabinets, appliances and utility entry locations.
 - Refer to Fig. 2 for adequate spacing from other items on the RV wall to the door assembly.
