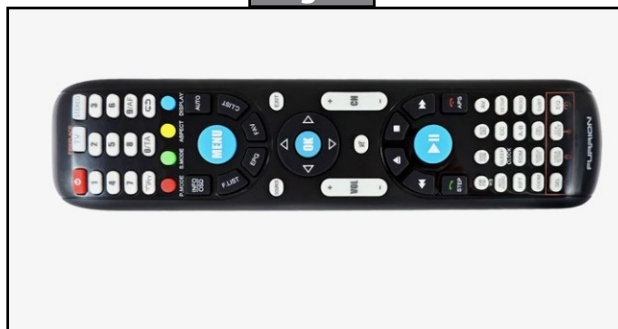
REMOTES
