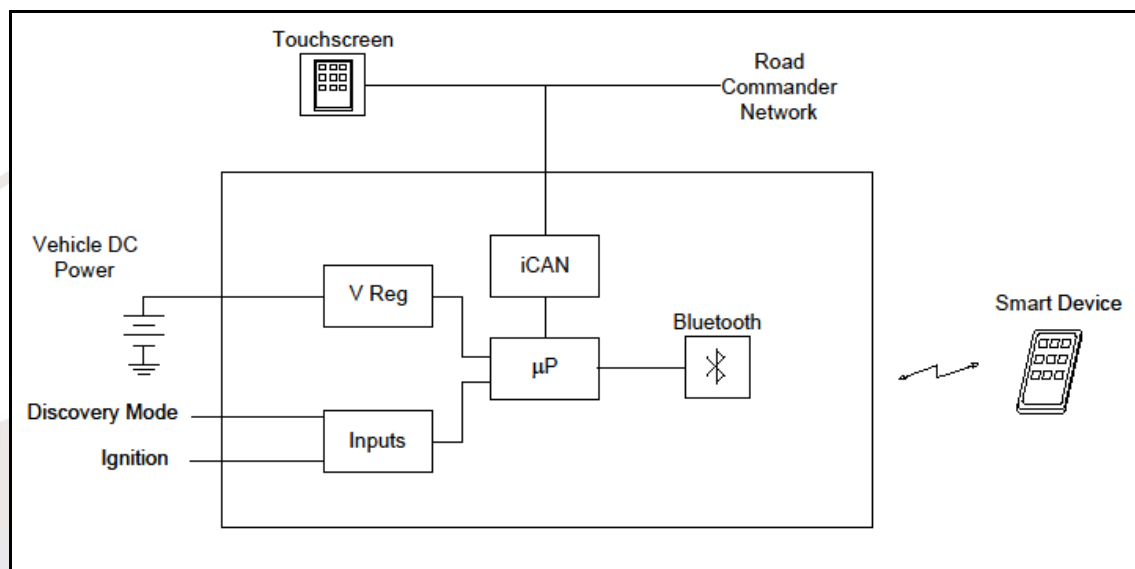


Description:

The Road Commander BT Module provides a wireless access for communicating between smart phones and tablets such as an Android or iOS device and the Road Commander system. The BT Module transmits and receives messages to and from the network and is capable communicating with any device on it. In order to communicate with the BT Module, the user must download the 'Road Commander' app from either the iTunes App store or Google Playstore, keyword is Road Commander.

Once the app is installed on the SMART Device, the user will 'pair' with the BT Module in order for the installed Road Commander system to recognize and take control of the system. Multiple SMART Devices may have the Road Commander app installed, but only a single SMART Device may be connected at one time. A personalized PIN may be configured once the SMART Device is connected to the BT Module.

The BT module has four available high/low selectable input channels, which can be configured to control outputs on the low current, high current or slide out module. Alternatively the inputs can be used to provide the network with inhibit information or as an external switch to make the Bluetooth module visible for pair. To use this component module for any reason other than what it is designed for may result in damage to the coach and/or cause serious injury or even death.
