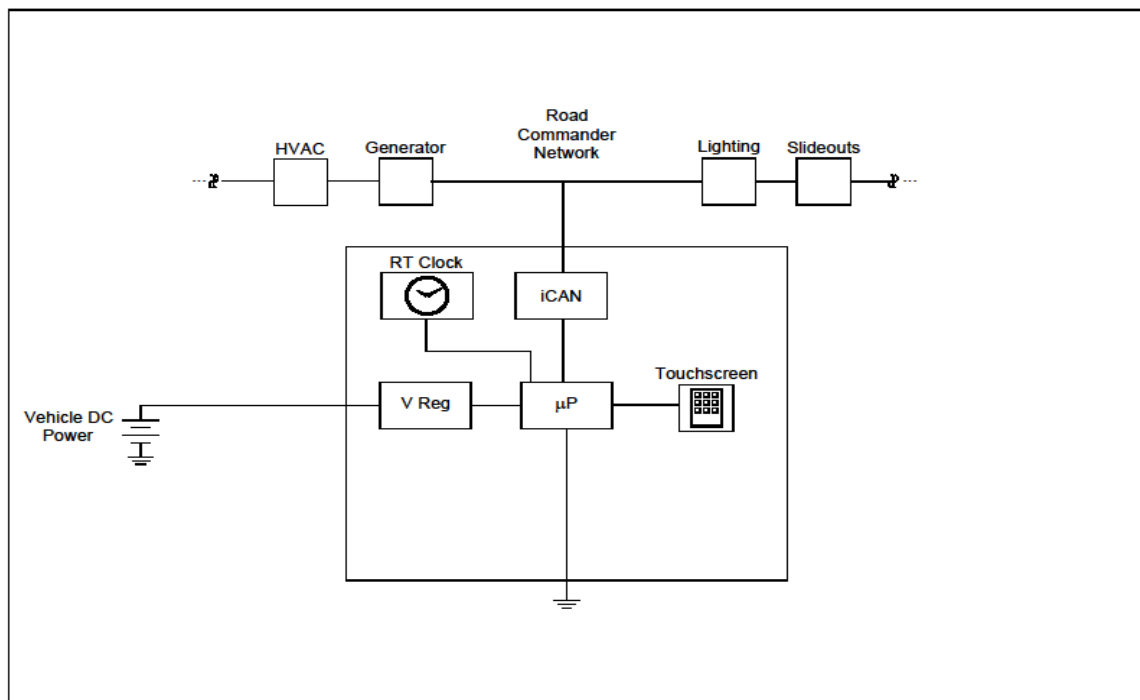

Description:

The 1115 Road Commander touchscreen is a capacitive touch, configurable, user interface display that can control all aspects of the Road Commander network. The touchscreen support both dimming and non-dimming outputs, slide outs, awnings generators and HVAC controls as well as monitors battery levels and tank levels. It offers custom labeling for outputs and backgrounds that the user can set from the settings menu. A built in real time clocks displays the date and time in a number of configurations. The lighting screen features filters to help locate specific lighting controls such as separating interior from exterior. It also features scene buttons which automatically set the lighting to a preconfigured setting such as movie, or party scene. Each scene is configurable by the user so it can be tailored to the needs.

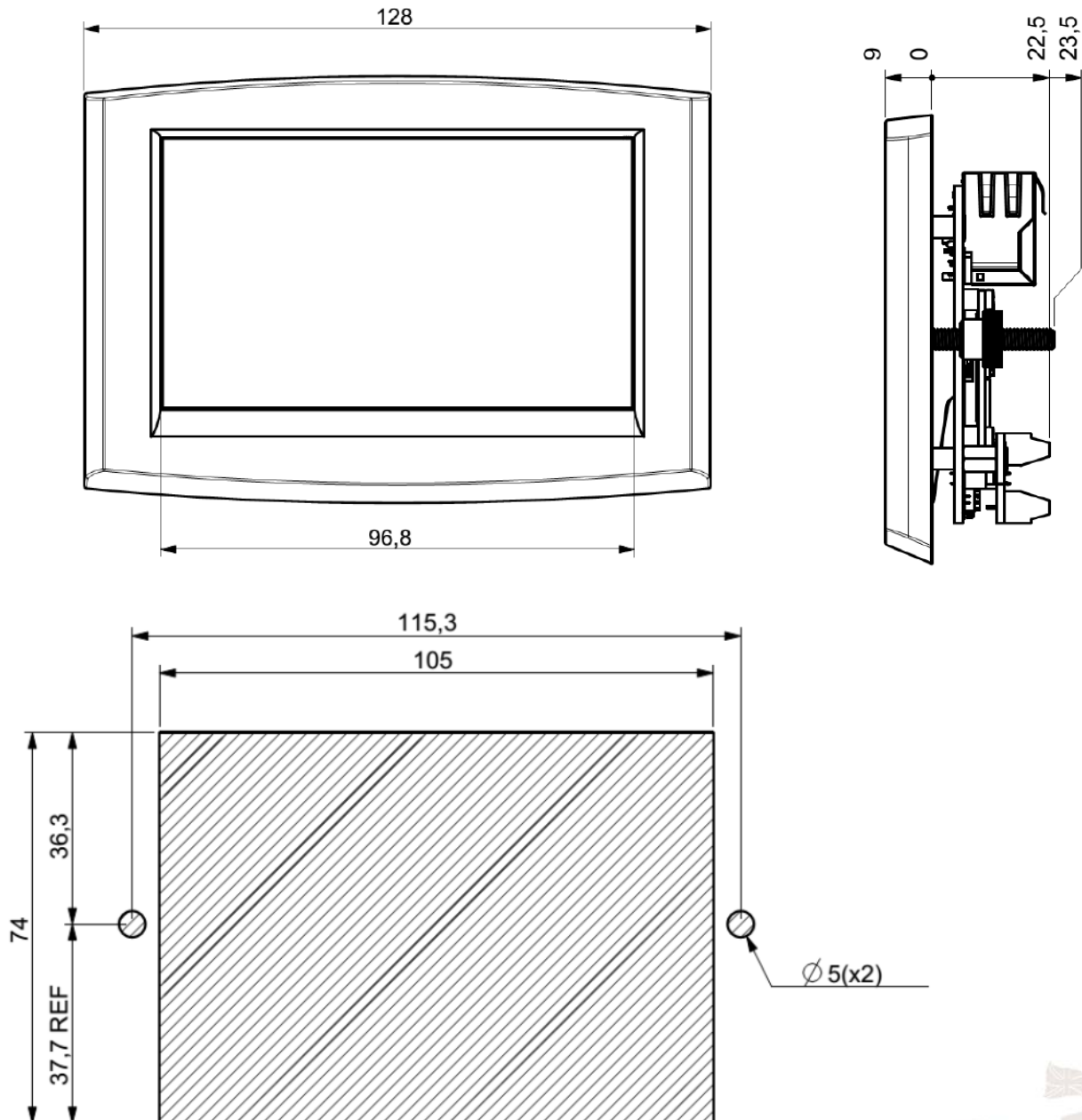

Mounting Specifications



All dimensions are in shown in millimeters

The touchscreen is supplied with 4 threaded nylon studs which should be screwed into the rear of the touchscreen in the 4 M4 brass inserts. Once the mounting location is created, use the supplied 4 thumb nut screws onto the nylon studs by hand. Do not over tighten as it may cause the nylon studs to break.
