

LEVELING AND STABILIZATION

Purpose

To maintain and extend the product life of the JT's Strong Arm product lines.

Safety

WARNING

The trailer MUST be supported per the manufacturer's recommendations before working underneath. Failure to do so may result in death, serious personal injury, severe product or property damage or voiding of the component warranty.

CAUTION

Always wear eye protection when performing service or maintenance to the trailer. Other safety equipment to consider would be hearing protection, gloves and possibly a full face shield, depending on the nature of service.

CAUTION

Moving parts can pinch, crush or cut. Keep clear and use caution.

Resources Required

- Lint-free cloth
- Water

Maintenance

Using a clean cloth, periodically wipe the arms with water to remove any salt or debris. Wipe dry with a clean, dry cloth when finished.

NOTE: Lubricating the JT's Strong Arm is not recommended, as it will attract more dirt and debris.
