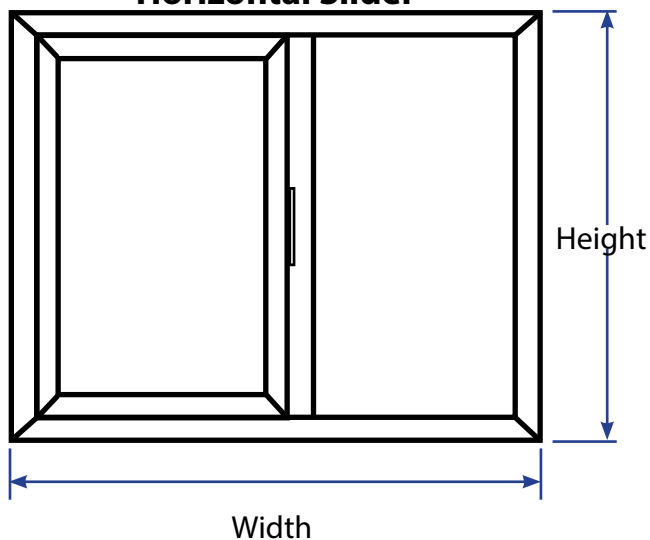

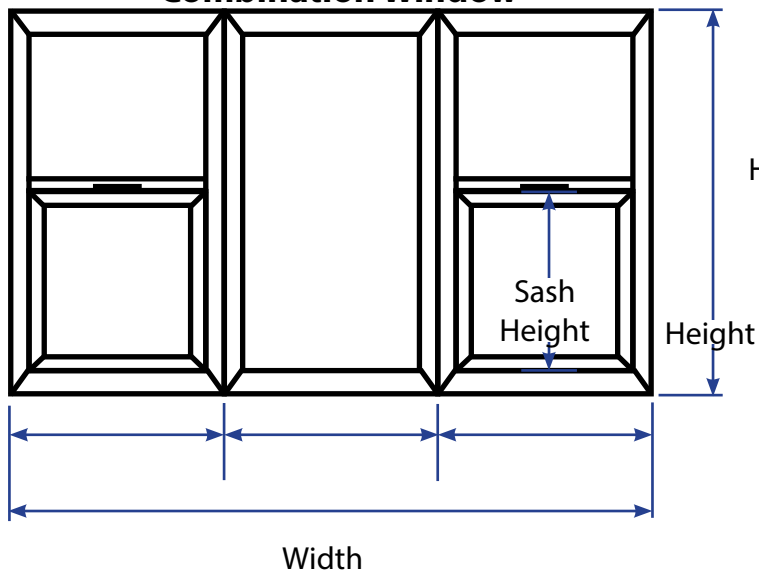

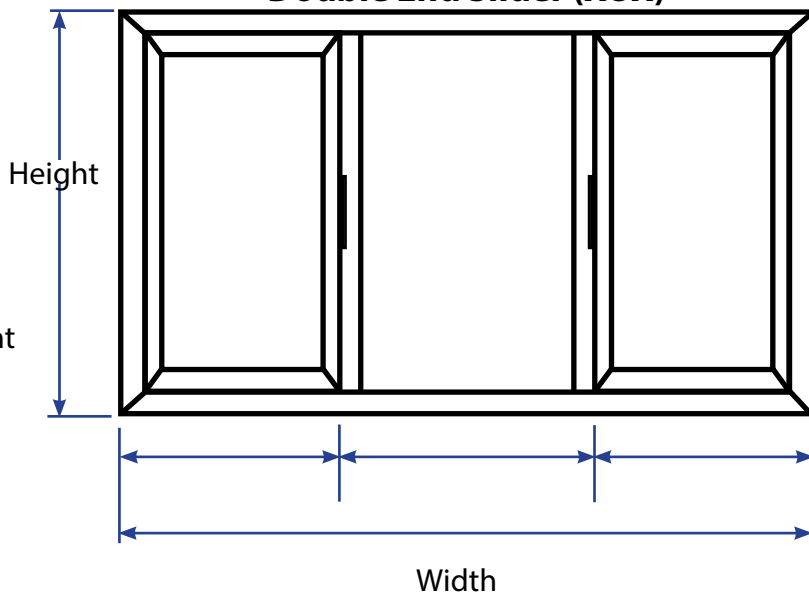
Horizontal Slider

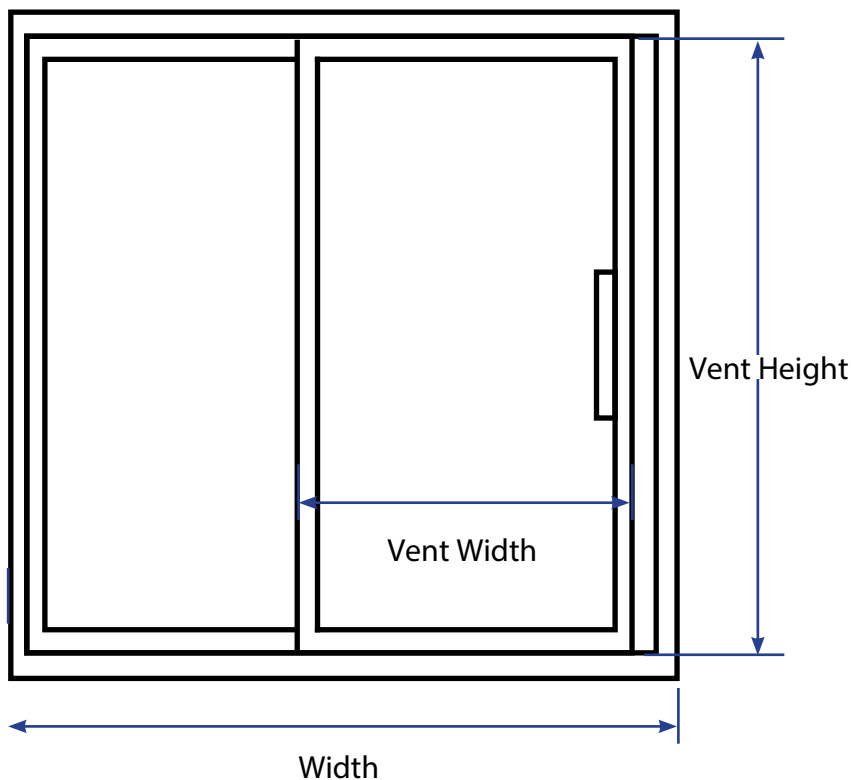
