Lewmar pioneered the high-volume flush hatch platform back in 2006, bringing what was then Superyacht styling to the masses.

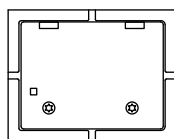

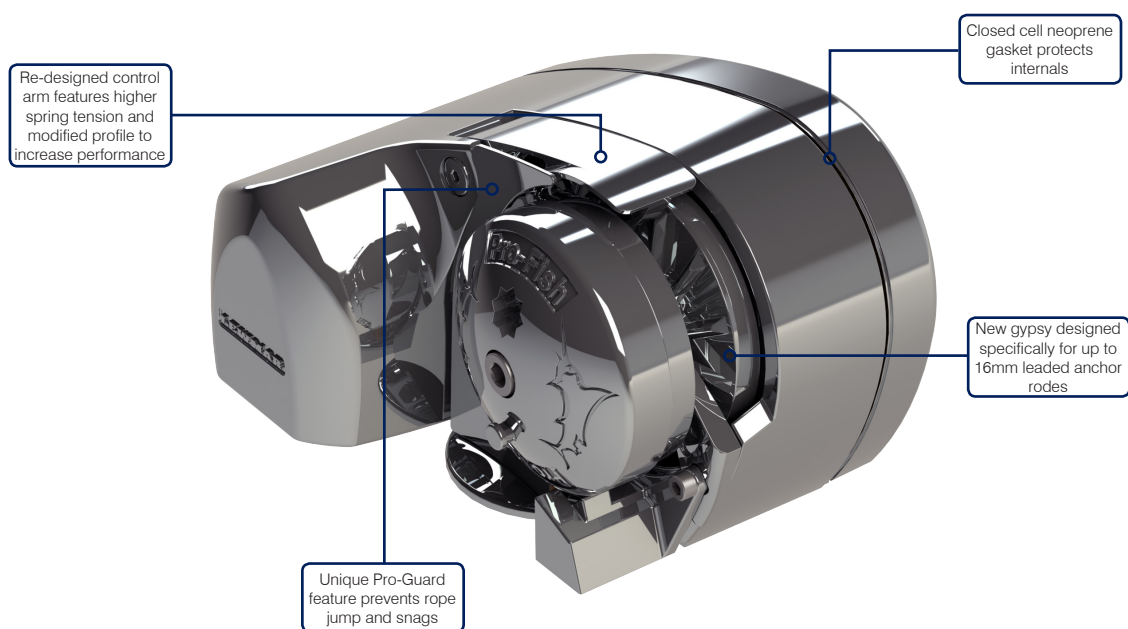
The Pro-Fish, the freefall version of the highly successful Pro-Series, sees a further update for 2013.
