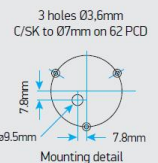
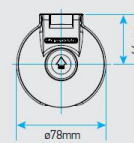
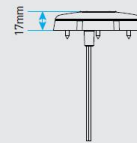
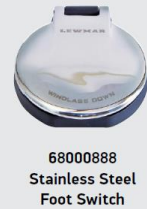
Deck Foot Switch (80mm Diameter) Current

- Must be used with a contactor or control box

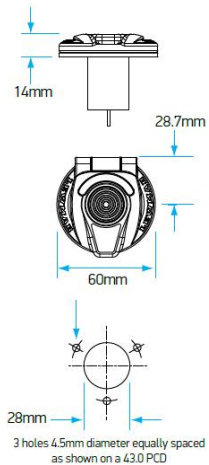

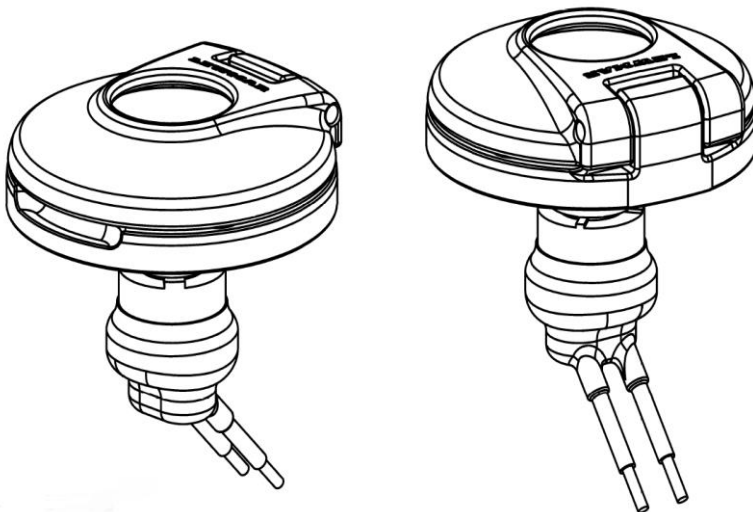


48000100 DECK SWITCH POL SS COVER
