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Introduction

This owner's manual describes the operation of the extend and retract functions of the Lexington Expandable L-Lounge with a retaining bracket.

NOTE: Some models may have a loose back cushion and no retaining bracket.

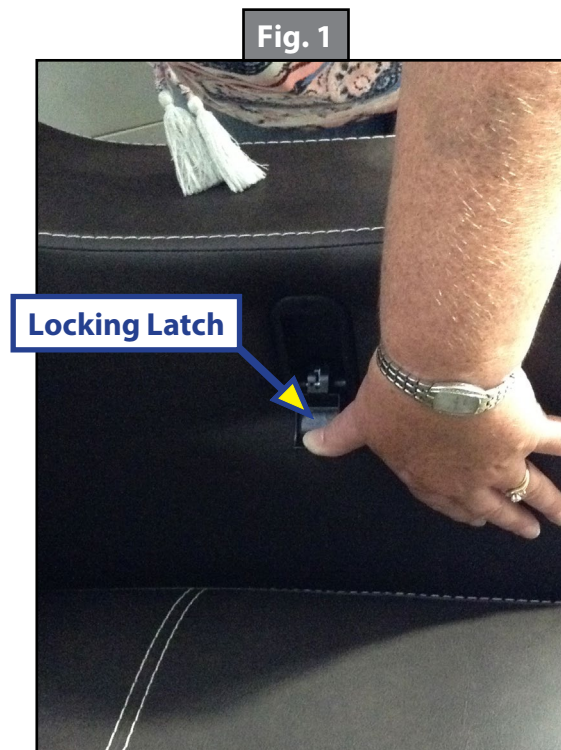
Moving parts can pinch, crush or cut. Keep clear and use caution.

Operation

Expanding L-Lounge

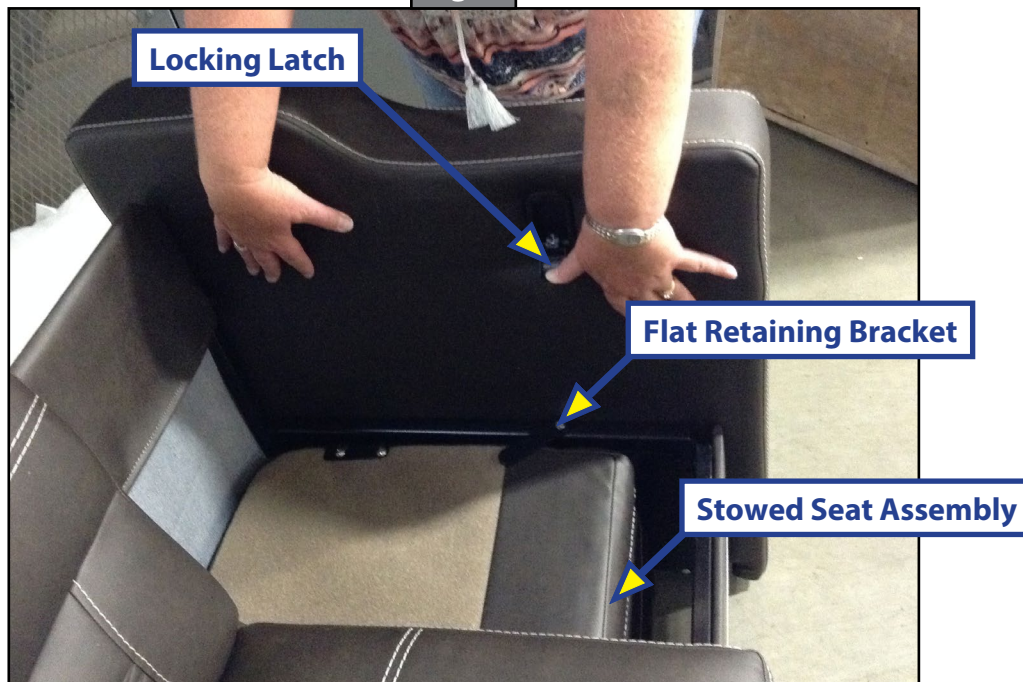
1. Push the expandable seat's armrest locking latch down and hold (Fig. 1).

NOTE: Do not release locking latch until armrest is fully extended.



2. While continuing to hold down the locking latch (Fig. 2), use both hands to pull the armrest straight out. The seat assembly should remain in its stowed position until the armrest is completely extended.

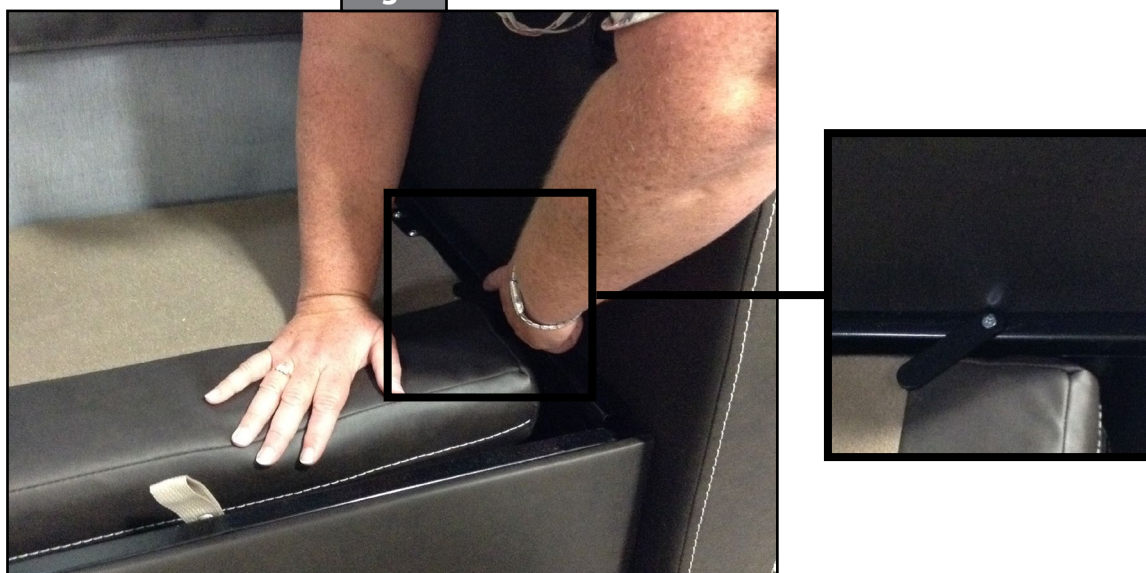
⚠ CAUTION

Mispositioned retaining bracket can damage cushion's fabric. Make sure bracket is aligned with top of side framework and not protruding into the seat cushion's stowage compartment.

3. Push down on back cushion and, if applicable, position flat retaining bracket in-line with the top of the side framework to allow seat assembly to rise out of its stowage compartment.

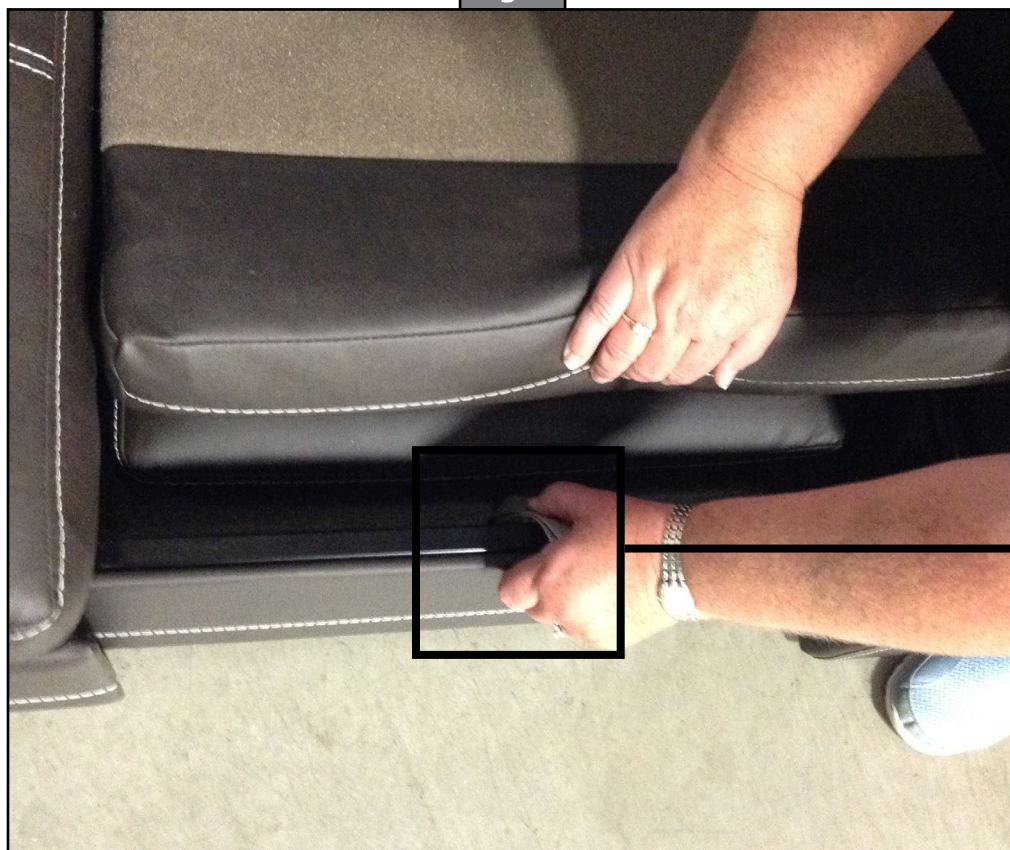
NOTE: Some models may not have a flat retaining bracket.

4. Unsnap the strap from frame (Fig. 4).

5. Using the strap (Fig. 5), firmly pull up and out (Fig. 6) to access the expandable seat.

6. Make sure to position seat cushion all the way forward (Fig. 7) then push back cushion into upright position (Fig. 8).

NOTE: A click sound should be heard when the cushion is in its correct position.

Retracting L-Lounge

1. Pull the back cushion forward.

NOTE: Some models may have a loose back cushion.

2. Place back cushion in down position (Fig. 10).

3. Lift seat cushion up, then push seat assembly downward into opening.

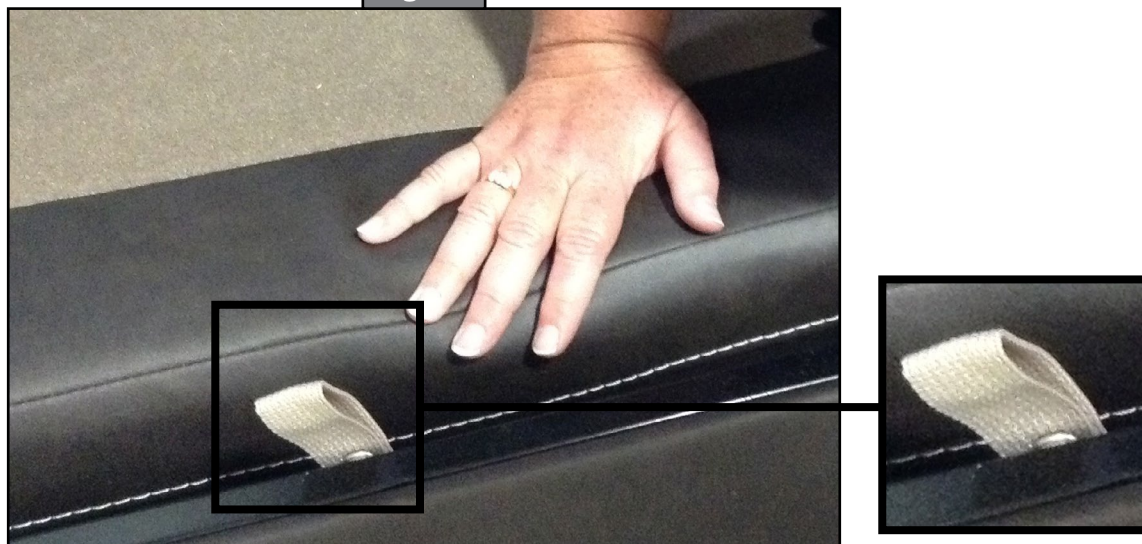
4. Snap strap to frame (Fig. 12).
 - A. With the seat assembly in the down position, move assembly all the way forward.

⚠ CAUTION

Mispositioned retaining bracket can damage cushion's fabric. Make sure bracket is aligned with top of side framework and not protruding into the seat cushion's stowage compartment.

- B. Make sure retaining bracket is not protruding into seat assembly's stowage compartment.

5. Push down on the cushion (Fig. 13), then reposition the flat retaining bracket to hold seat assembly in place (Fig. 3).

6. Push locking latch down and hold (Fig. 14).

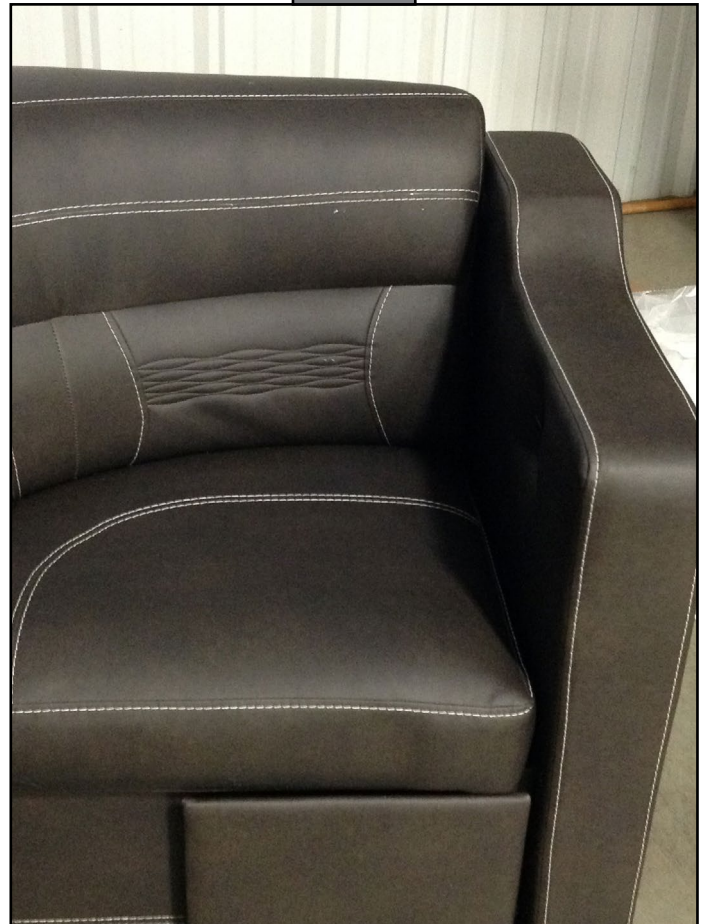
7. While continuing to hold the locking latch down, use both hands (Fig. 15) to firmly push the armrest straight back into its original position (Fig. 16).

NOTE: A click sound should be heard when the expandable seat assembly is in its correct position.
