Purpose

This document outlines the procedure for replacing/installing a 2000 or 3000 series window screen.

Procedure

1. Locate the edge of the inside interior main frame of the window (Fig. 1A).
2. Align the clips (Fig. 2A) located on the back side of the screen to the edge of the inside interior main frame of the window (Fig. 3).

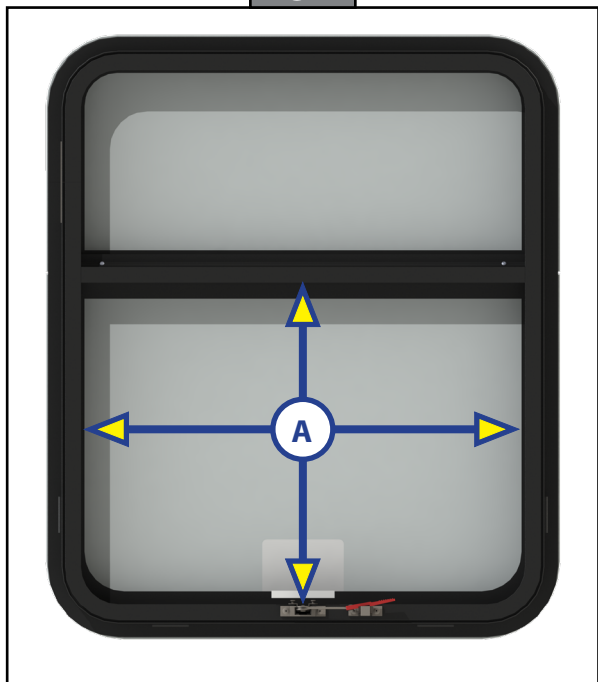

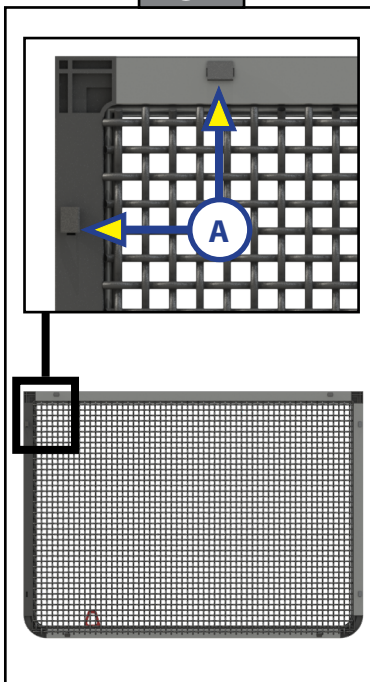
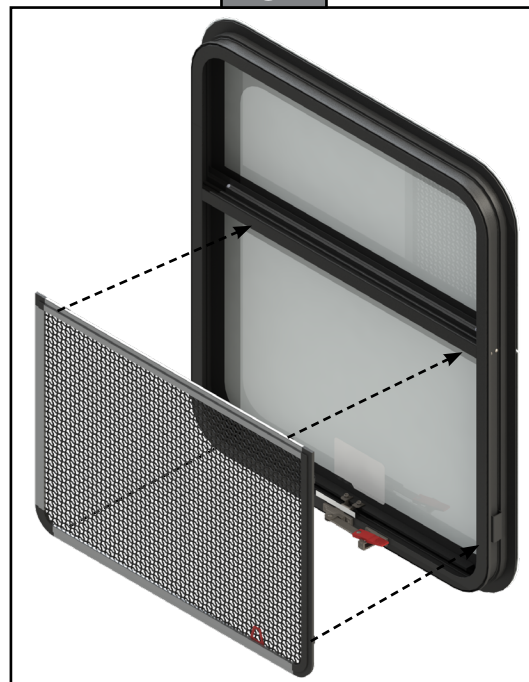

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3. Push the screen forward until all the clip locations snap onto the inside interior edge of the main frame of the window. Check the entire perimeter of the screen that all clips are securely snapped in place.
4. Figure 4 illustrates the completed screen installation.
