Purpose

This document outlines the steps for replacing the vent (Fig. 1) on a 2000 series window.

Safety

Resources Required

- Flat head screwdriver
- Phillips screwdriver
- Ladder

NOTE: Save all removed screws for reinstallation of the window.

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Procedure

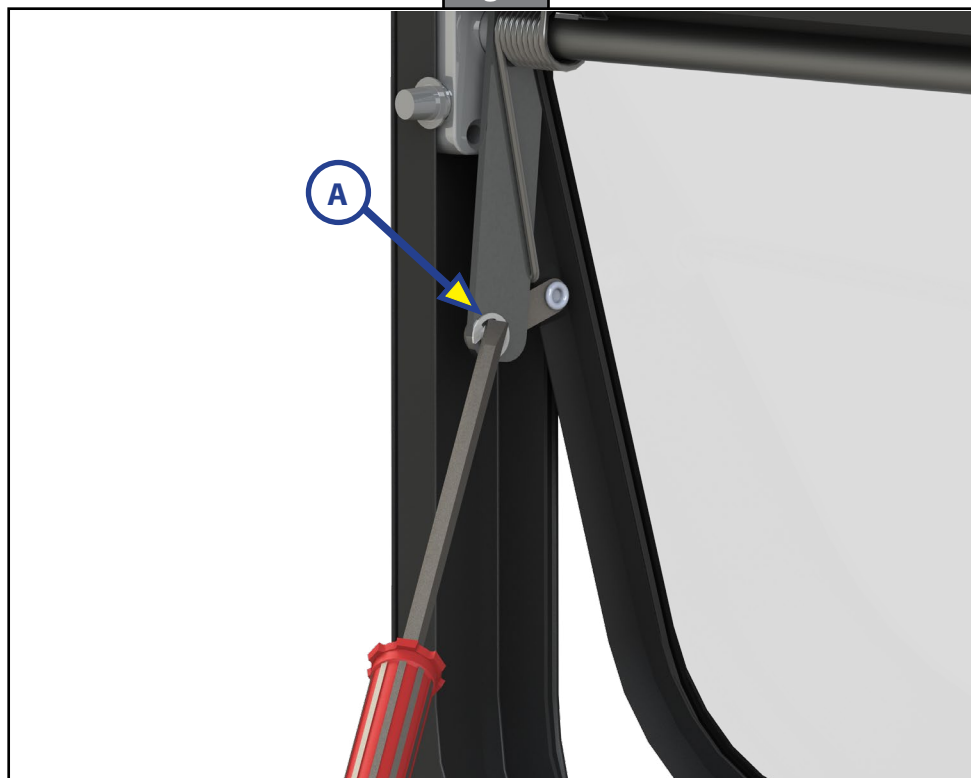
1. Remove the screen (Fig. 2A) and open the window vent.

2. Using a flat head screwdriver, remove the C-clips (Fig. 3A) on the operator arms. Retain C-clips for re-installation.

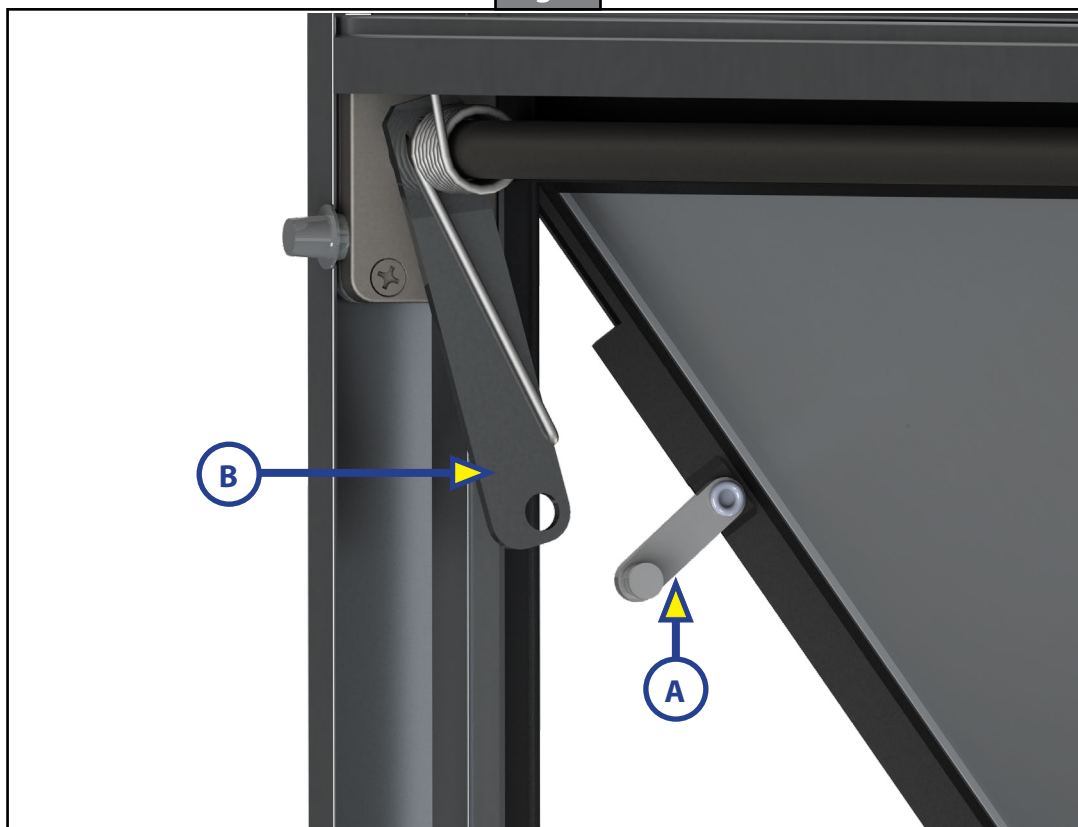

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3. Unfasten the link stud (Fig. 4A) from the window operator arm (Fig. 4B). Repeat for the other side.

4. Using a Phillips screwdriver, remove the set screws (Fig. 5A) on exterior hinge on outside face of the window.

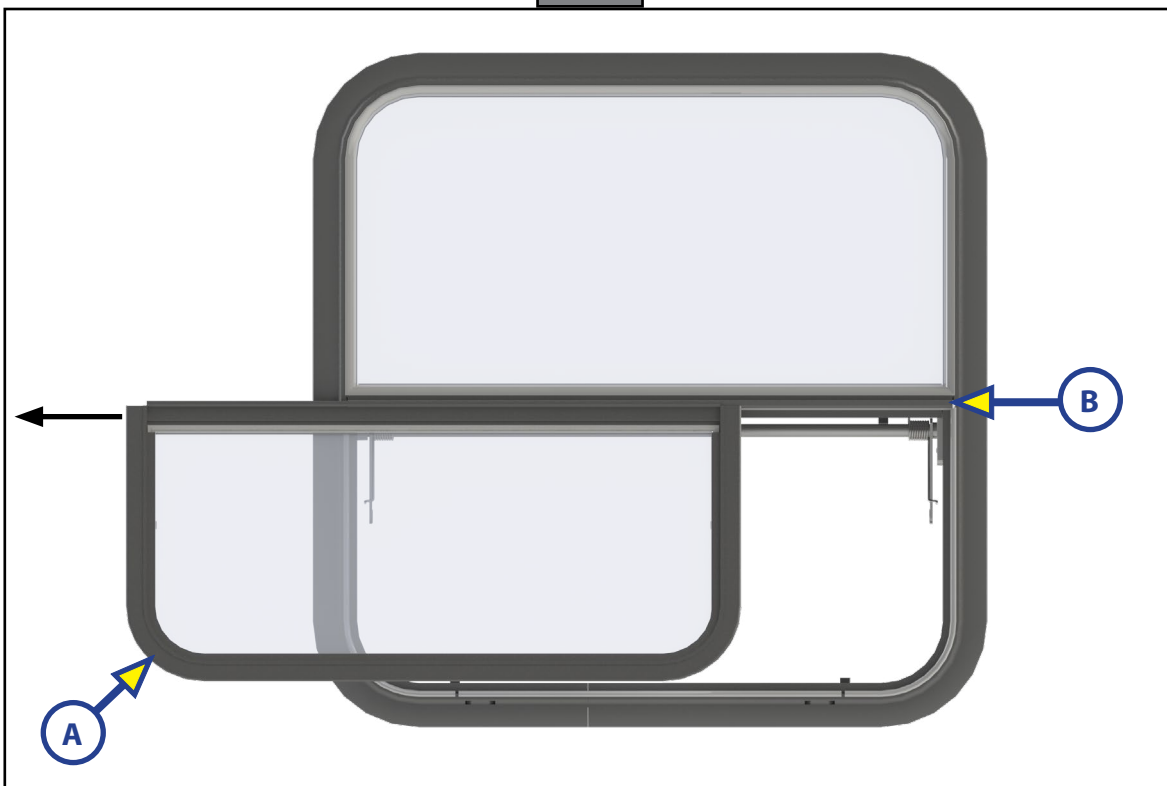

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5. Slide the vent (Fig. 6A) out of the window frame exterior hinge (Fig. 6B).

6. Slide the replacement vent into the window frame exterior hinge.
7. Re-install the previously removed set screws into the exterior hinge (Fig. 7A).

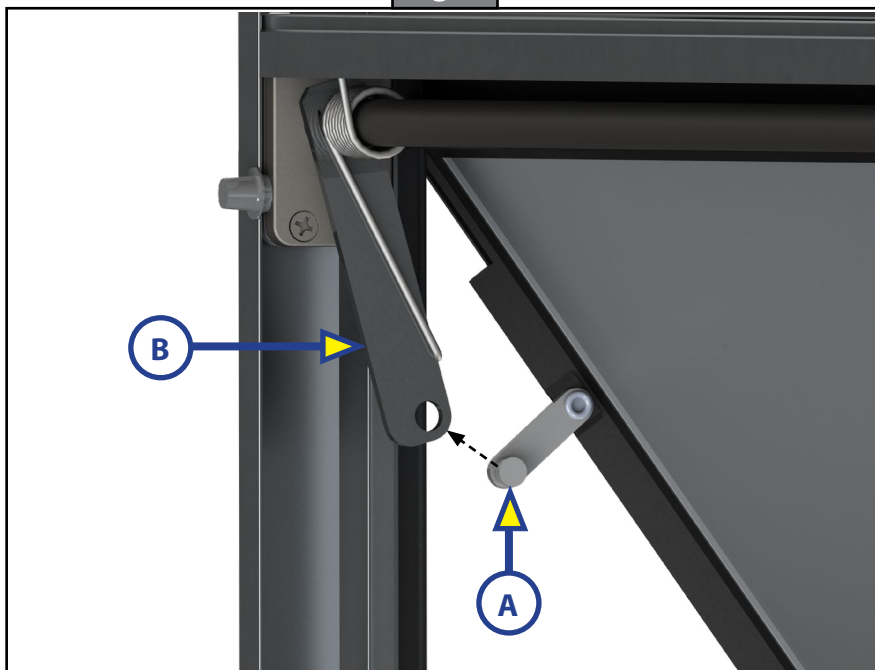

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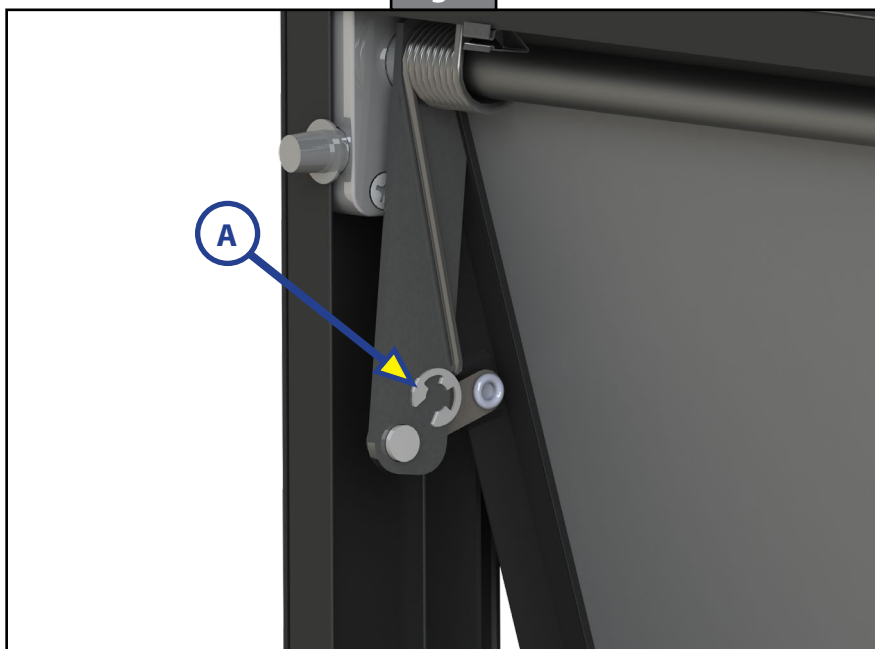
8. Insert link studs (Fig. 8A) into the window operator arms (Fig. 8B).

9. Re-install the c-clips (Fig. 9A) removed in step 2.

10. Re-install the screen removed in step 1.
11. Make sure the window operates properly.
