

Purpose

This document outlines the procedure to remove and replace the actuator's rear strut receiver handle.

Safety

Resources Required

- Phillips screwdriver
- 5/32" hex wrench

Procedure

1. Use a 5/32" hex wrench to remove the two 1/4" hex cap screws (Fig. 1A) in the frame rail (Fig. 1B). Set the hex cap screws aside.
2. Slide the frame rail (Fig. 2B) off the rear strut receiver handle (Fig. 2A).

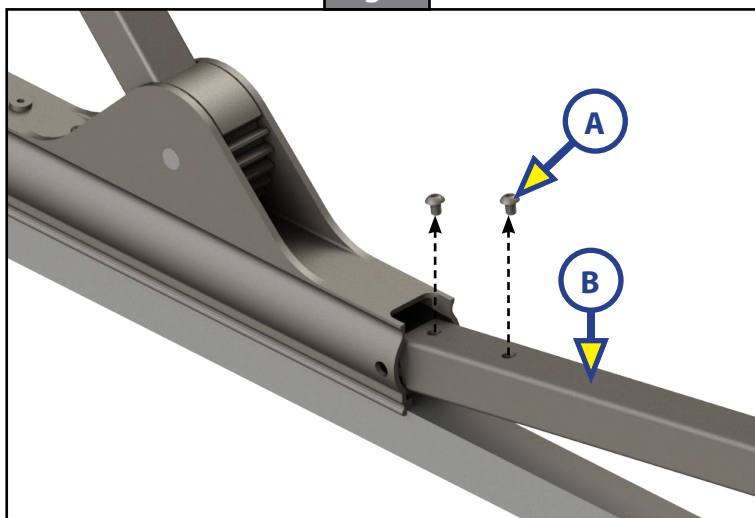
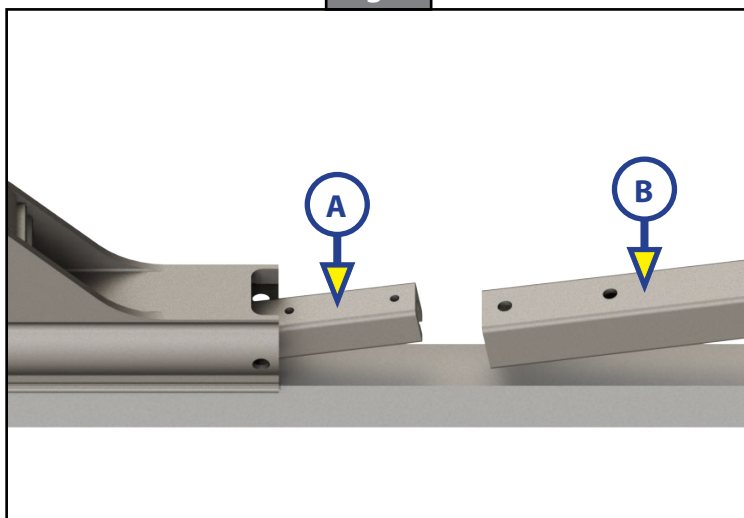

3. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, remove the screw (Fig. 3A) holding the pivot pin (Fig. 3C) in the rear strut receiver handle (Fig. 3B) of the actuator (Fig. 3D). Slide the pivot pin out and set the pivot pin and screw aside. Properly dispose of the old rear strut receiver handle (Fig. 3B).
4. Place the new rear strut receiver handle (Fig. 4A) into the actuator (Fig. 4B). Align the side hole of the rear strut receiver handle (Fig. 4C) with the hole in the actuator (Fig. 4D).

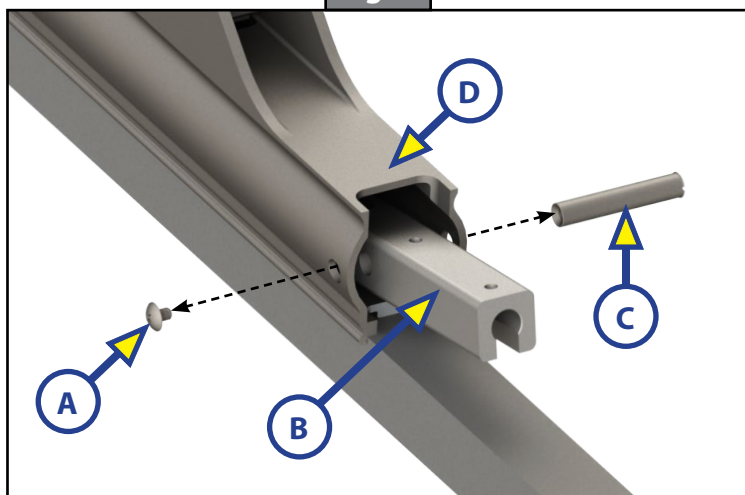
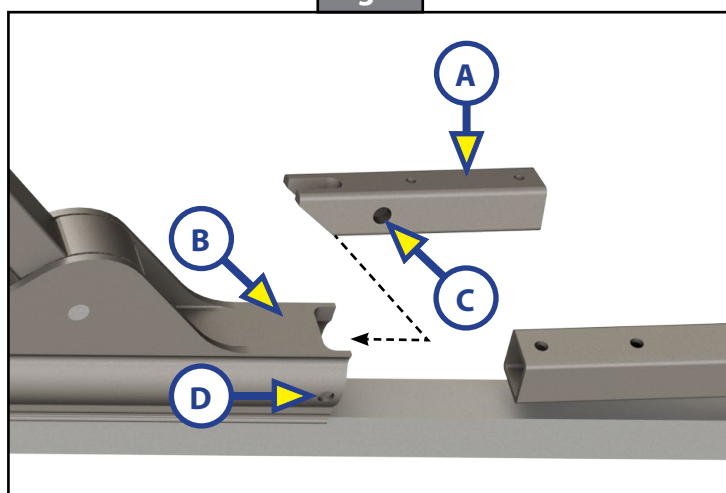

5. Slide the pivot pin (Fig. 5D) through the actuator hole (Fig. 5C), and into the new rear strut receiver handle (Fig. 5B). Reinstall the screw (Fig. 5A) into the pivot pin.
6. Reinstall the frame rail (Fig. 6B) on new rear strut receiver handle. Align the holes of the frame rail with the holes in the new handle and install the two 1/4" hex cap screws (Fig. 6A).

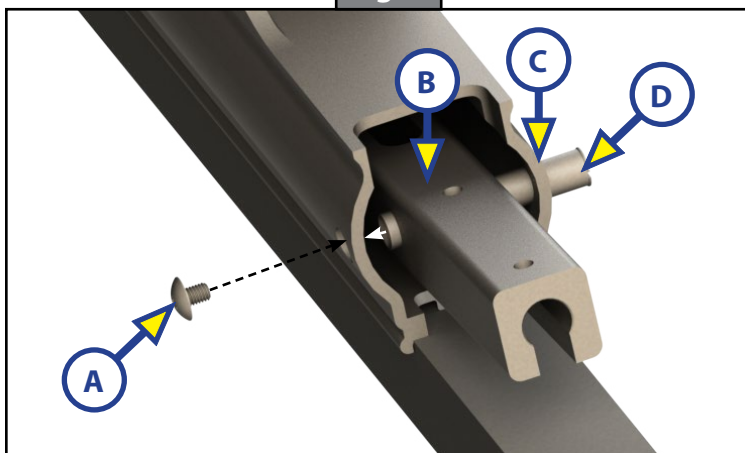
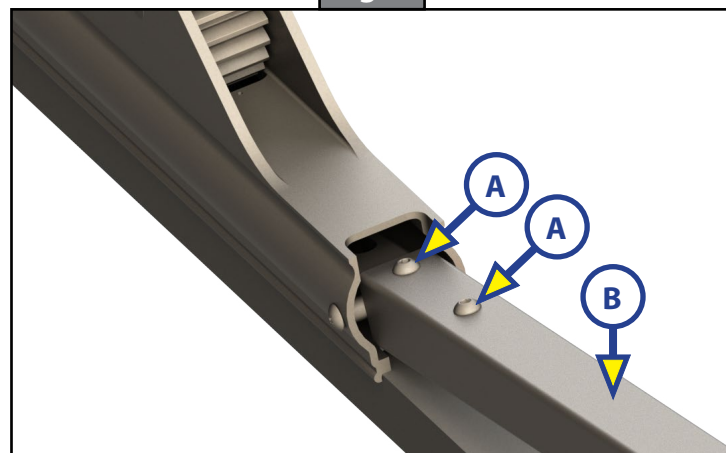
