Essential Ladder Operation Safety

- Do not exceed the 220 lb. (100 kg) maximum weight capacity of the ladder.
- Only one person at any given time should be on the ladder.
- Position the ladder only on a level, stable surface that will not shift or sink under use.
- Do not overreach. Keep your torso between the side rails at all times.
- Always face the ladder when ascending or descending.
- Equipment carried up and down the ladder should be manageable and easy to handle.

Preparation

General Precautions

Before using the ladder the following precautions must be taken.

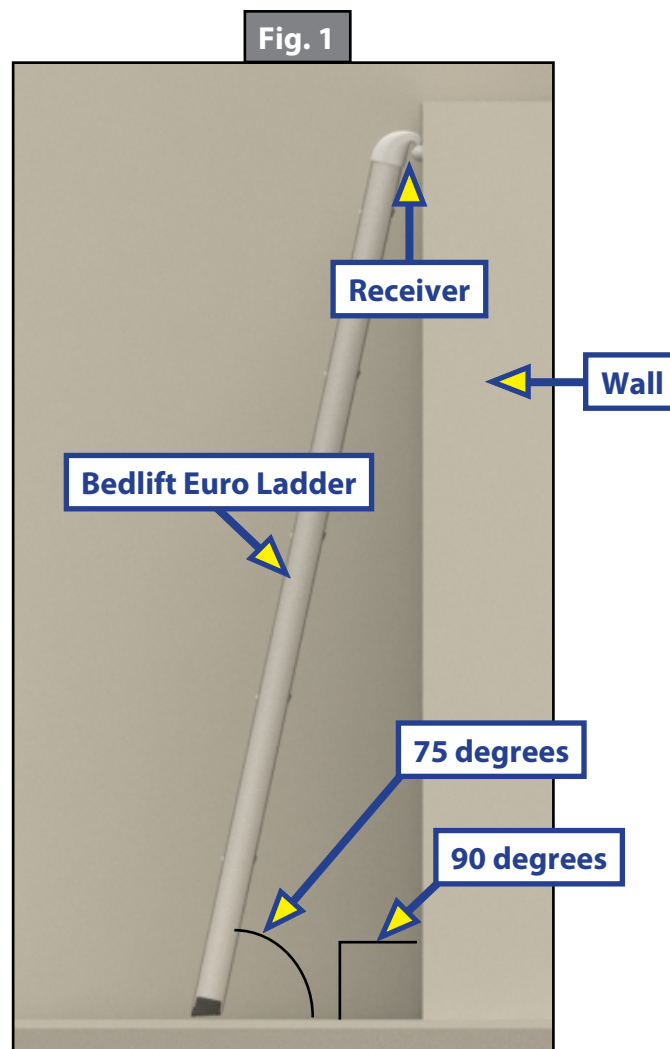
1. If applicable, the unit must be powered off, parked, and on level ground.
2. The ladder must be securely placed into the receivers.
3. Make sure the wall and surrounding floor are free of obstruction and debris.

⚠ CAUTION

Failure to secure ladder into receivers can cause the ladder to fall causing damage to the unit, the ladder, or personal injury.

Understanding the Bedlift Euro Ladder - Standard Version

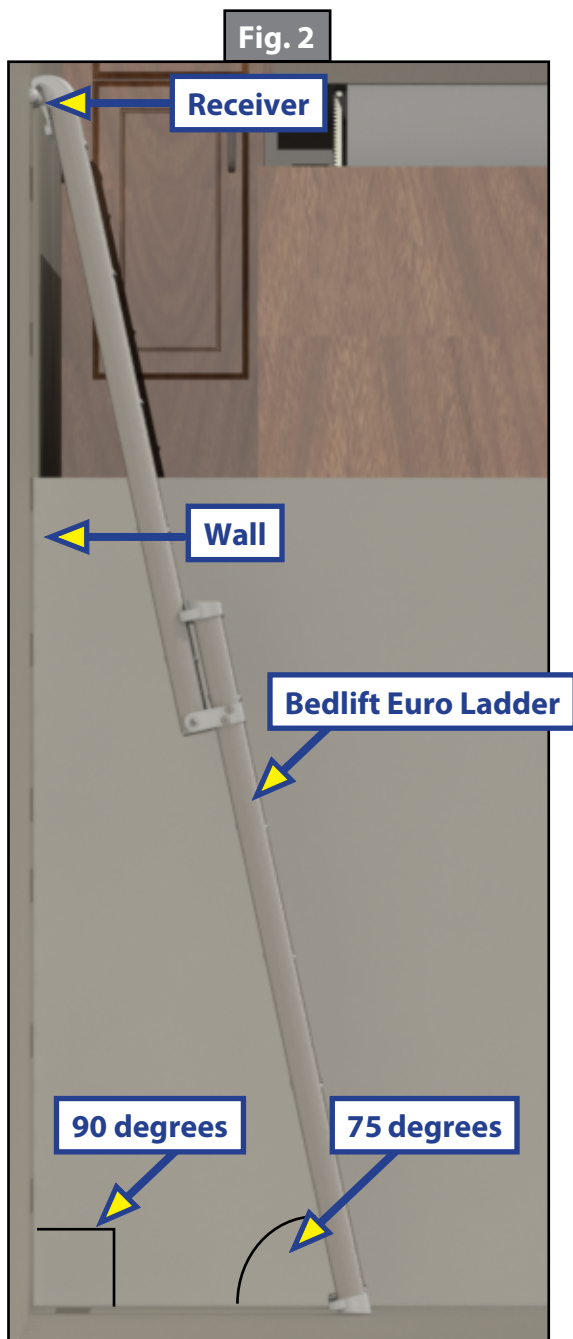
Figure 1 shows the standard version of the Bedlift Euro Ladder.



Understanding the Bedlift Euro Ladder with Extension

For a greater, farther reach, a Bedlift Euro Ladder with Extension is available; this is the folding variation. This ladder functionally operates the same and users should adhere to the previous safety precautions and directions.

- Figure 2 illustrates the Bedlift Euro Ladder with Extension as used in unit.
- Figure 3 shows the ladder in its folded and extended positions.



Installation and Removal - Standard Ladder

1. Make sure unit is parked and turned off.
2. Carefully lift the ladder (Fig. 4A) up so the top hooks (Fig. 4B) catch into receivers (Fig. 4C).
3. Make sure the ladder hooks securely catch the receivers (Fig. 5), and that ladder legs are on the floor.

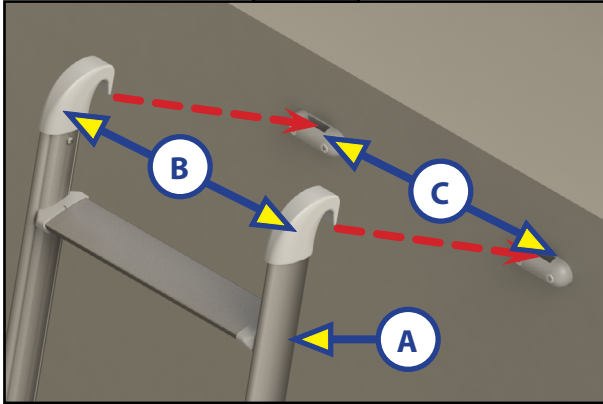
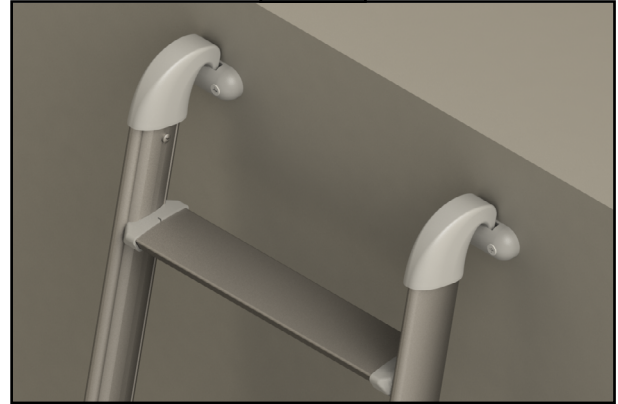

⚠ WARNING

Make sure the right and the left side of the ladder are securely caught and hooked into the receivers. Failure to secure the ladder into the receivers may result in uneven weight distribution as the user climbs the ladder possibly causing personal injury and/or damage to the ladder.

To remove the ladder, just lift the ladder straight out of the receivers.

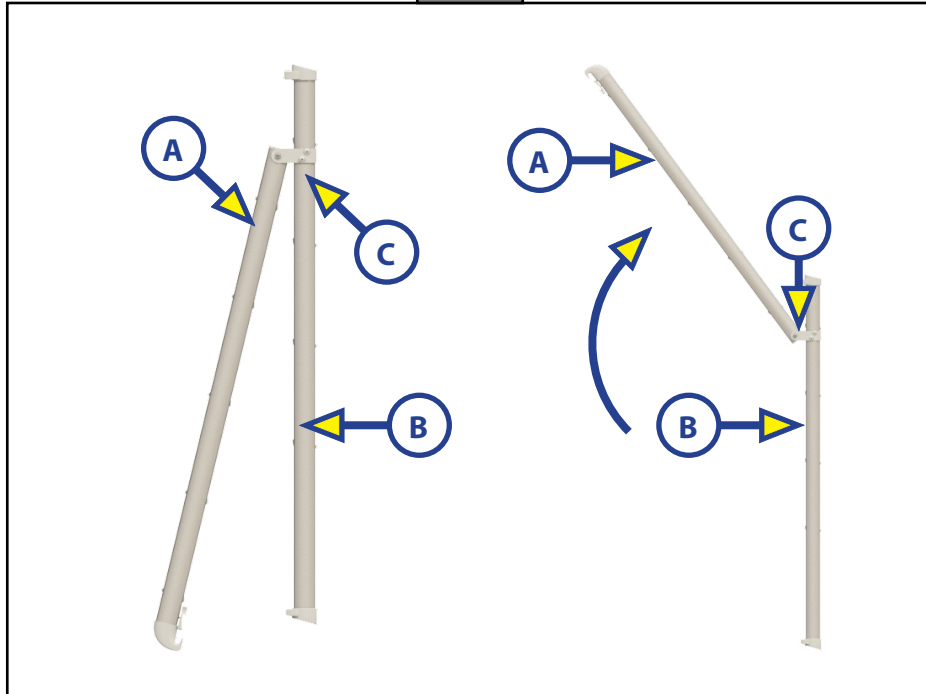

Installation and Removal - Ladder with Extension

Unfolding the Ladder

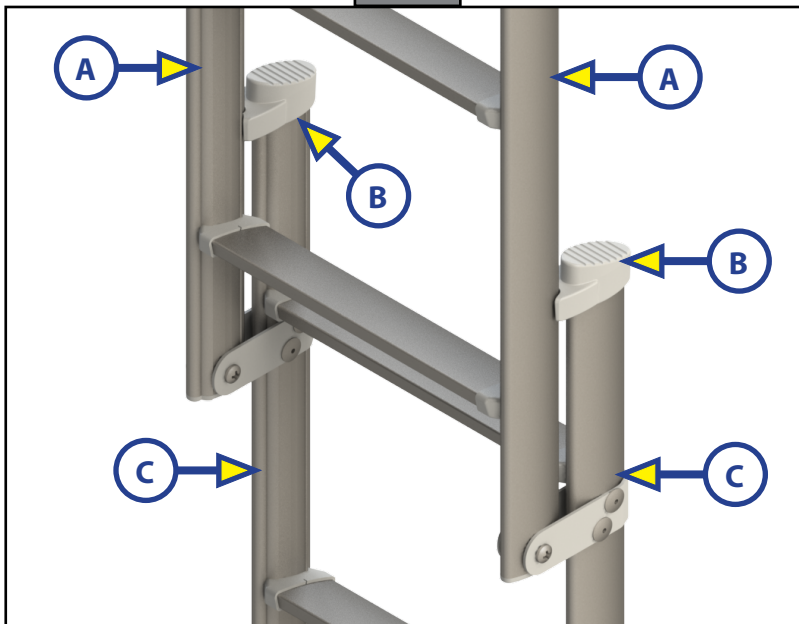
1. Make sure unit is parked and turned off and that the ladder is being unfolded in a area that is free of possible obstructions and on a flat, secure surface.
2. Using 1 to 2 people, unfold the ladder by pulling the upper half (Fig. 6A) away from the lower half (Fig. 6B) leveraging the hinge (Fig. 6C).

3. The ladder will unfold and the ladder's upper profile legs (Fig. 7A) will rest into the stops (Fig. 7B) at the top of the lower profile legs (Fig. 7C).

Attaching Ladder to Receivers

1. Carefully lift the ladder (Fig. 8A) up so the top hooks (Fig. 8B) catch into receivers (Fig. 8C).
2. Make sure the ladder hooks securely catch the receivers (Fig. 9), and that ladder legs are on the floor.

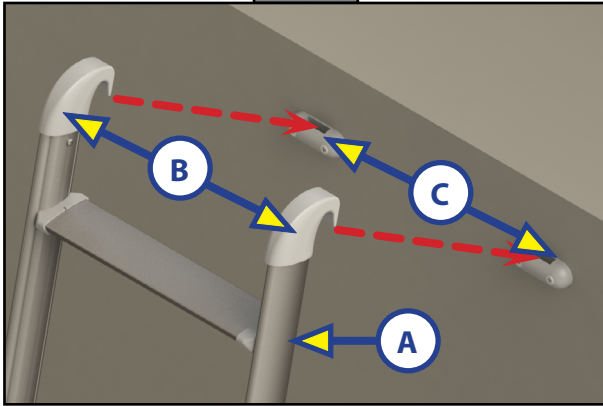
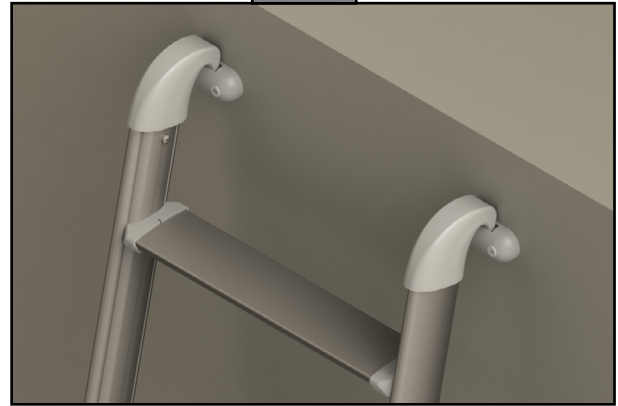
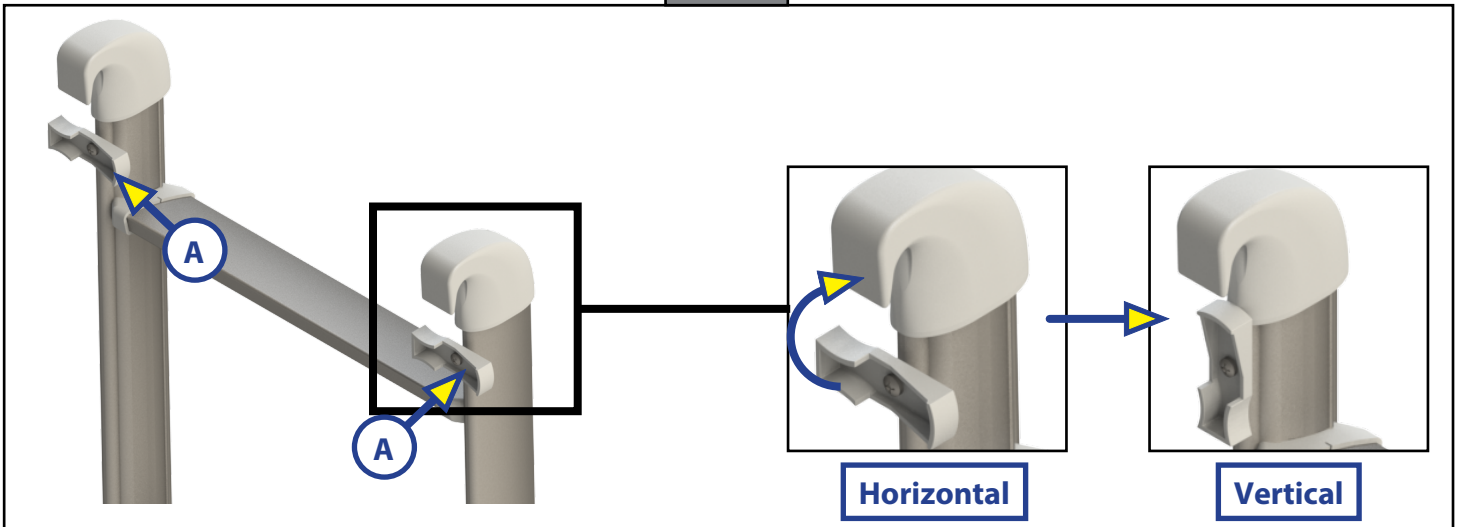

3. Turn support knobs (Fig.10A) vertically to lock the ladder into the receivers.

Removal and Folding

⚠ WARNING

Always remove, fold and stow the ladder prior to travel. Failure to properly remove and stow the ladder could result in personal injury or property damage.

To remove the ladder, turn the support knobs horizontally (Fig. 10) then lift the ladder straight out of the receivers.

Using 1 to 2 people, fold the upper half of the ladder down over the lower half.

Ladder Use

Make sure ladder is secure prior to use:

1. Face the Bedlift Euro Ladder.
2. Keep body centered between the legs of the Bedlift Euro Ladder.
3. Climb ladder slowly and steadily.



Do not overreach. Keep your torso between the rails at all times.

Maintenance

Regularly inspect the receiver and ladder for any signs of wear that may affect safety or the stability.
