Safety Information

LCI recommends that installations only be done by a qualified technician. LCI also recommends that the technician should use appropriate personal protective equipment, such as safety glasses and gloves, during the installation process.



Failure to follow the instructions provided in this manual may result in injury, component damage, or voiding of the component warranty.

Installation

NOTE: All caulks, adhesives, sealants **MUST** be compatible with ABS.

1. All adhesion surfaces **MUST** be clean and dry prior to installation. This includes the wall kit panels, corner pieces, and alcove walls.
2. Test fitting of all pieces of the tile trim kit prior to installation is recommended.
3. For kits with vertical panels, install these first by removing tape release paper and properly position panel so tape adheres to wall panel.

NOTE: Vertical panel should fit over the end of the tub flange, thus concealing it. Press panel firmly against flange and wall with your hand or with a wall roller.

4. To install horizontal wall panels, remove tape release paper and properly position panels with bottom edge resting on the tub deck. Press panel firmly against wall with your hand or with a wall roller.
5. Remove backing from tape on corner piece and position it so the top of the corner piece is aligned with the top of the installed horizontal panels. Press corner firmly to ensure tape adheres to trim kit wall panels.
6. The above trim kit instructions were written to cover installations using the tape pre-applied to the panels and corner(s). Optional use of rivets, ABS friendly adhesives, or extra tape is acceptable and up to the discretion of the manufacturer.

Care and Cleaning Instructions

LCI Thermoforming units are easy to keep clean and sparkling. Simply use warm water and a mild soap solution. Rub with a soft cloth and rinse thoroughly with warm water. Do not use abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals.

Recommended Cleaners: Mild soap and water, Fantastic Spray Cleaner, Top Job Liquid (3% solution), Spic and Span Pine Cleaner, Joy Liquid Detergent (5% solution), Gel-Gloss, "The Works" Tub and Shower Cleaner, DuPont 7 Auto "Polish," and DuPont 606S Auto "Polish." All cleaning should be followed by a warm water rinse.

Do Not Use: Disinfectant sprays, disinfectant foams, pine oil cleaners, citrus-based cleaners, abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, Scrubbing Bubbles, petroleum-based products, auto rubbing compounds or industrial or commercial cleaners.



If any adverse chemicals, as described in the Care and Cleaning Instructions, come in contact with any surface, immediately rinse thoroughly with clean water.

With the exception of Permalux® and Permalux Plus® products, fading or discoloration may result from continued exposure to direct sunlight. Keep blinds or drapes closed during periods of the day when the product is exposed to direct sunlight.

Do not place any hot objects or objects such as candles or cigarettes on the surface of this product. These objects may scar, burn or ignite this plastic.
