Introduction

This document details how to properly clean and maintain LCI furniture.

Procedures

LCI's "Leather Like" furniture is a polyvinyl-blend material (Fig. 1 or Fig. 2) that should only be cleaned with a mild soap and warm water. For tougher stains the use of a mild, non-alcohol based cleaning fluid is acceptable to remove tough stains. Clean the area with warm water afterwards to remove any residual left behind.

For LCI furniture covered in fabric that is not polyvinyl-blend (Fig. 3 or Fig. 4) spot cleaning with mild soap and water is recommended to remove any stains on the fabric.

The use of any leather treatment or protectant is not advised as this may degrade the material and cause premature peeling and cracking of the material.

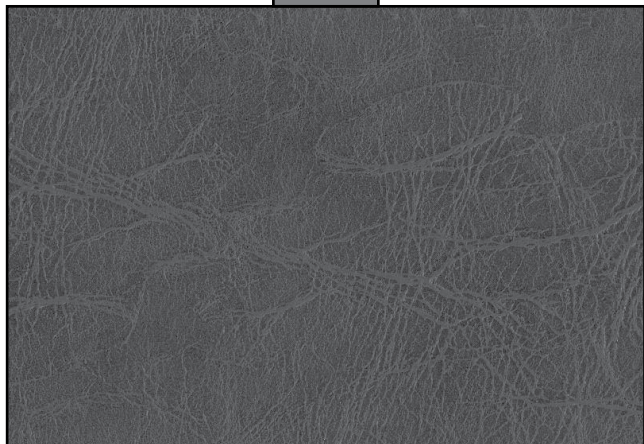


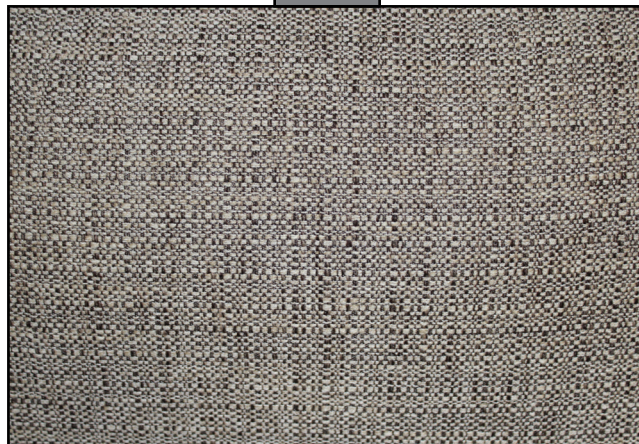
