Introduction

The purpose of this document is to provide information on KwikEE Controllers with part numbers [379146](#), 786949 and 776367.

Controllers are equipped with an ignition override system to prevent the vehicle from being driven with the step extended. When the step is locked in the extended position, the door is closed, and the ignition is turned on, the ignition override system will automatically retract the step.

NOTE: Refer to vehicle OEM owner's manual (or OEM Requirements) which will provide switch position of 'on' or 'off' for the step lock position.

Please note that this is a change from the old "power switch," which needed to be in the "off" position to lock the step out.

Operation

When the step switch is in the 'step lock' position, the step will remain locked in the extended position. The step cannot be locked in the retracted position.

NOTE: Refer to vehicle OEM owner's manual (or OEM Requirements) which will provide switch position of 'on' or 'off' for the step lock position.)

If the ignition is turned 'on' (whether the step switch is 'on' or 'off'), the step will follow the door.

- Door Open = Step Extended
- Door Closed = Step Retracted
