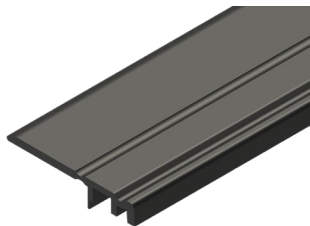
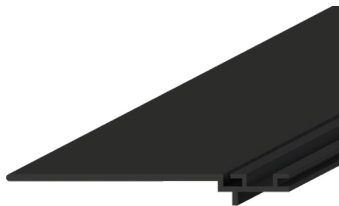
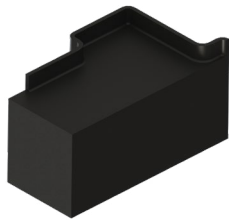


SLIDE-OUTS

Callout	Description	Boyd Part Number	Location	Picture
A	Integrated wear bar/ramp	3198	On the trailer floor in the recessed area for the slide-out room (Fig. 1).	
B	Dual durometer top and bottom wipe seal with EK bulb receiver	3249	Top inside/outside and bottom outside of slide-out opening (Fig. 2).	
C	Black rubber slide-on D-seal	2004	The perimeter of the outside and inside of the slide-out room (Fig. 3).	
D	Injection molded left-hand notched corner pan	3259	Bottom left-hand side of the slide-out room opening (Fig. 4).	
E	Injection molded Right-hand notched corner pan	3260	Bottom right-hand side of the slide-out room opening (Fig. 5).

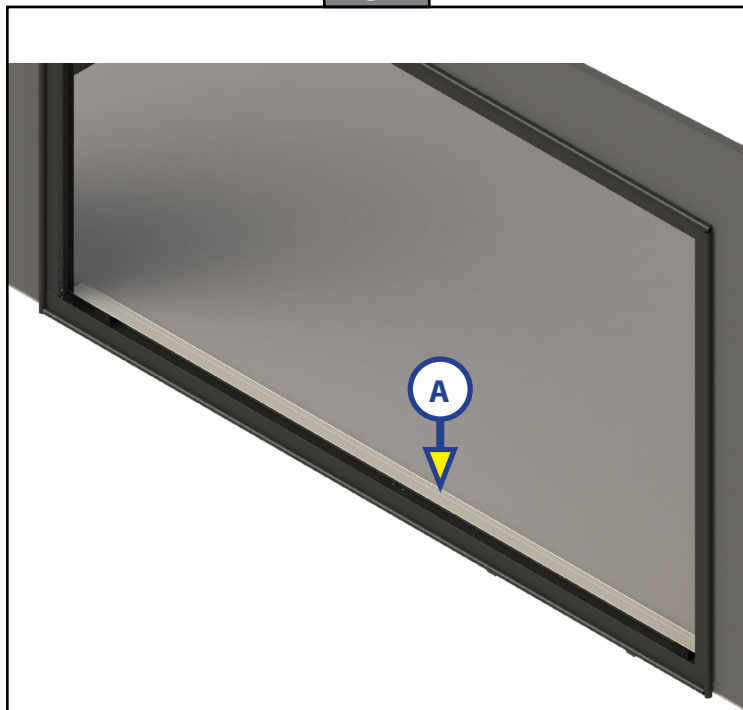
