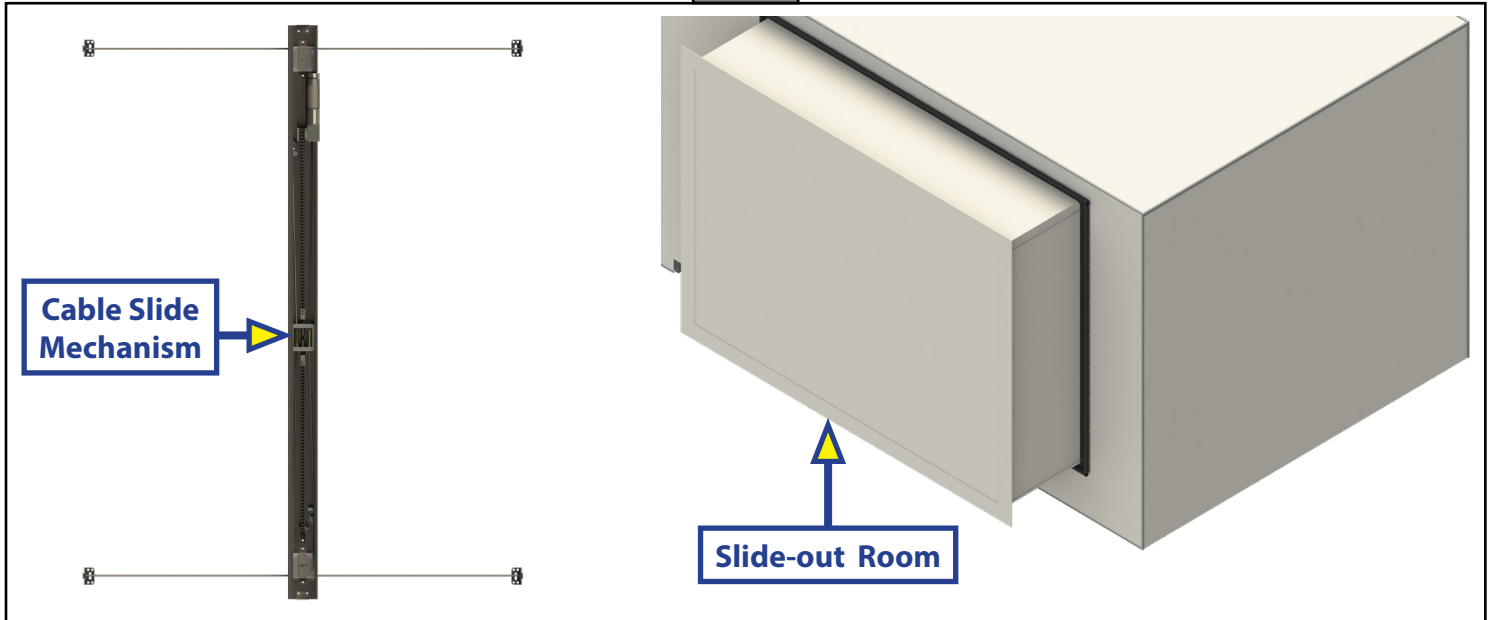


SLIDE-OUTS

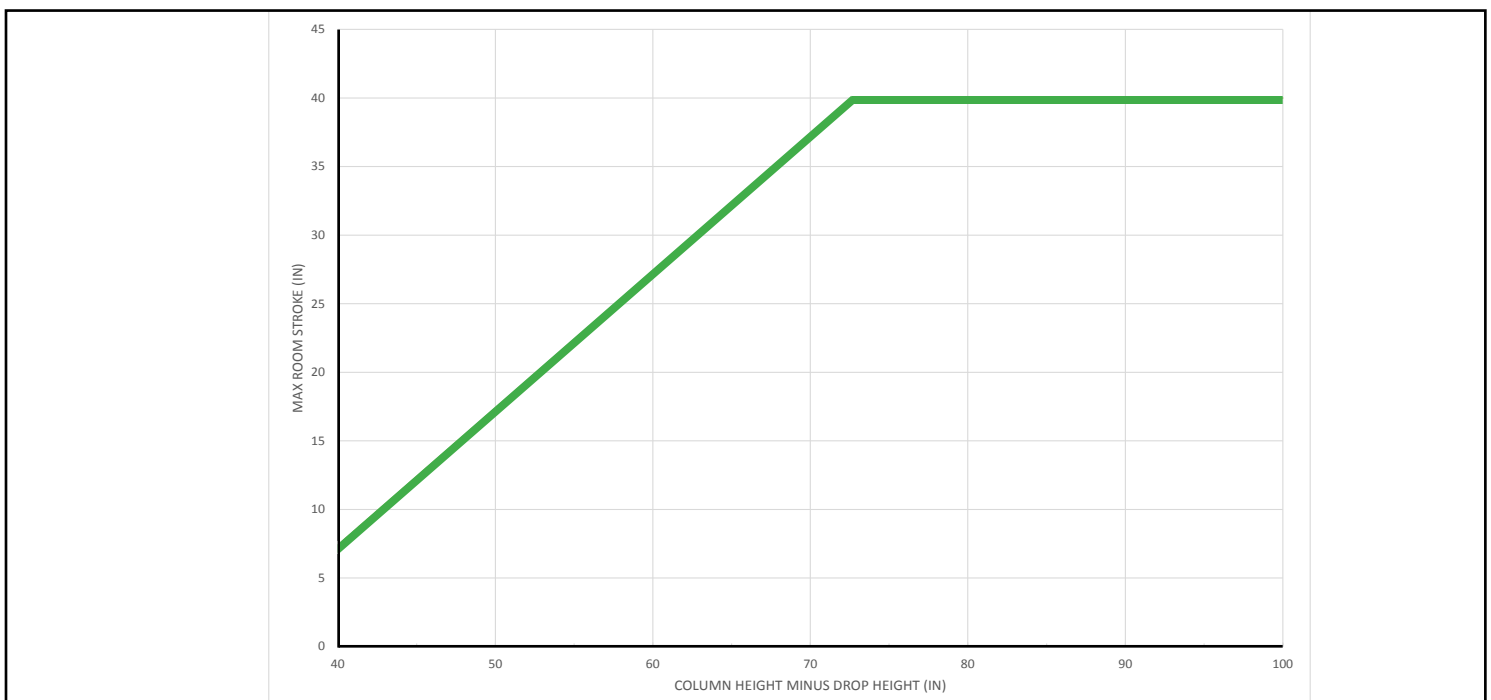
