

KITCHEN AND BATH

Purpose

To maintain and protect the finish of the faucets.

Safety

CAUTION

Wear eye protection and any other appropriate personal protective equipment when performing maintenance.

CAUTION

Moving parts can pinch, crush, or cut. Keep clear and use caution.

Resources Required

- Toothpaste
- Soft-bristle toothbrush
- Soft cloth
- Warm water

General Maintenance

Clean the faucet periodically.

NOTE: Avoid abrasive cleaners, steel wool and chemical solutions as these will dull the finish and void the warranty.

1. Apply a coat of toothpaste to a wet soft-bristle toothbrush.
2. Brush over the surface of the faucet.
3. After cleaning, rinse the faucet thoroughly with water, washing away all the remains of the toothpaste.
4. Rub dry with a soft cloth.
