



Purpose

This document illustrates the location of the frame identification tags for both 5th wheels and travel trailers.

NOTE: Frame identification tags are adhesive-backed white labels with black print (Fig. 1).

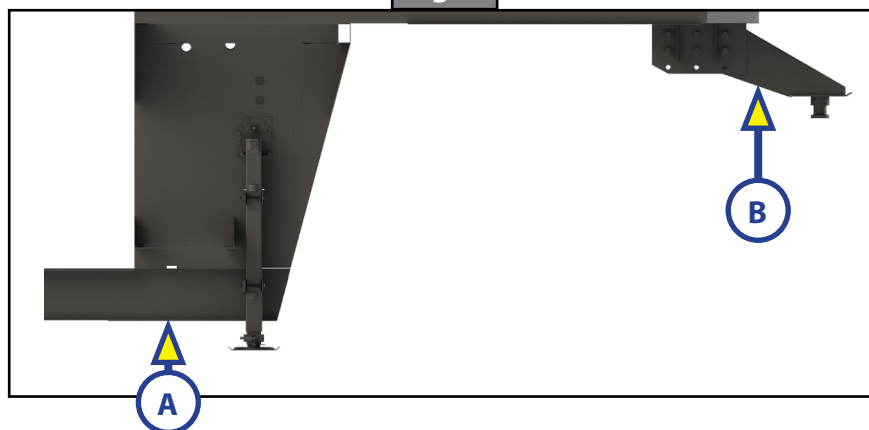

5th Wheels

On 5th wheel units, one frame tag is located on the underside of the trailer, behind the landing gear (Fig. 2A). Another frame tag is placed on the arm of the pin box (Fig. 2B).

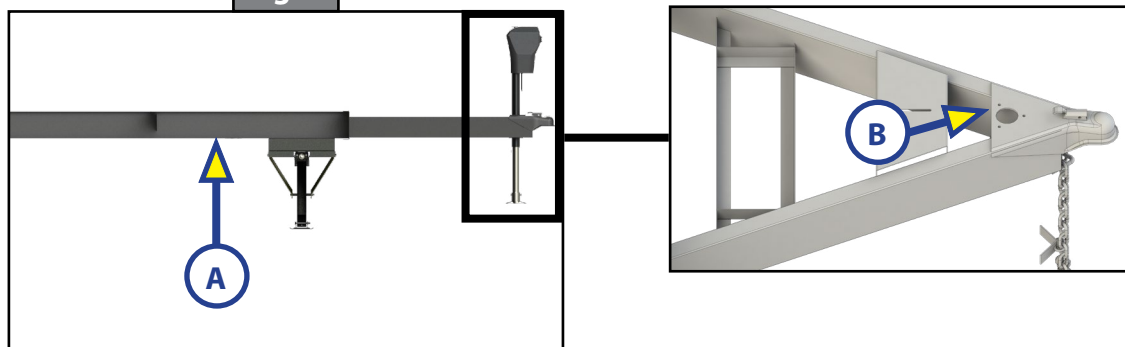

Travel Trailers

On travel trailers, one frame tag is located on the underside of the trailer attached to the I-beam (Fig. 3A). The frame tag can be placed either on the roadside or curbside of the trailer. Another frame tag is placed roadside, on the inside of the A-frame, under the coupler (Fig. 3B).
