Purpose

To maintain and extend the product life of the Ground Control Travel Trailer Leveling System product line.

Safety

Wear eye protection and any other appropriate personal protective equipment when performing maintenance.

Resources Required:

- Lint-free cloth
- Silicone lubricant

Maintenance Steps

1. For optimum performance, the system requires full battery current and voltage. The battery must be maintained at full capacity.
2. Check the terminals and other connections at the battery, the controller, and the jacks for corrosion, and loose or damaged connections.
3. Remove dirt and road debris from jacks as needed.
4. Lightly lubricate the jack screw and wipe off any excess lubrication, leaving only a thin coating for protection.
5. If jacks are down for extended periods, it is recommended to spray exposed leveling jack rods with a silicone lubricant every three months for protection. If the trailer is located in a salty environment, it is recommended to spray the rods every four to six weeks.
