

LEVELING AND STABILIZATION

Purpose

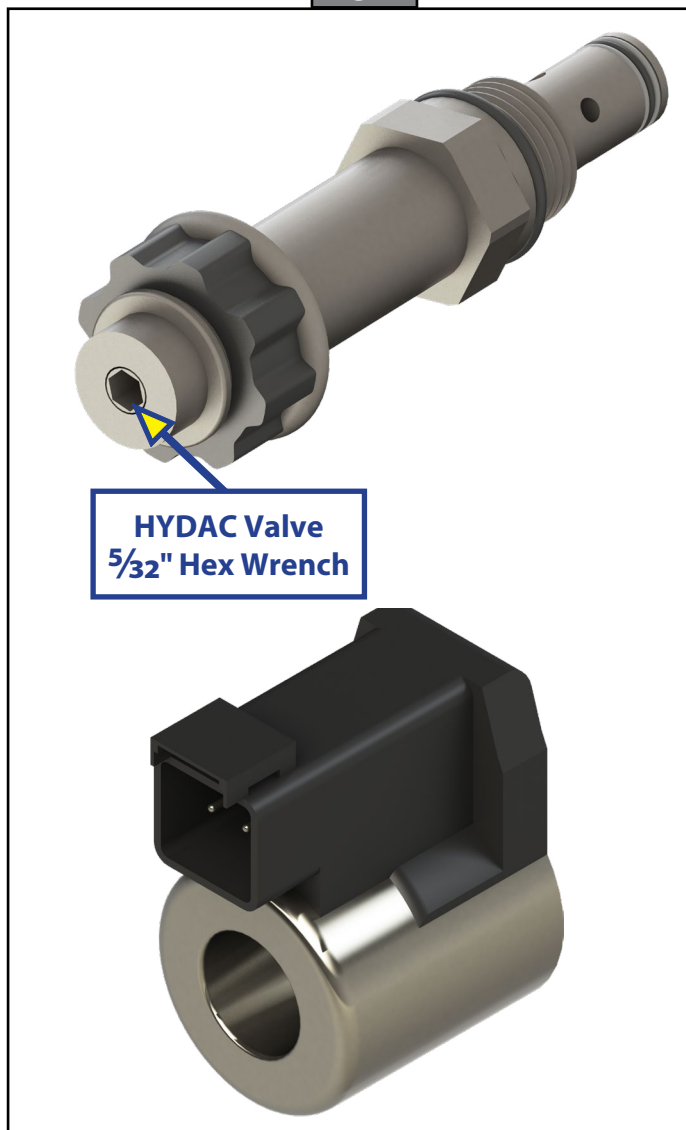
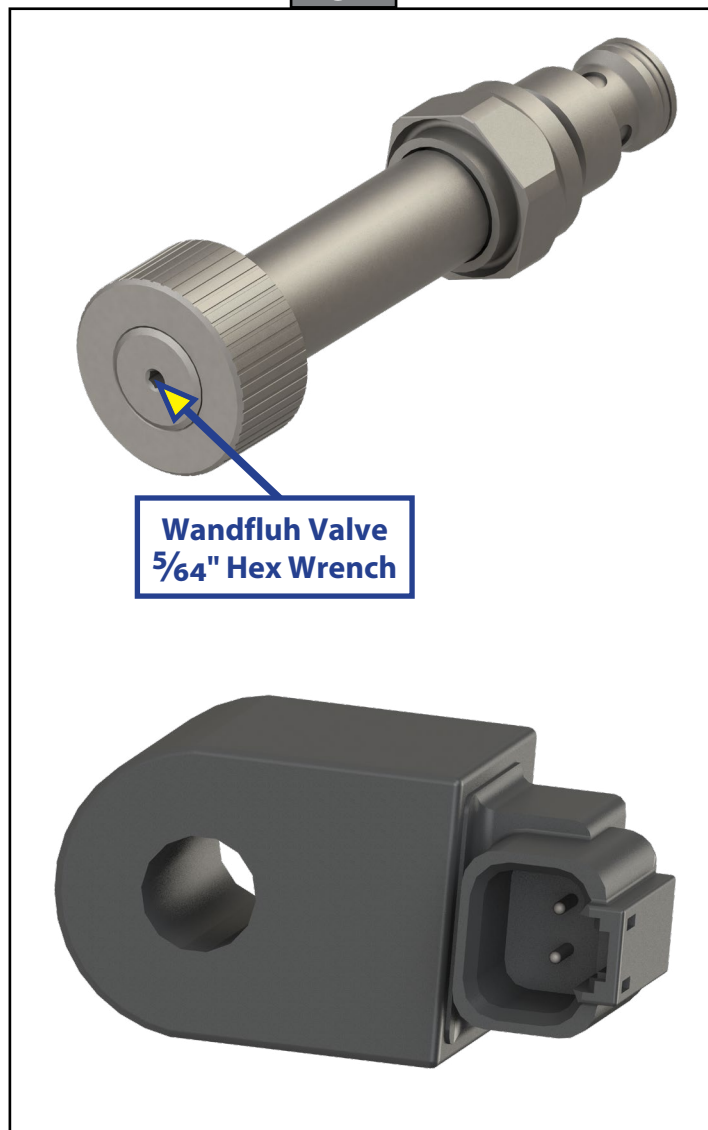


Fig. 2



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

This document identifies the manual override hex wrench required to open the various cartridge valves. The HYDAC cartridge valve, shown with its associated coil (Fig. 1), has a $\frac{5}{32}$ " manual override. The Wandfluh cartridge valve, shown with its coil (Fig. 2), has a $\frac{5}{64}$ " manual override.
