

SLIDE-OUTS

A revision has been made to the Inner Tube Assembly on Through Frame Slide-outs. The Rear Roller ([104475](#)) and Roller Shaft ([105893](#)) have been removed and replaced with a Wear Tab ([277882](#)). These new Inner Tube Assemblies are 100% interchangeable with the former design. This change was made to reduce noise created by the Rear Roller. See the illustrations below. 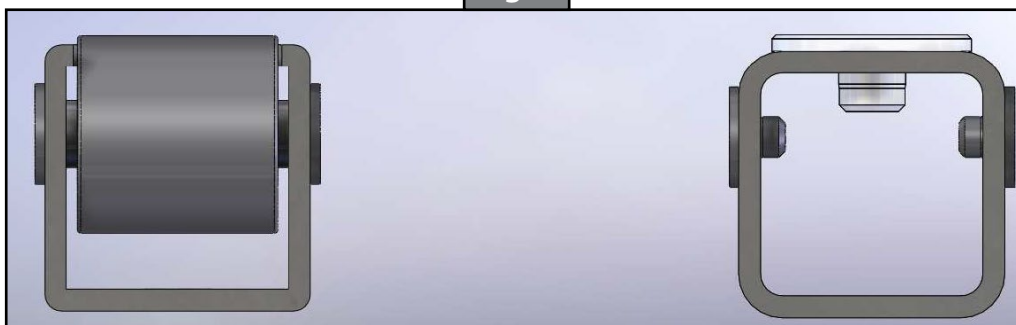
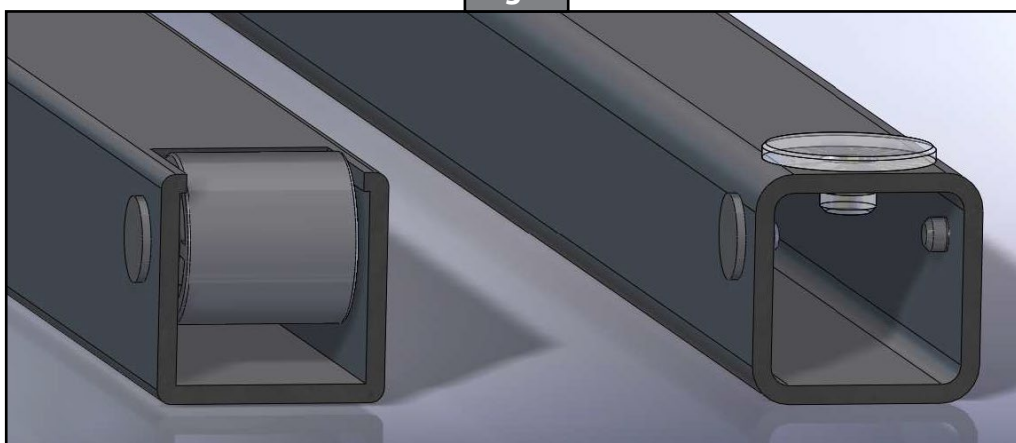
