Production Labels Placement

EVERY PRODUCT WE MAKE MUST HAVE A PRODUCTION LABEL!

In an effort to maintain quality and consistency, all law labels will be placed as follows:

Hide-a-bed (HAB):

Effective 11-1-14 it is stapled inside the front panel of the drawer.

Before 11-1-14, it was stapled to the to the left rear when looking at the HAB from the back. In some cases , there may be one label on one arm and one on the other (ex. Skyline).

Tri-fold Sofa:

It is located on the back of the arm.

Before 11-1-14, it was located on the back side of the right hand facing arm or on the inside of the back support rail.

Dinette:

It is sewn on the bottom side of cushions near the zipper.

Flips - Jack Knife - Roll Over - HappiJac:

It is sewn on the back of the seat.

Specialty items (U-Sofa, Sectionals, J-Lounge):

It is located on the back of the sofa with no specific side.

Rockers:

It is stapled to the bottom of the rocker next to the base.

Recliners:

It is stapled on the back side of the recliner.

Barstools - Euro Chairs:

It is glued to the bottom of the seat or ottoman.

Thomas Payne Collection Theater Seating:

It is stapled on the leg rest bottom or on the back behind cover.

Thomas Payne Tri-fold Sofa:

It is located on the back of the arm.

Thomas Payne Jack Knife - Happijac Sofa:

It is sewn on the back of the seat.
