



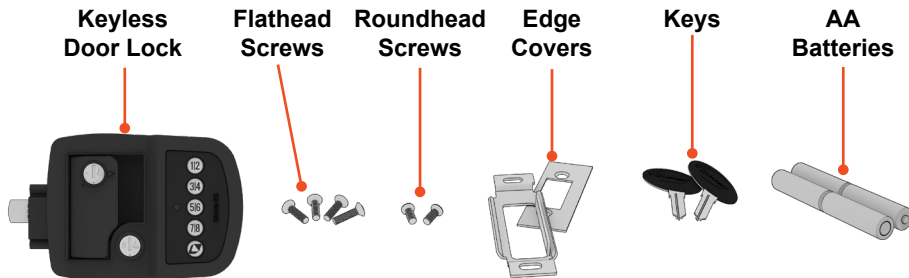
Lippert Keyless RV Door Lock with Bluetooth™



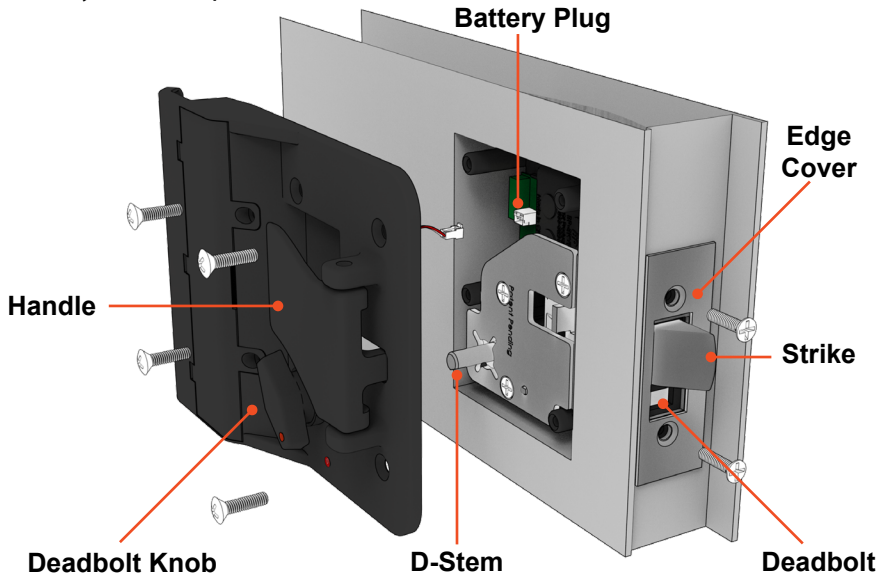
Introduction

Lippert Keyless RV Door Lock with Bluetooth is a 4-keypad button programmable deadbolt lock, and self-contained electronic RV latch with Bluetooth, and AISentis HSS.

Assembly and Components



Resources Required

△ Putty Knife or Plastic Scraper

△ Phillips Screwdriver

Preparation

1. Remove old lock from door. It may be necessary to consult existing door lock instructions for removal tips.
2. Clean the cut-out area of all dirt, loose material, burrs, etc.
3. The Lippert Keyless RV Door Lock with Bluetooth comes with batteries preinstalled. Pull the tab to begin powering the lock with the batteries.

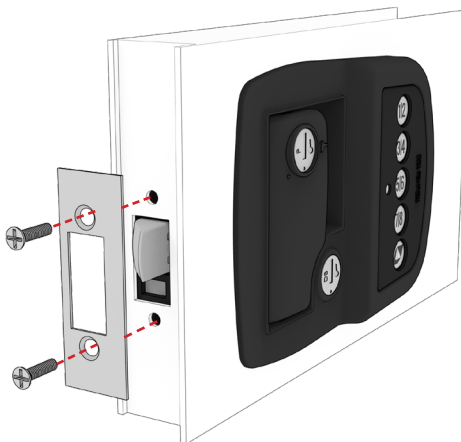
Pull Tab

TIP: Retain product packaging to store the original door lock for possible exchange if the unit is sold and the Lippert RV Door Lock needs to be transferred to a new unit.



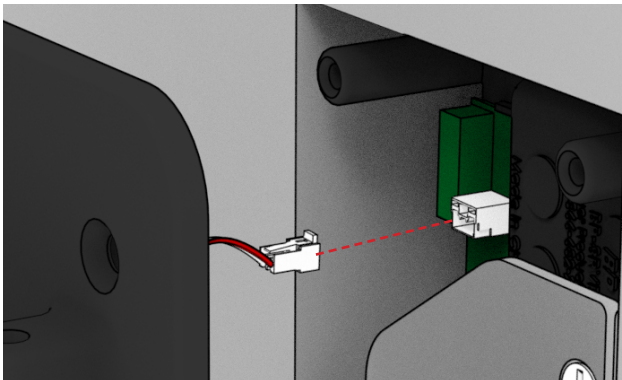
Installation

1. Install outside door latch housing with the deadbolt in the unlocked position.



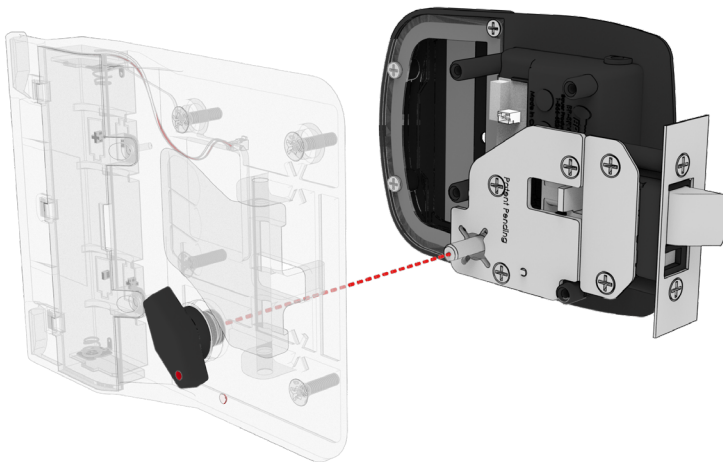
2. Align the thin side of the edge cover facing inward and install two (2) flathead screws.

3. Install battery harness into battery plug, making sure to align tab with the slot. Harness should click into plug when properly engaged.

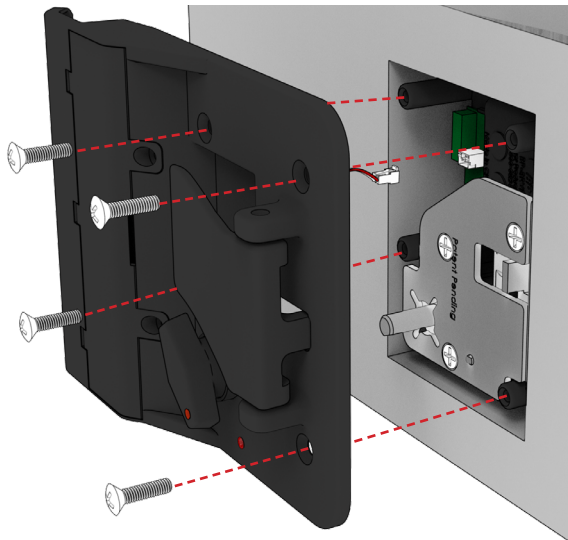


NOTE: Make sure harness wires are tucked in below the battery plug before proceeding to Step 4.

4. With the deadbolt in the unlocked position and red dot on the deadbolt knob and lock housing aligned, slide the deadbolt knob over the D-Stem.



5. Install inside door latch housing with four (4) roundhead screws in an "X" pattern.



Program New Entry Code

NOTE: The door latch is pre-programmed with a factory entry code "3715."

1. Type in the factory keycode "3715" followed by the "Enter" button.
2. Immediately hold down the "3|4" and "Enter" buttons at the same time for 2 seconds.
3. The keypad will blink blue and beep 3 times. This is immediately followed with 10 seconds of blinking orange, during which time the new 4 digit code should be entered.
4. If successful four green blinks and beeps will follow. If unsuccessful one long red blink and beep will follow.

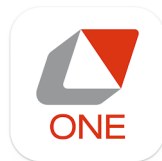


Using OneControl App

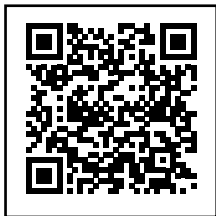
Download OneControl App

NOTE: This product also works with the Compass Connect and Lippert Connect Apps.

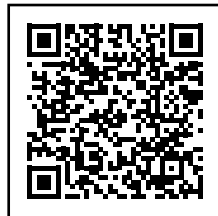
1. Make sure the smart device is connected to the Internet and Bluetooth® is on.

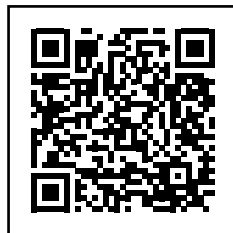
