Law and Production Label Placement

EVERY PRODUCT WE MAKE MUST HAVE A PRODUCTION & LAW LABEL!

In an effort to maintain quality and consistency, all law labels will be placed as follows:

Hide-A-Bed (HAB):

Effective 6-1-19 - Production Label inside of the back rail. Law label inside of the front rail.

Tri-Fold Sofa:

Effective 6-1-19 - Production Label inside of the back rail. Law label inside of the front rail.

Dinette:

It is sewn on the bottom side of cushions near the zipper.

Flips - Jack Knife - Roll Over - HappiJac:

It is sewn on the back of the seat.

Specialty Items (U-Sofa, Sectionals, J-Lounge):

Right or left side lower base. If a pullout drawer is present, then inside the pullout drawer.

Rockers:

It is stapled to the bottom of the rocker next to the base.

Recliners:

It is stapled under the foot kick out.

Euro Chairs:

It is glued to the bottom of the seat or ottoman.

Thomas Payne Collection Theater Seating:

It is stapled under the foot kick out.

Thomas Payne Tri-Fold Sofa:

Production label is inside of the back rail. Law label is inside of the front rail.

Thomas Payne Jack Knife - Happijac Sofa:

It is sewn on the back of the seat.
