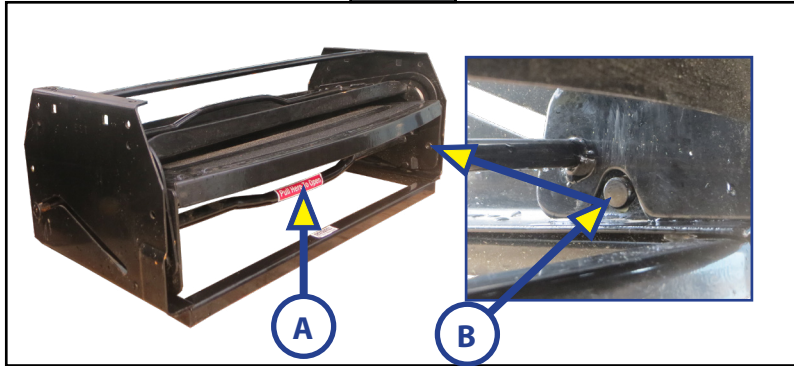


STEPS

Unfolding Steps

Fig. 1



1. Grasp step handle (Fig. 1A) firmly. Lift up slightly to disengage lock mechanism (Fig. 1B) from channel and pull entire step assembly forward. (Fig. 1 shows the steps fully retracted.)

NOTE: Top step slides forward, it does not fold.

2. Bottom step rests on top step, then folds down.

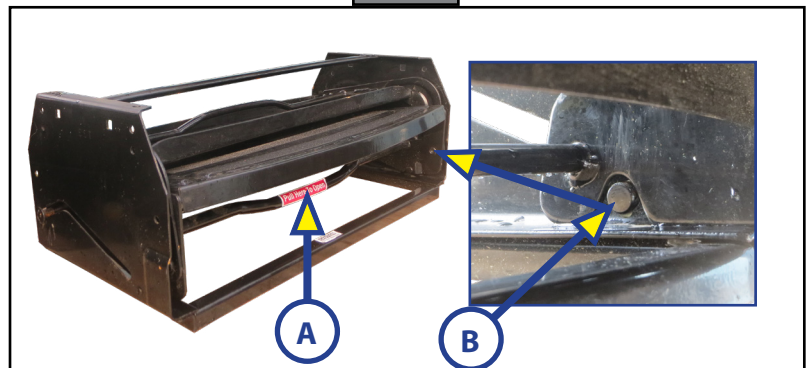
2. Fold bottom step onto top step to store.

4. Grasp step handle (Fig. 8A) firmly. Lift up slightly to disengage lock mechanism (Fig. 8B) from channel and push entire step assembly back. (Fig. 8 shows the step assembly fully retracted.)

NOTE: Top step slides back, it does not fold.
