



MOON TABLE LEG
OEM INSTALLATION MANUAL

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Introduction

The Moon Table Leg provides support for a table. It can also be folded up for storage and the extension can be folded to align the table with the base of a couch in order to create a bed.

Resources Required

- Cordless or electric drill or screwdriver
- Appropriate drive bits
- Four wood screws: Self-tapping countersunk
4.8 mm wood screws, length depending on
thickness of tabletop

Installation

1. Hold top piece of leg assembly to underside of tabletop and install four screws into tabletop to secure piece (Fig. 1).
2. Insert small aluminum section into top piece (Fig. 2).
3. Snap connector into aluminum section (Fig. 2).
4. Attach the long section of the leg to connector and lock it into the top section (Fig. 2).
5. Snap second connector into bottom of long section of table leg (Fig. 3).

NOTE: Connectors are interchangeable.

6. Add leg extension to bottom of connector (Fig. 3).
7. Using the supplied screws, attach footpad to bottom of leg section (Fig. 4).

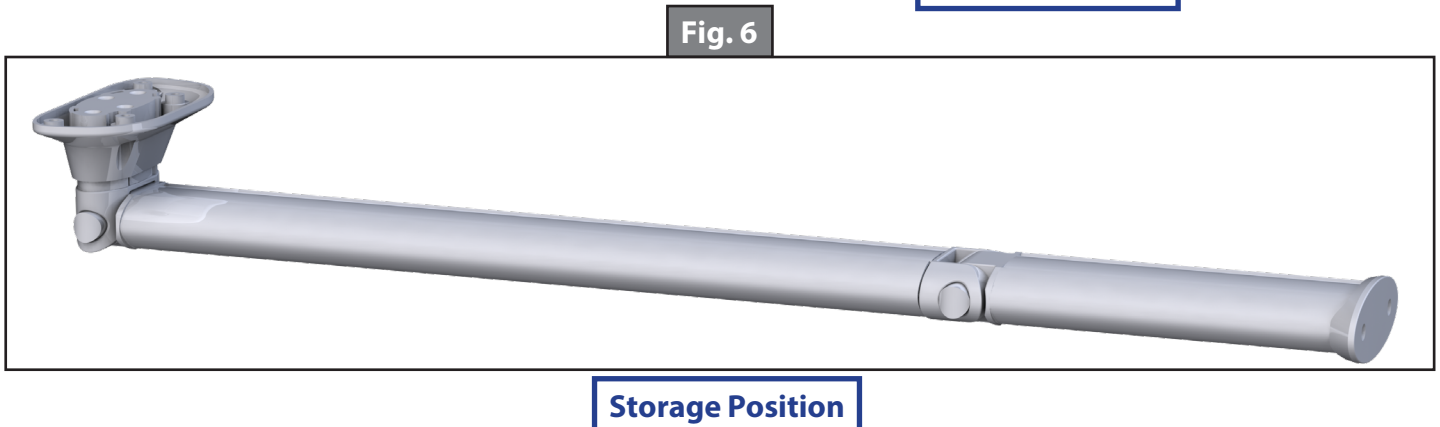
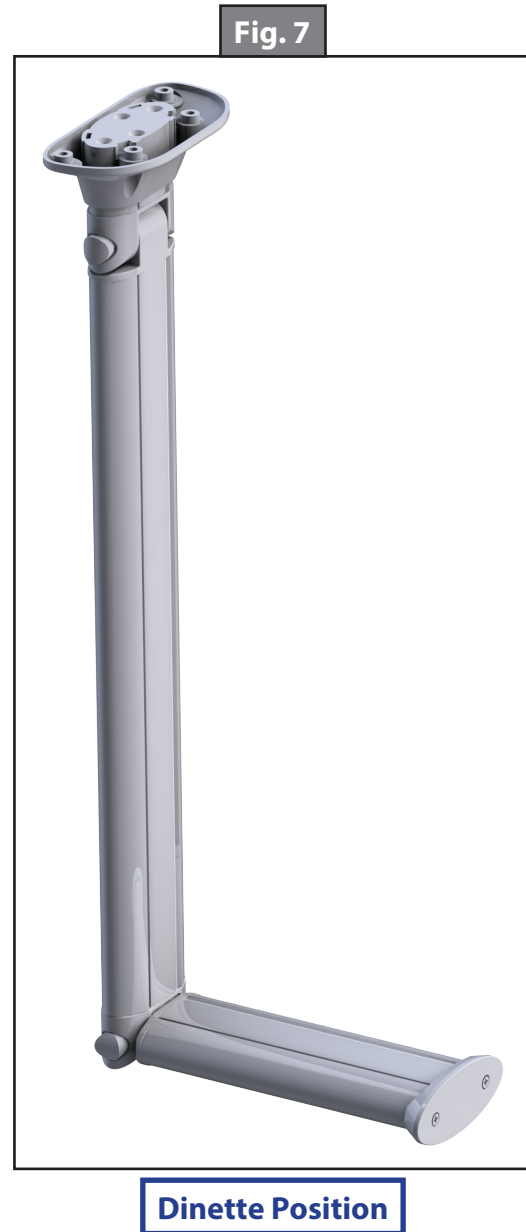
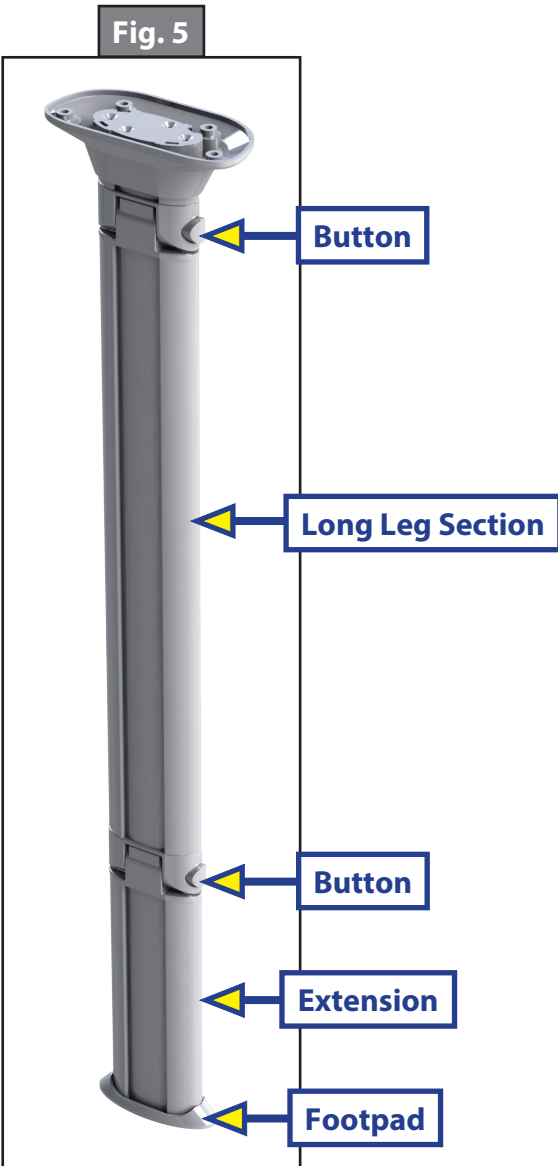
NOTE: If extension is not needed, attach footpad to the bottom of the long leg section.



Operation

1. To fold up leg, press button on side of leg near the top (Fig. 5). The button will unlock the leg.
2. Swing the leg 90 degrees to the storage position (Fig. 6).
3. If the extension is added to the leg, the extension can also be folded 90 degrees by pressing the button on the connector to unlock the leg.

NOTE: The dinette position with the extension folded up (Fig. 7) can align the table with the base of a couch in order to create a bed.
