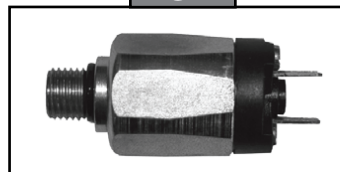


LEVELING AND STABILIZATION

157507 - Sterling Pressure Switch (Fig. 1)

- Used on Forest River Georgetown units featuring the Sterling leveling components.
- Smaller threaded condition than the other two switches.

140592 - IDS Pressure Switch (Fig. 2)

- Used on Damon units featuring the IDS leveling components.
- Offered with rubber boot to keep spade connections free of contamination.

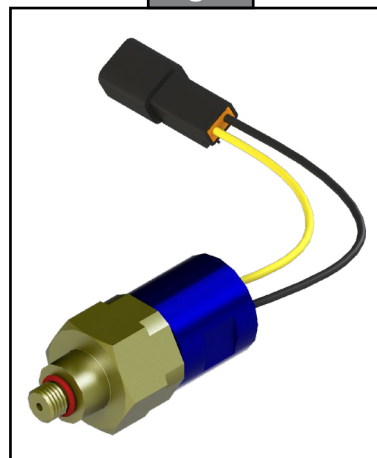

142927 - Nason Pressure Switch (obsolete) (Fig. 3)

- 2150 psi rating
- Used on all motorized leveling units since 2007 model units with IDS leveling components.
- Offered with weather-resistant, plug and play Deutsch connector.
- Prior to April 2013 the Pressure Switch was rated at 2075.

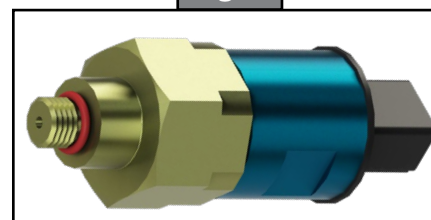
