Installation

1. Unpack bike from box (Fig. 1).

2. Install the handlebar.
 - A. Remove the four handlebar clamp bolts using a 4mm hex key (Fig. 2).
 - B. Mount the handlebar on the stem.
 - C. Tighten the four bolts gradually. One turn per bolt in an X pattern (Fig. 3).

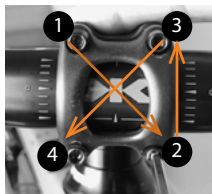

3. Insert the front wheel.

A. Locate front axle within the box (Fig. 4).

B. Remove tensioning nut and one spring and place into front wheel hub (Fig. 5).

NOTE: Narrow end of spring faces the wheel hub.

- C. Place spring (narrow side towards hub) and tensioning nut back onto the axle and leave loose (Fig. 6).
- D. Guide wheel into the fork, paying close attention to the brake-disc alignment into the brake caliper. Once seated, finger tighten the plastic nut with the tensioning arm open, then close the tensioning arm. The tensioning arm should be tight enough to close by hand, no tools required (Fig. 7).

NOTE: Narrow end of spring faces the wheel hub.

- 4. Install pedals.
 - A. Grease the threads.
 - B. Use a 15mm pedal spanner to tighten.
- 5. Install disc brakes.
 - A. Loosen the 5mm allen bolts on the brake calipers (front and rear) (Fig. 8).

- B. Pull the rear brake lever to center the caliper on the disc for even pad contact on the rotor (Fig. 9).

- C. Keep hold of the rear brake lever, and tighten the allen bolts on the rear caliper (Fig. 10).
- D. Release the lever and check that the disc rotor spins freely (Fig. 11). Repeat these steps for the front brake.

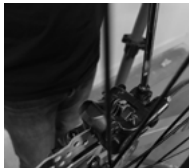

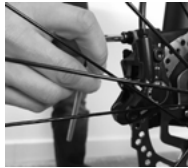

Operation

1. Charge the battery.
2. Insert the battery then turn the key to lock (Fig. 12).

3. Push ON/OFF switch to I position (Fig. 13).

4. Hold until on (Fig. 14) and select assistance level.
5. Pedal to start.
