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REPLACING DAMAGED GLIDE STRIP

1. Remove damaged glide strip and clean off any remaining adhesive or debris with acetone.
2. Place adhesive strip along c-channel with strip half on and half off the channel as shown below.



3. Peel the backing from the adhesive strip as you do the adhesive will fold under the edge of the c-channel.



4. Press the plastic glide strip into place between the raised stops at each end of the c-channel and allow the adhesive to "cure" for 24 Hrs. before reassembling the slide mechanism.





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
