Purpose

This document outlines the general steps to handle and care for the RV mattress during OEM installation and dealer storage.

⚠ CAUTION

Failure to remove factory plastic from mattress stored in a unit could result in extreme deterioration of material due to collection of moisture in the unit.

Mattress Handling

General Mattress Handling For OEM Installation and Dealer Storage

- OEM - The protective plastic used during shipping should be removed from the mattress during OEM installation if the mattress has the potential to be stored in a non-climate-controlled environment for any length of time.
- Dealer - Dealer should remove the plastic from the mattress upon receipt of the unit, if not previously removed.

NOTE: Multiple days of extreme temperature with a mattress left in the protective plastic can cause deterioration of the mattress material which would not be covered as a warrantable issue.

Mattress Care

Resources Required

- Mild dish soap for stain removal
- Cleaning cloths
- Warm water

Stains can be removed from a mattress using a mild dish soap and warm water to spot clean. Make sure to thoroughly dry any damp spots before adding any bedding.



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
