

## STEPS

Fig. 1



1. Firmly grasp grab bar (Fig. 1).
2. Pull grab bar outward and down until top step is fully exposed and cannot be pulled out any farther.

3. Grasp second grab bar from the top of the second step (Fig. 2).
4. Pull grab bar outward and down until bottom step is fully exposed and cannot be pulled out any farther.

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
