Essential Toolkit

This toolkit contains tools and repair items that are among the most needed by RV'ers.

The 15 products contained in the toolkit range from an air gauge and electronics multimeter to duct tape, fuses, electrical connectors and masks.

The items are compact enough to be contained in a tool bag that can be stored in an RV.

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200 Lumen Wide-Angled LED Headlamp

The LED headlamp (Fig.1) has an adjustable head strap and shines light up to 33 feet. It is ideal for hiking, running or moving around the campsite, and provides comprehensive illumination, especially in tighter spaces.

- △ Three light modes: High, low, strobe
- △ Waterproof
- △ Shockproof
- △ Operates with three AAA alkaline batteries (Included)

Flexible Tire Pressure Gauge

The tire pressure gauge (Fig.2) has a built-in flexible hose and an easy-to-read two-inch dial gauge. The flexible hose will allow checking tire pressure from any angle.

- △ 10-inch flexible hose
- △ Brass air chuck
- △ Push button resets to zero

Seven-Function Digital Multimeter

The digital multimeter (Fig.3) provides measurements and tests for a variety of electronics. The multimeter tests AC voltage, DC voltage, DC current and resistance. Also available are a transistor test, diode test and battery test. The 3.5-inch digital display updates 2.5 times per second.

- △ Low battery indicator
- △ Over range indicator
- △ Includes two 24-inch 18 gauge CCA test leads

Circuit Tester

This circuit tester (Fig.4) enables users to check any 6- or 12-volt fuse. A light in the handle indicates whether the circuit can carry an electrical current or not.

- △ Heavy duty high impact handle
- △ Five-foot lead wire
- △ Needle point probe

Crimping Tool

The crimping tool (Fig.5) is designed to work as a crimper, bolt cutter, wire cutter and wire stripper. The tool features dipped cushion grips for less user fatigue over long jobs.

- △ Strips wire gauges 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20-22
- △ Crimps connectors 12-10, 16-14, 22-18
- △ Cuts bolts from 4-40 to 10-32
- △ Forged and machined alloy steel

Utility Knife

The utility knife (Fig. 6) can be used for a variety of purposes, from cutting carpet to opening packages. The knife has a snap-off blade to provide a new cutting edge as needed.

- △ Heavy duty composite construction
- △ Blade lock feature
- △ 10 replacement blades included

Multi-Bit Ratcheting Screwdriver Set

The ratcheting screwdriver set (Fig.7) includes 12 metric and SAE drive sockets, two hex bits, a set of 15 standard, Phillips® and Torx® bits plus an ergonomically-designed screwdriver.

△ Drive sockets:

SAE - $\frac{1}{4}$ ", $\frac{5}{16}$ ", $\frac{11}{32}$ ", $\frac{7}{16}$ " $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Metric - 5 mm, 6 mm, 7 mm, 8 mm, 9 mm, 10 mm

△ Bits:

Slotted - 4 mm, 5.5 mm, 7 mm; Phillips - PH1, PH 2x5, PH3

Star - T-15, T-20, T-25; Hex - 3 mm, 4 mm

Set of Hex Keys

The hex keys (Fig.8) are constructed of carbon steel with a black oxide finish to resist rust.

△ Hex keys include:

$\frac{1}{16}$ ", $\frac{5}{64}$ ", $\frac{3}{32}$ ", $\frac{1}{8}$ ", $\frac{5}{32}$ ", $\frac{3}{16}$ ", $\frac{7}{32}$ ", $\frac{1}{4}$ ", $\frac{5}{16}$ ", $\frac{3}{8}$ "

Wire Connector Assortment

This 158-piece wire connector set (Fig.9) for copper-to-copper connections features wire connectors with cone-shaped springs to eliminate pre-twisting wires. The connectors are color coded and flame retardant with a temperature rating of 221° F (105° C) with maximum-rated voltage of 300 volts for gray, blue and orange and 600 volts for yellow and red.

- △ There are 40 pieces each of Gray #22 - #16 AWG and Blue #22 - #16 AWG. There are 50 pieces of Orange #22 - #16 AWG, 18 pieces of Yellow #22 - #16 AWG and 10 pieces of Red #22 - #16 AWG.

Automotive Fuse Set

This automotive fuse set (Fig.10) has an assortment of standard blade type fuses in the six most commonly-used ranges for cars and trucks. The fuses have transparent covers for quick detection of blown fuses.

- △ The set includes 10 fuses each of 5A, 10A, 15A, 20A, 25A and 30A.

Screw Set Assortment

This set of 230 assorted Phillips flat head self-tapping wood screws (Fig.11) are constructed of zinc-plated carbon steel to resist rust and corrosion.

△ 30 each of: #6 x $\frac{3}{5}$ ", #6 x $\frac{3}{4}$ ", #8 x $\frac{1}{2}$ ", #8 x $\frac{5}{8}$ ", #8 x $\frac{3}{4}$ "

△ 20 each of: #8 x 1", #8 x 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ ", #10 x $\frac{3}{4}$ ", #10 x 1"

Cable Ties

The bundle of cable ties (Fig.12) can help organize wires, cables and ropes and eliminate tangles or tripping hazards. The ties are made of nylon and certified to current fire standards.

△ Loop tensile strength: 46 lbs.

△ Working temperature: Maximum 185° F, Minimum -40°

△ Minimum install temperature: 14° F (-10° C)

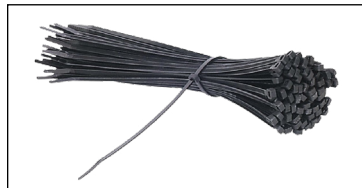

All-Purpose Duct Tape

This polyethylene-backed rubber base adhesive duct tape (Fig.13) can be used for repairs and sealing. It is resistant to water and abrasions, is UV and sunlight resistant and bonds to both smooth and rough surfaces.

△ Length: 50 yards; Width: 1.88"; Thickness: 8 mil

Electrical Tape

This heavy-duty electrical tape (Fig.14) conforms to sharp contours and works in temperatures up to 176° F (80° C) and on systems up to 600 volts.

△ Five rolls included

△ Length: 60 feet per roll; Thickness: .177 mm; Width: 3/4"

KN95/FFP2 Face Masks

These face masks (Fig.15) meet KN95 filtration standards and are foldable, lightweight and offer more protection than a standard disposable three-ply mask.

△ 10 masks included; equal to or above 94% efficiency

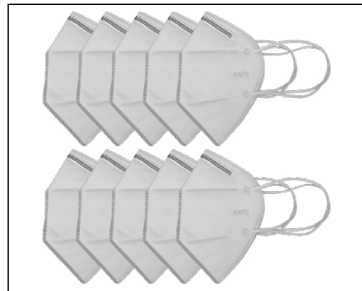
