Purpose

This document shows the connections for electrical hookups after the first unboxing of the Seismic Theater Seating.

Safety**⚠ WARNING**

Make sure that the furniture is completely unplugged from any electrical socket to avoid electrical shock.

- The Seismic Theater Seating has right and left seating and a console (Fig. 1). Right and left seating is determined from a seated point of view.

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Packaged Cords

- Cords for connecting power to the left and right theater seating to a wall outlet will be in a plastic bag inside of the box with the furniture.
- Remove cords from the bag and then lay out for correct identification.

A. Electrical plug (qty. 2) (Fig. 2A) plugs into the AC adapter (Fig. 2B).

B. The AC adapter (qty. 2) (Fig. 2D) plugs into the back lower corner of each seat (Fig. 3C).

NOTE: Do not plug the seating plugs (Fig. 2C) into a wall outlet until all connections have been made between right and left seating and console.

- Electrical plug (Fig. 2C) plugs into a wall outlet.

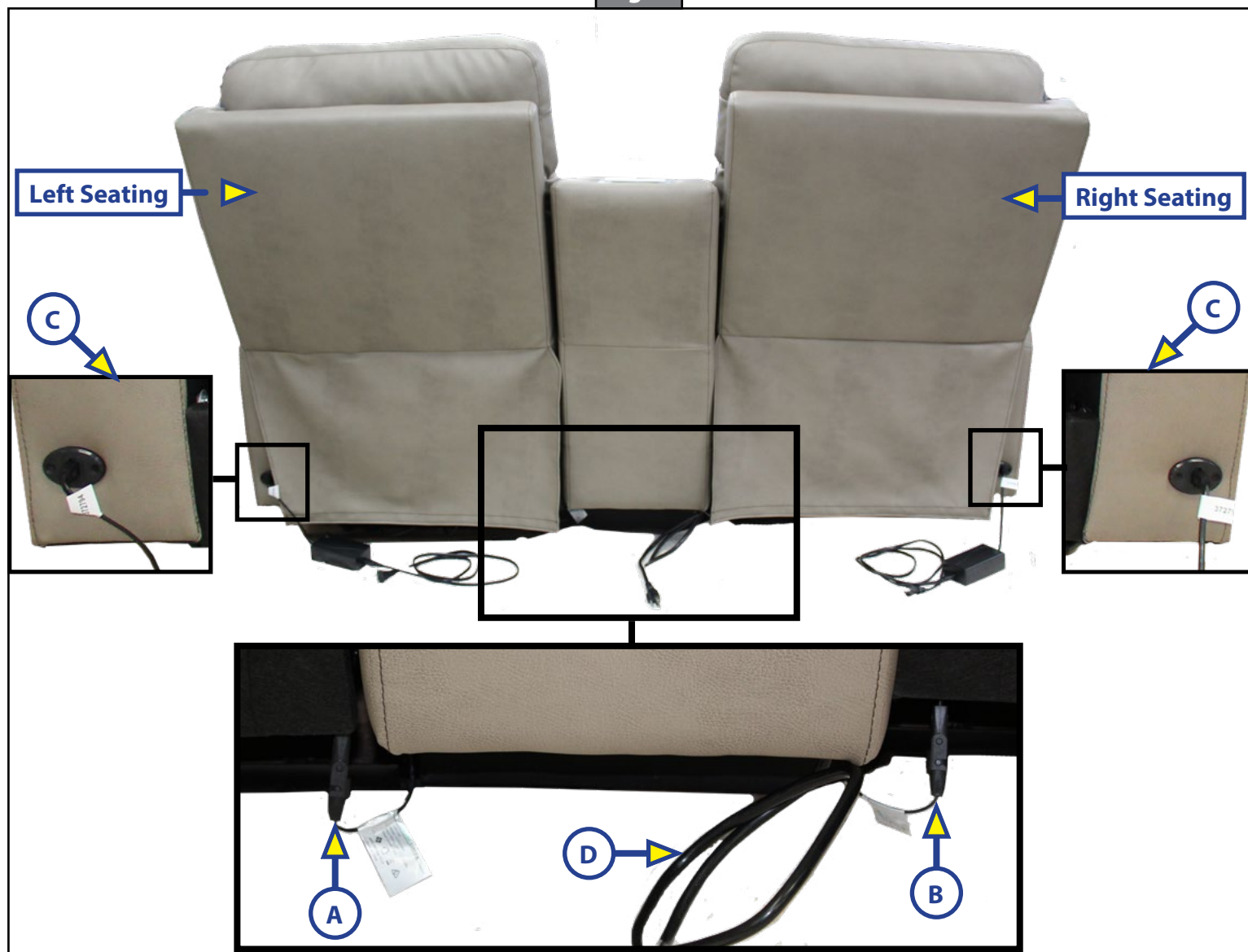


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Power Attachment Locations

- There are connections from the right and left seating to the console, if applicable.
 - A. The console has a connector on the left side (from the back) that plugs into a connector on the left seating (Fig. 3A). This connection powers the console's left cup holder.
 - B. The console has a connector on the right side (from the back) that plugs into a connector on the right seating (Fig. 3B). This connection powers the console's right cup holder.
- There are connections from right and left seating to a wall outlet (Fig. 3C). These connections power each seat's individual functions.
- There is a connection from the console to a wall outlet (Fig. 3D). This connection powers the power center (Fig. 2).
