



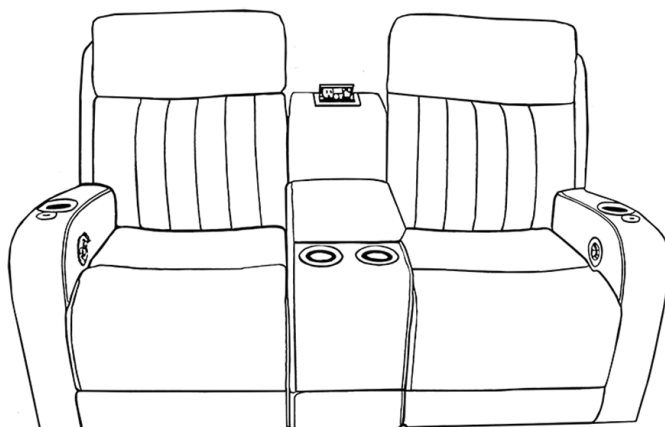

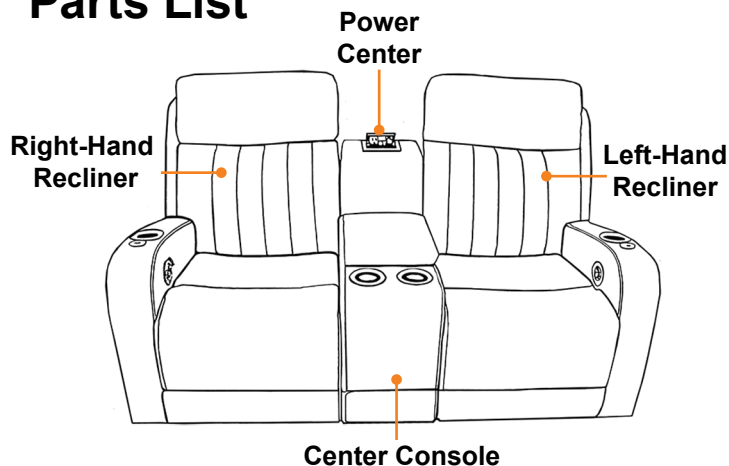

Installation

1. The seating comes with the seat back laying on top of the seat cushion (Fig.1).

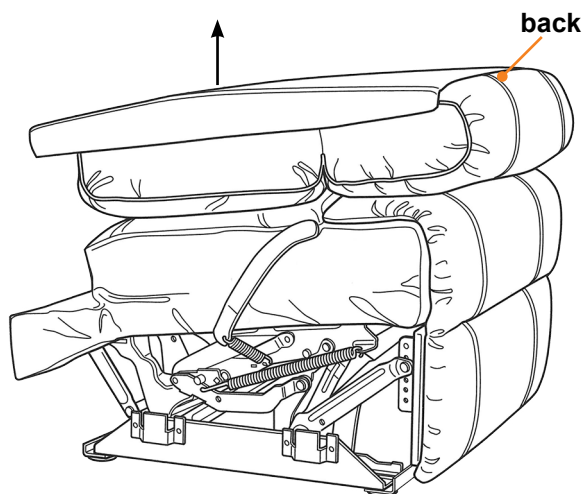

2. Lift the seat back (Fig.2A) and align with the brackets (Fig.2B, Fig. 2C) on the seat base (Fig.2D).

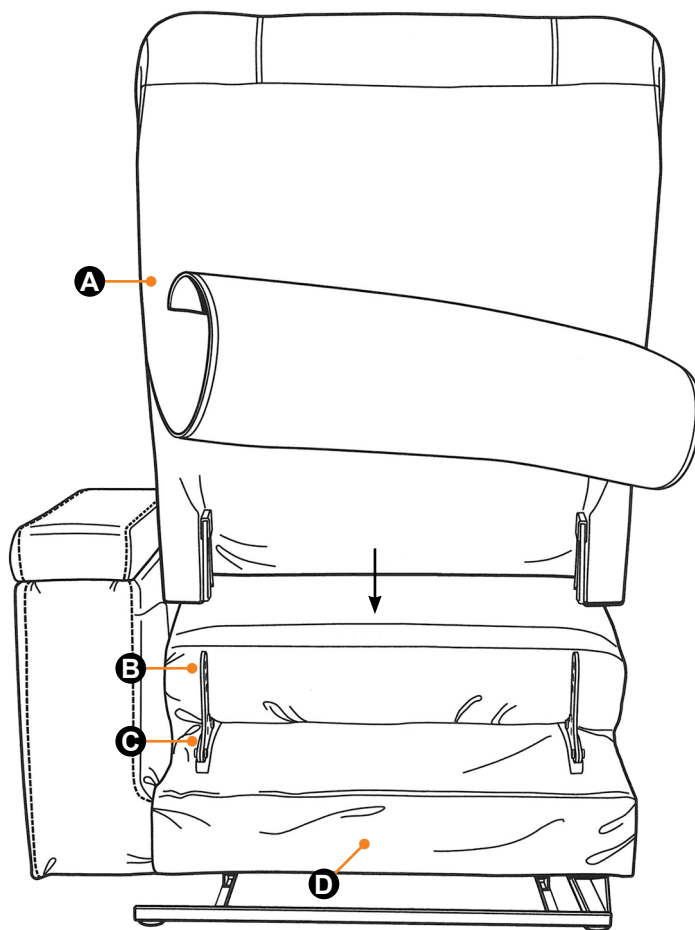

3. The seat back is fully installed when the clips (Inset Fig.3C) on the back of seat back (Fig.3D) slide down over the bottom brackets (Fig.3A) on the seat base (Fig.3B) and click into place.

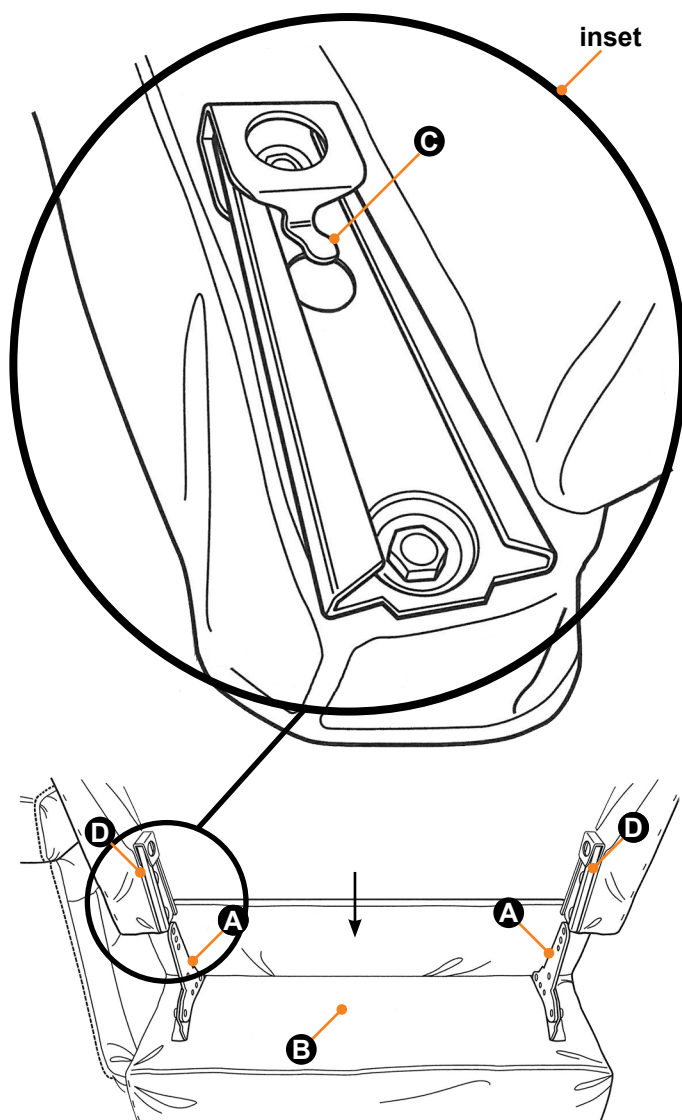

4. Determine placement for Seismic Theater Seating and place the center console (Fig.4, Fig.5) in the middle of the designated space.

A. Right-Hand Seating - Move the right-hand seat (Fig.6) to the right-hand side of the console (Fig.4). Slide the brackets on the bottom inside of the right-hand seat (Fig.6A) on top of the brackets on the bottom of the inner console (Fig.4A).

B. Left-Hand Seating - Move the left-hand seat (Fig.7) to the left-hand side of the console (Fig.5). Slide the brackets on the bottom inside of the left-hand seat (Fig.7A) on top of the brackets on the bottom of the inner console (Fig.5A).

Center Console - Right-Hand Seating

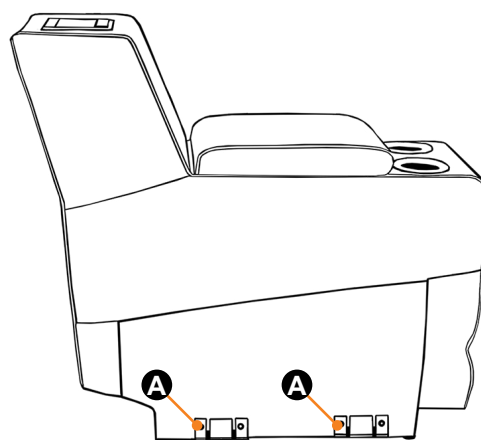

Center Console - Left-Hand Seating

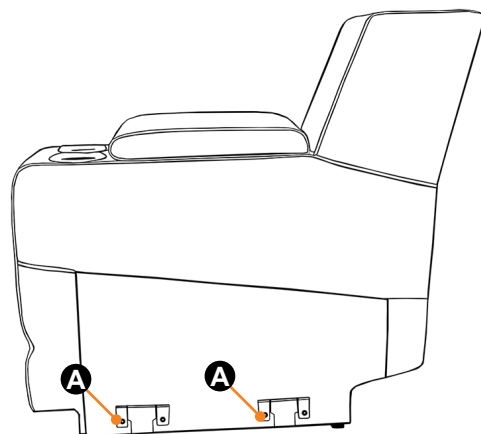

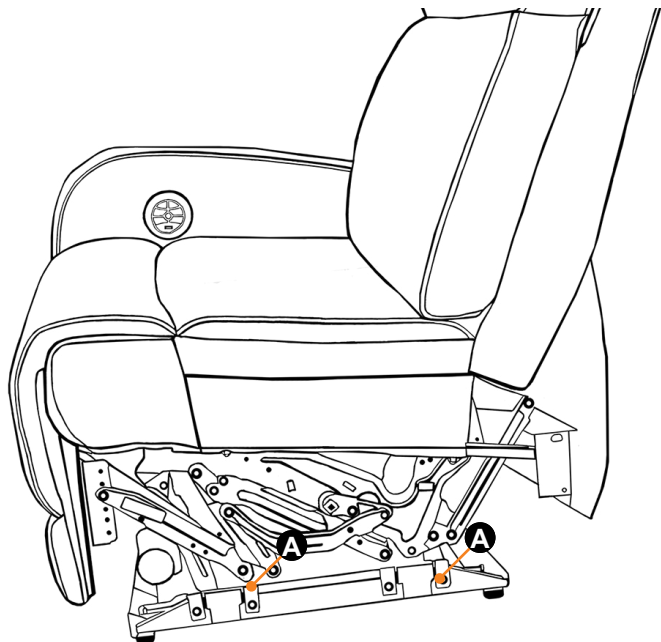

Left-Hand Seating

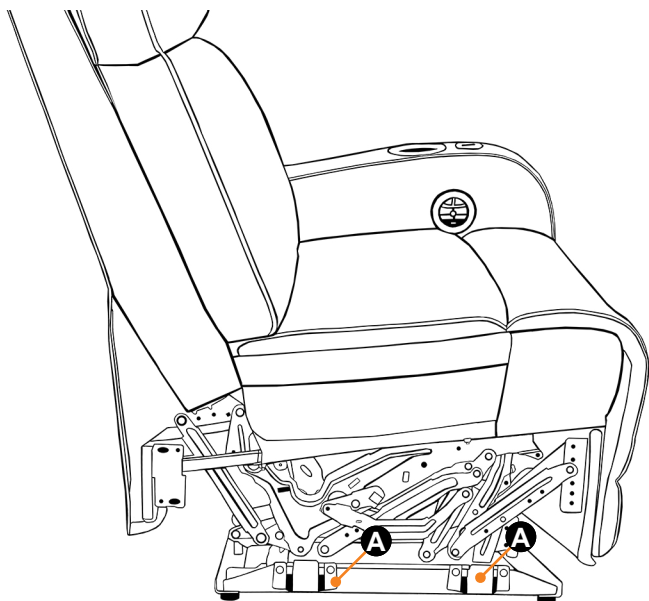

Cords and Electrical Connections

1. Locate the plastic bag in the furniture box with the cords for connecting power to the left and right theater seating to a wall outlet.

2. Remove the cords for the bag and lay out for correct identification.

A. Electrical plug (qty. 2) (Fig.8A) plugs into the AC adapter (Fig.8B).

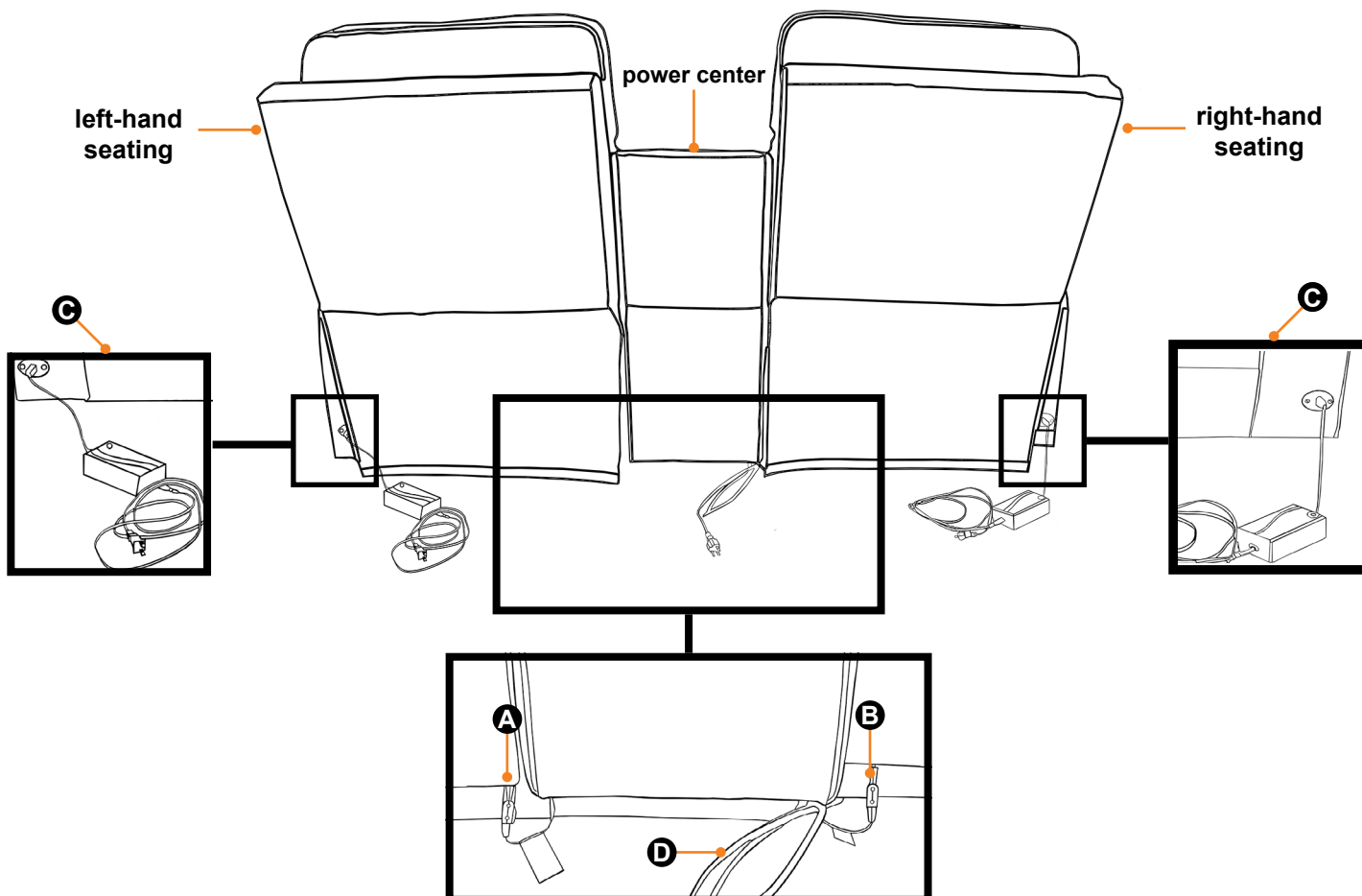


Fig.9



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

B. The AC adapter (qty. 2) (Fig.8D) plugs into the back lower corner of each seat (Fig.9C).

NOTE: Do not plug the seating plugs (Fig.8C) into a wall outlet until all connections have been made between right- and left-hand seating and console.

C. Electrical plug (Fig.8C) plugs into a wall outlet.

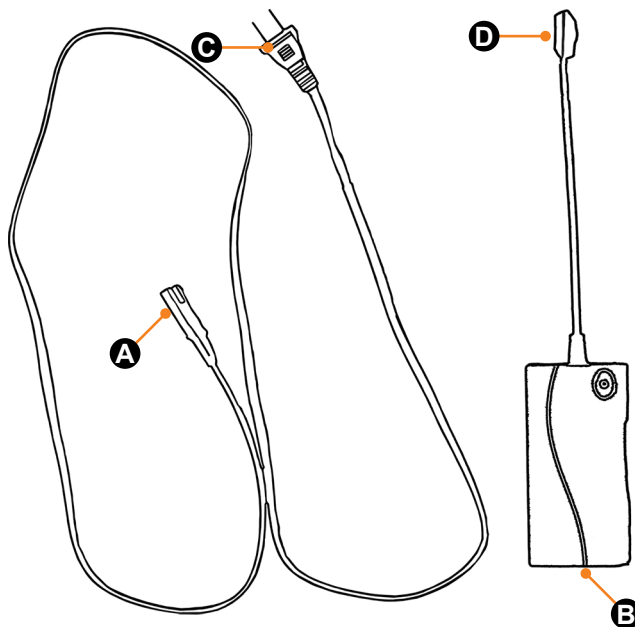

3. Connect the right- and left-hand seating to the center console.

A. The console has a connector on the left side (from the back) that plugs into a connector on the left-hand seating (Fig.9A). This connection powers the console's left cup holder.

B. The console has a connector on the right side (from the back) that plugs into a connector on the right-hand seating (Fig.9B). This connection powers the console's right cup holder.

4. Connect the right- and left-hand seating to a wall outlet (Fig.9C). These connections power each seat's individual functions.

5. Connect the console to a wall outlet (Fig.9D). This connection power the power center (Fig.9).
