

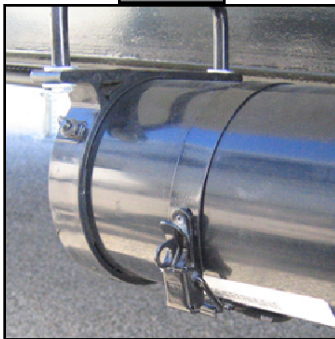

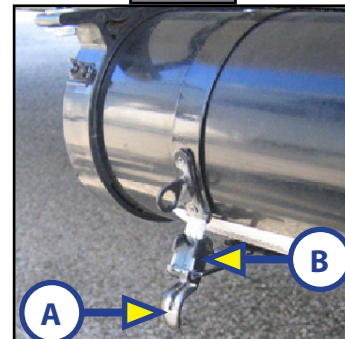
1. Sewer Management tube secured with steel band and locking latch. Locking Pin or small padlock can be used to safely lock tube in place.

2. To release tube for purging the sewer system, flip latch handle (Fig. 3A) down and disengage latch bar (Fig. 3B) from the clip.
