



SIRIO 2.0 PVC BLINDS
OEM INSTALLATION MANUAL

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Introduction

The Sirio 2.0 PVC blind assembly is a combination of a flyscreen and shade for windows that can be pulled up or down by hand using the two different profiles. The integrated spring shaft tensions the fabric permanently and gives optimum hold. The entire assembly is simply hung on the inside wall window console and secured.

Resources Required

- Cordless or electric drill or screw gun
- Appropriate drive bits
- (4) #6 x 1/2" screws

Installation

1. Located on the inside wall of the unit, place the Sirio blind assembly (Fig. 1A) over the window and center.
2. Install one #6 x 1/2" screw (Fig. 2A) in each corner of the blind assembly (Fig. 2B) to secure it to the wall of the unit.
3. Install the corner covers (Fig. 3A) by aligning the pins (Fig. 3B) in the cover with the pins on the blind assembly (Fig. 4A). Press the cover in until it slides into place and an audible snap is heard.

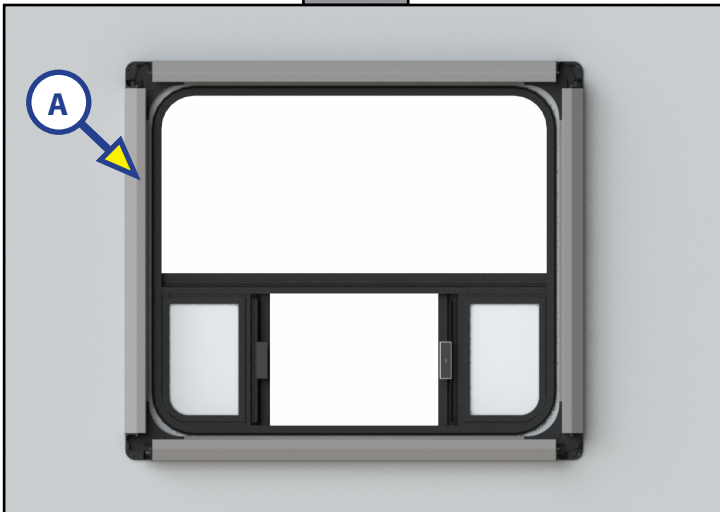

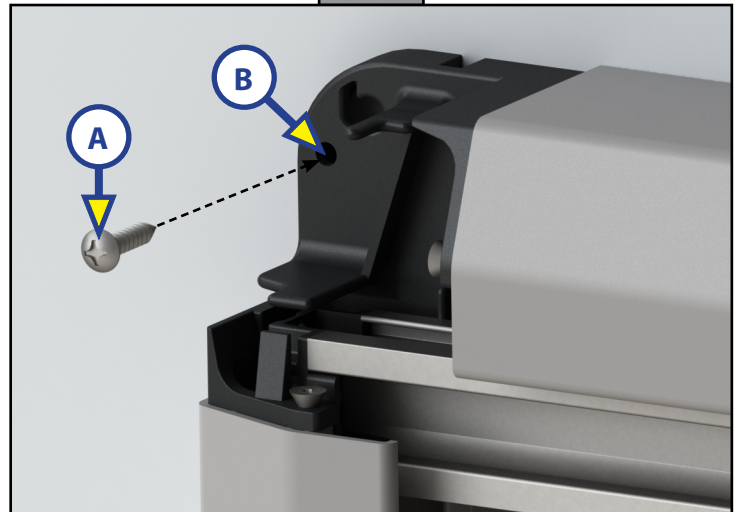

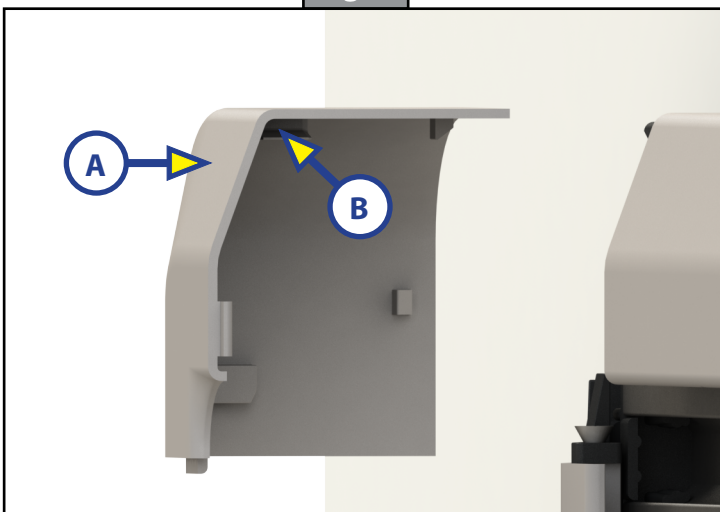
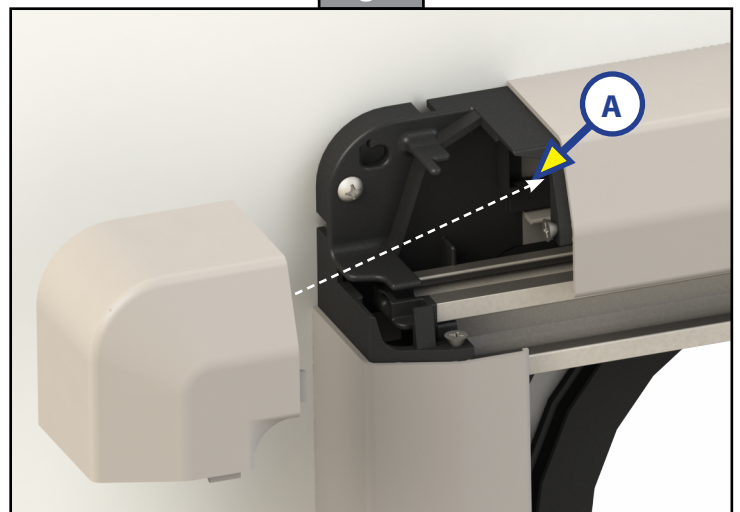

Operation

There are two different window profiles: blind (Fig. 5A) and screen (Fig. 5B).

1. Place your hand in the middle of the lower profile (Fig. 5B) to raise or lower the Sirio flyscreen (Fig. 6) slowly.
2. Place your hand on the middle top profile (Fig. 5A) to raise or lower the Sirio blind (Fig. 7) slowly.
3. Both profiles can be in use at the same time as well. Figure 8 depicts a half blind, half screen window profile.

NOTE: Do **NOT** rapidly raise and lower the profiles of the assembly. Rapidly raising and lowering the profiles may cause damage to the Sirio blind or wall of the unit.

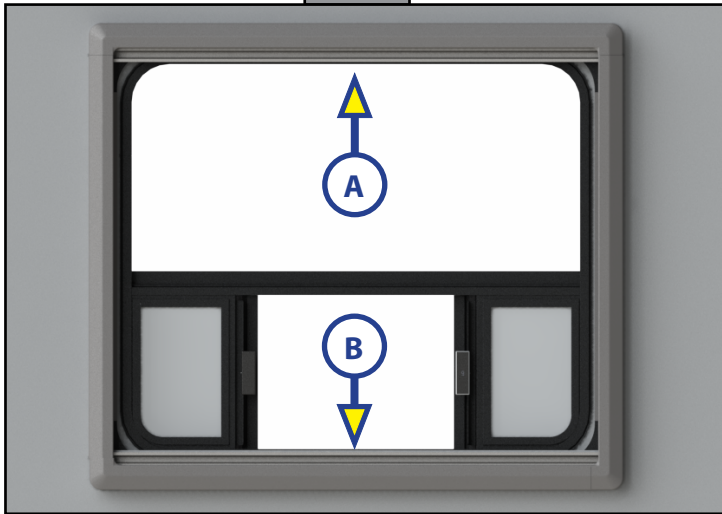

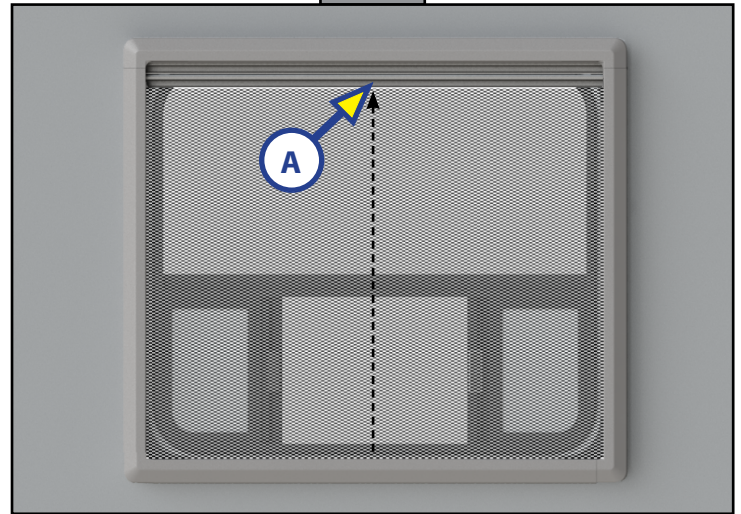

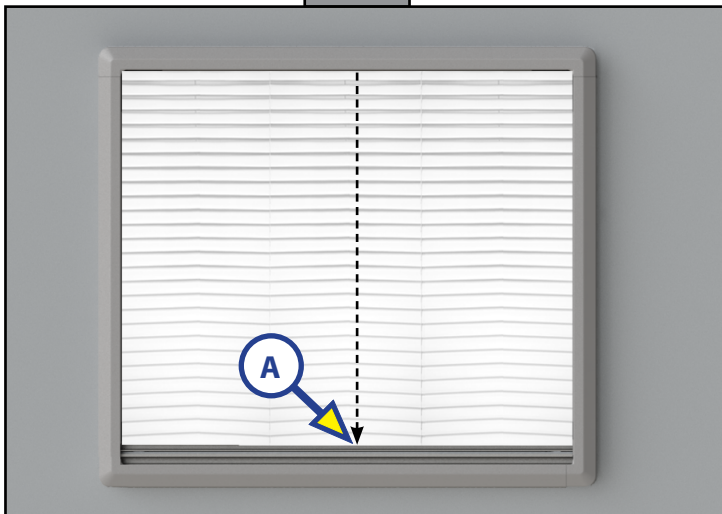
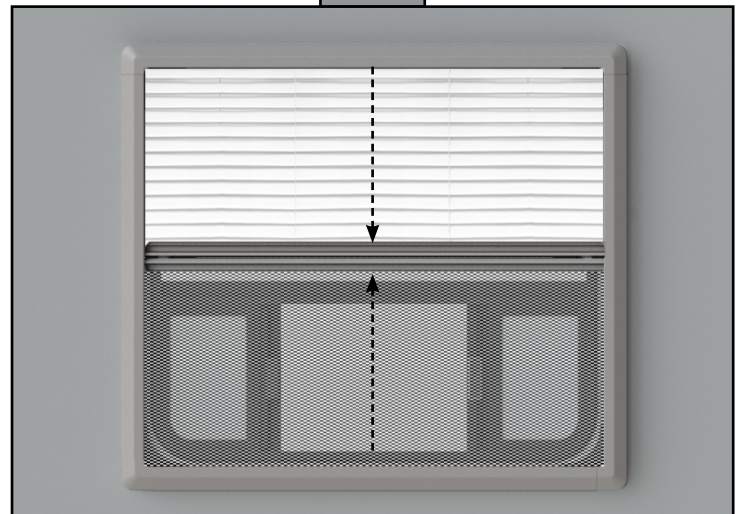
