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System Information

The Solera® Slide Topper Prep Kit can be installed on the slide-out of a trailer for easy installation of a Solera Slide Topper at a later time.

Safety



Moving parts can pinch, crush or cut. Keep clear and use caution.

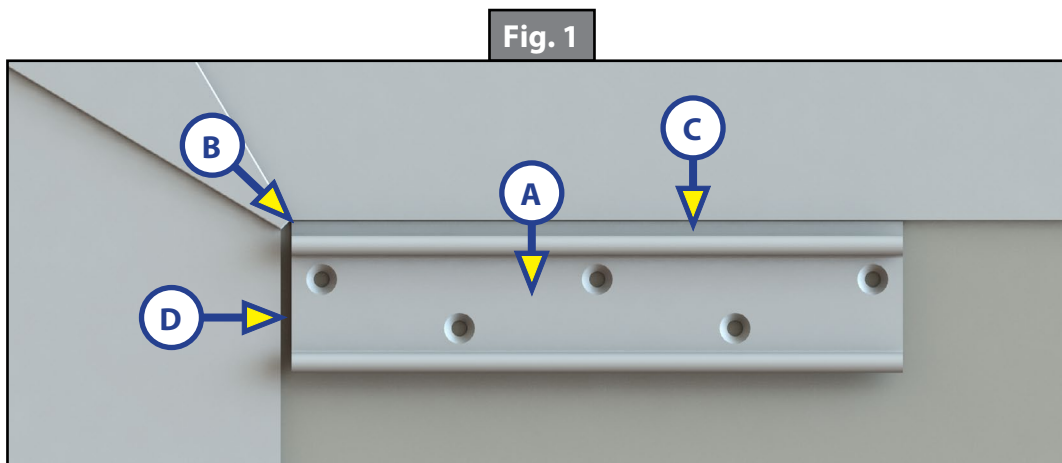
Resources Required

- Cordless or electric drill or screw gun
- Appropriate drive bits

Installation

1. Install the access plate below the T-molding (Fig. 1) or on the T-molding (Fig. 2).
 - A. If installing below the T-molding, start on one side of the front of the slide-out by placing one of the two mounting brackets (Fig. 1A) against the bottom of the T-molding at the top corner of the slide-out (Fig. 1B). Make sure the flat edge of the mounting bracket is oriented at the top (Fig. 1C) and keep the mounting bracket parallel with the bottom edge of the T-molding.

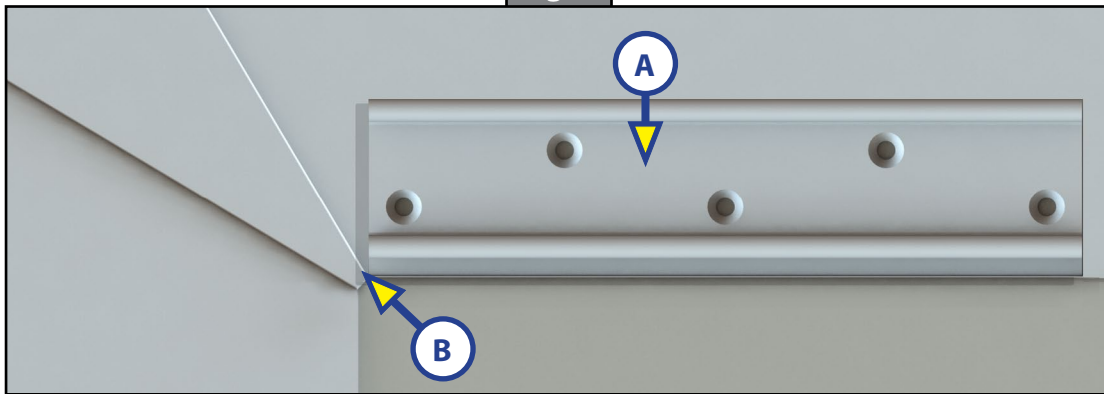
NOTE: Place the mounting bracket as close to the corner as possible. There might be a slight gap between the T-molding side and the side of the mounting bracket (Fig. 1D) if the corner does not have a 90° angle.



- B. If installing on the T-molding, start on one side of the front of the slide-out by placing one of the two access brackets (Fig. 2A) at the very bottom corner of the T-molding (Fig. 2B) as close to the outside of the T-molding as possible without going over the corner mold.

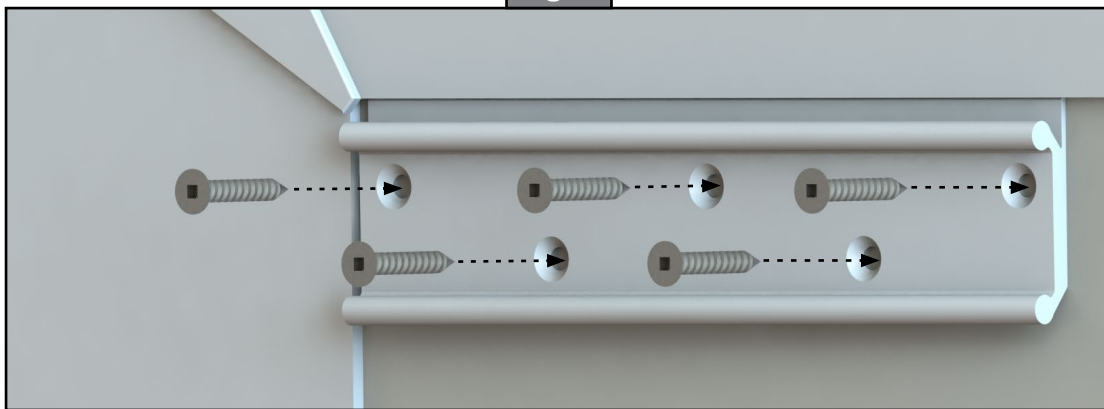
NOTE: Make sure the screws do not go over the roof line.

2. Fasten the mounting bracket to the slide-out exterior wall using the five provided #10 -13 x 1 1/4" recessed square head screws (Fig. 3).

3. Snap the cosmetic slide topper access plate cover (Fig. 4A) onto the access plate (Fig. 4B).
