

Purpose

This document outlines the general steps to handle and care for the Tub Surround during OEM installation and dealer storage. Specifically, how to prevent Tub Surround from yellowing prior to installation.

Tub Surround Handling

OEM

- Tub Surrounds are delivered wrapped in a black protective plastic cover. As long as the Tub Surround remains covered up or stored away from sunlight, it will not discolor or yellow.
- The black protective plastic cover also prevents the Tub Surround from being dirtied or damaged by environmental elements. As long as the Tub Surround remains covered up or stored away from weather, it will not get unnecessarily dirty or damaged.
- Make sure Tub Surrounds are stored in a location where they are not being hit or knocked over, which can cause blemishes or other defects.

Dealer

The dealer should remove the protective covering from the Tub Surround if not previously removed.

Tub Surround Care

Resources Required

- Mild dish soap for debris or stain removal
- Warm water
- Cleaning cloths

Recommended Cleaners: Mild soap and water, Fantastic Spray Cleaner, Top Job Liquid (3% solution), Spic-and-Span Pine Cleaner, Joy Liquid Detergent (5% solution), Gel-Gloss, "The Works" Tub and Shower Cleaner, DuPont 7 Auto "Polish," and DuPont 606S Auto "Polish." All cleaning should be followed by a warm water rinse.

Do Not Use: Disinfectant sprays, disinfectant foams, pine oil cleaners, citrus-based cleaners, abrasive cleaners, harsh chemicals, Scrubbing Bubbles, petroleum-based products, auto rubbing compounds or industrial or commercial cleaners.

NOTE: With the exception of Permalux® and Permalux Plus® products, fading or discoloration may result from continued exposure to direct sunlight. Keep blinds or drapes closed during periods of the day when the product is exposed to direct sunlight.

1. Debris and stains can be removed from the Tub Surround using a mild dish soap and warm water applied with a gentle cleaning cloths.
2. Rinse soap with water.
3. Thoroughly dry Tub Surround with another cleaning cloth.
