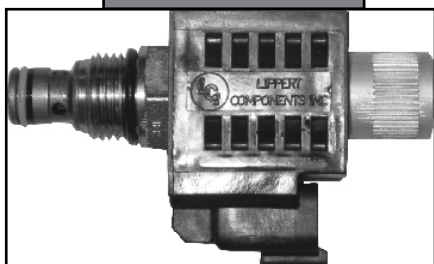


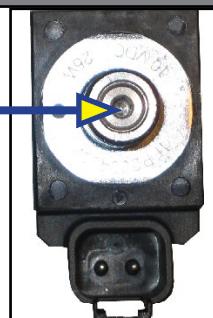

Assembled View

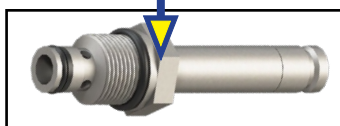

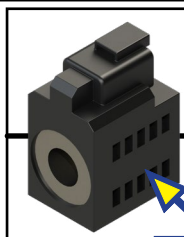

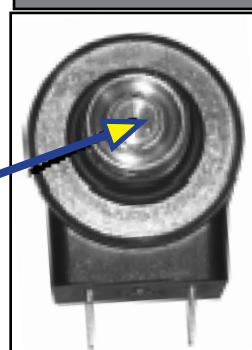

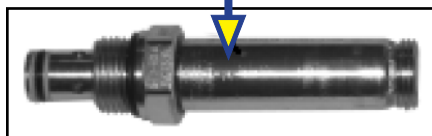

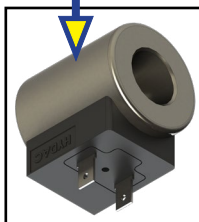

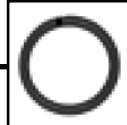

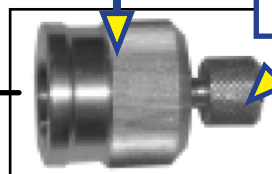

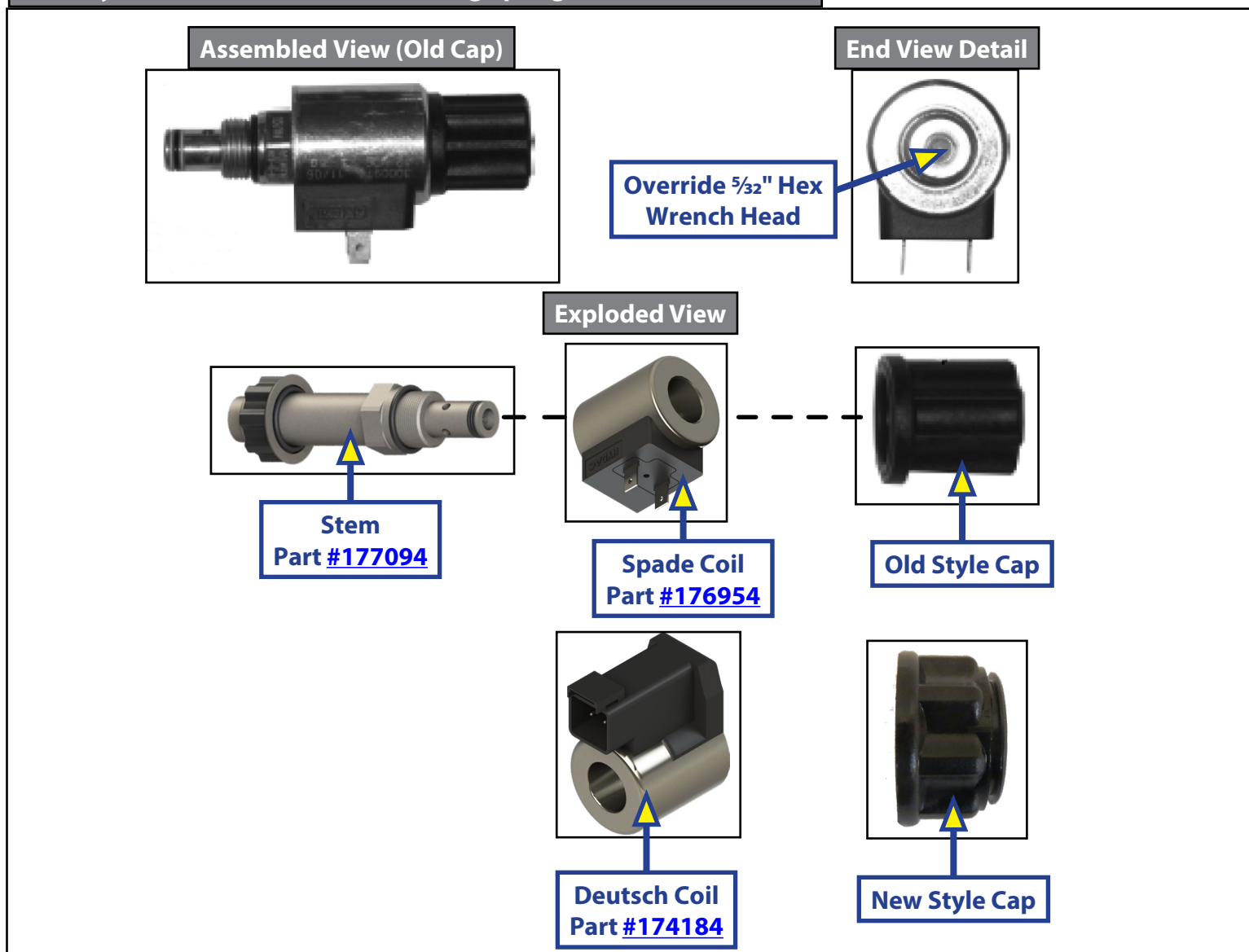

New Style HYDAC Valve (In Use Starting Spring 2006) - Part #138417



Operation of Manual Override for Valves with Hex Wrench Head Overrides

Turn CLOCKWISE to manual override valve.
Turn COUNTERCLOCKWISE to return the valve to normal use.

⚠ CAUTION

Do not over-tighten the override in either the clockwise or counterclockwise direction. Over-tightening may damage the valve and hamper its functions.

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
