The document explains the common abbreviations for window configurations and terminology for the 2000, 3000, 8500, 8600, 8700 and 8800 series windows.

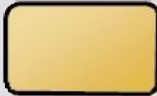
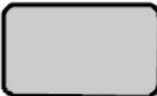
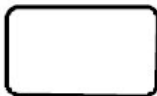
Window Series Configurations

Series	Configuration
2000	Single vent crank out windows (non-insulated and insulated)
3000	Bonded - Frame does not show on exterior
8500	Slider windows with a few picture windows
8600	Insulated - No frame on a sliding pane
8700	Slider windows (non-insulated)
8800	Slider windows (non-insulated)

Frame Colors

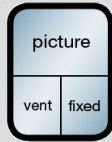
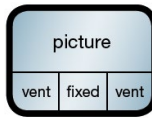
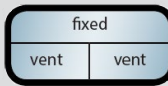
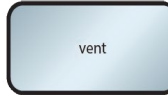
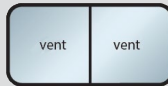
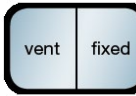
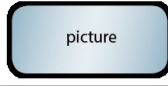
Code	Definition
BK/BLK	Black - frame color
WH/WHT	White - frame color

Glass Codes

Code	Definition	Example
G20	Gray 20 - tint color of glass (dark)	
G55	Gray 55 - tint color of glass (lighter)	
SCB	Solar Cool Bronze - tint color of glass (mirrored) 4mm thick	
SCG	Solar Cool Gray - tint color of glass (mirrored) 4mm thick	
CL	Clear	
OBS	Obscure glass (for bathrooms)	
SS or SSB	Single strength - glass strength

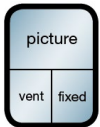
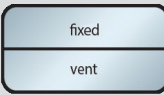
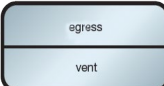
