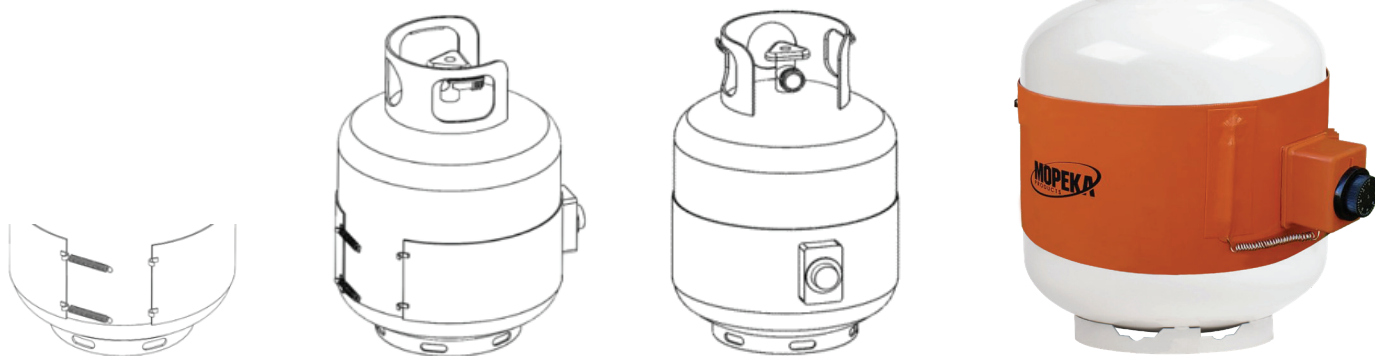


Tank Blanket Installation Instructions

Part No. 024-5003



1. **READ THE WARNINGS AND SAFETY INFORMATION THAT IS PROVIDED WITH THE MOPEKA TANK BLANKET FIRST!**
2. Remove all plastic sleeves and clean any dirt from the tank
3. Remove all tape and plastic bubble wrap from the Mopeka Tank Blanket ends.
4. Wrap the Mopeka Tank Blanket around the tank and hook the 2 attached springs from one end to the 2 hooks on the opposite end. See images:
5. Plug the power cord into any 120V outlet
6. Set the thermostat to the desired temperature.
Thermostat setting range is 35 degrees to 140 degrees Fahrenheit.



WARNINGS AND SAFETY for the Tank Blanket



- Before and after every use, inspect your **Tank Blanket** product for rips, tears or holes of any kind, and inspect the power supply cord for damage. Do not return to service or apply power to any damaged Tank Blanket product.
- Only install the correct size of **Tank Blanket** on the designated tank it is designed for. Do Not install larger **Tank Blankets** on smaller tanks.
- When in use, a **Tank Blanket** product might be placed over warning labels or instructions on other products. You should be familiar with the content and location of such warning labels or instructions before covering them with the **Tank Blanket** product.
- Always read and follow installation instructions in regards to the warning labels and plastic sleeves.
- The warnings and instructions provided in this guide relate only to the **Tank Blanket** product, and should not be used as a substitute for any warnings or instructions on other products used with the blanket. Mopeka makes no representations as to suitability for use with specific products.
- For questions regarding whether other products may be used safely with a **Tank Blanket** product, please refer to the warnings and instructions provided with the covered product, and/or contact the product manufacturer.
- Always use a Ground Fault Protection Device when using **Tank Blanket** products. Never connect to a higher voltage power supply than what is listed on the installation instructions (120V).
- Never use ungrounded, worn, or damaged extension cords.
- Do not put **Tank Blanket** in water. The product is not waterproof.
- Never pull, drag, or lift the product by the power cord. Do not fold product. Save original container for product storage.
- Do not connect product to power until installed.
- Do not add extra insulation to the underneath or cover it with any other product.
- Do not place heavy objects or walk on the product.
- Verify prior to use that object(s) being heated can tolerate the max temperature of the blanket.
- Be sure the work area is free of sharp objects that may puncture or tear your **Tank Blanket**.



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
