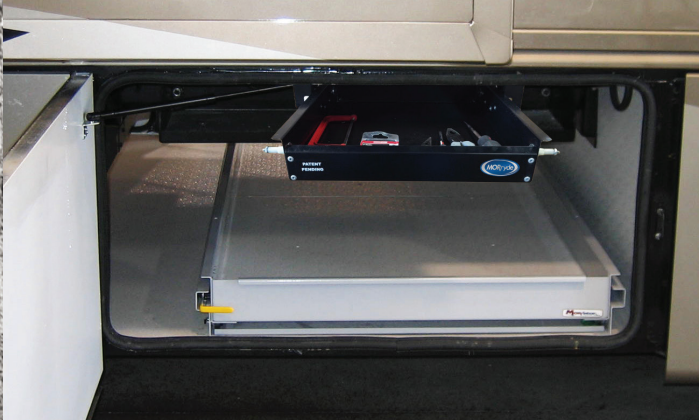


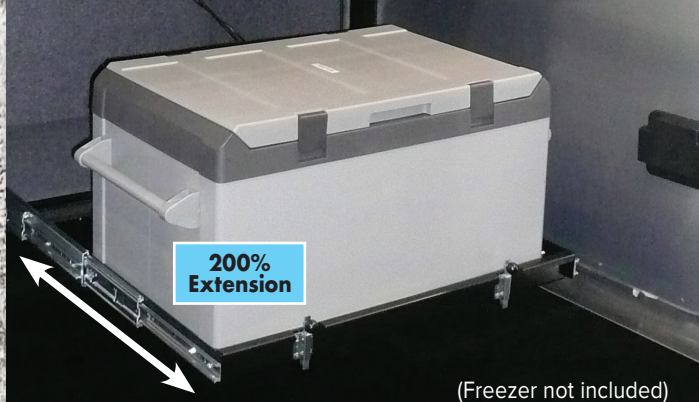


HIDDEN DROP DOWN TRAY
